And there are new options, too. One is America's only 4-cylinder turbocharged engine—the 2.3 liter turbo built by Ford-now available on Futura. Another is the new 4.2 liter (255 CID) 2V V-8 engine. Our display models feature Futura's own Tu-Tone paint treatment, also a new option.

Futura is aerodynamic in design, with room to seat five. And its standard 2.3 liter OHC engine with 4-speed manual transmission offers excellent fuel economy.\* With optional turbocharger, the 2.3 liter engine delivers extra acceleration for passing or freeway merging. - (C) The 2.3 liter turbo engine provides extra acceleration when you need it for passing or freeway merging. The turbocharger is basically an air compressor driven by recycled exhaust gases. When activated, it pressurizes atmospheric air to increase the velocity of the fuel/air mixture. The result: excellent acceleration.



You can select any of six attractive colors for the Futura seating arrangement you like best: Medium Red, Med Wedgewood Blue, Caramel, Med. Vaquero, Sand, or White. Bucket seats in optional plaid cloth/vinyl trim (B) are available in Medium Red, Medium Wedgewood Blue and Caramel.

Note: Futura offers low-back buckets (B) as standard with the 2.3 liter engine/floor-mounted manual transmission, and with the 2.3 liter turbo/floor-mounted automatic. You get a bench seat (C) as standard with the 3.3 liter (200 CID) "I" Six/floor-mounted manual, and with the 4.2 liter (255 CID) V-8/column-mounted automatic, while buckets are available as an option. The bench seat is available with all engine/transmission combinations except the 2.3 liter with floor-mounted manual transmission and the 2.3 liter turbo with floor-mounted automatic.





And in order to help keep your Futura looking new, we incorporate the use of precoated steels, such as galvanized steel, vinyl sealers, aluminized wax in critical areas, and enamel as a finishing coat.

LOW SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE, As part of a continuing program to lower the cost of ownership, scheduled maintenance requirements on most new Fords have been lowered dramatically in recent years. For example, with the new 1980 Ford Futura the recommended schedule is 10,000 miles (7500 miles with V-8 engines) or 12 months on 6- and most 4-cylinder engines between oil changes and 30,000 miles between lubes. These are just two small parts of the comprehensive program, which, in total, can significantly lower the cost of scheduled maintenance for Futura over 50,000 miles of driving.

COLOR AND TRIM CODES. Car colors and trims are coded, example: Silver Metallic (1G). Your Ford Dealer will be pleased to show you color samples of paint and trim materials.
