

Ever since Ford introduced its V-8 idea in 1932, it has held a commanding lead in V-8 manufacture. And refinements each year assure you of top cruising V-8 economy and performance. For 1971, Ford offers you six responsive V-8's to choose from, in cubic inch displacements (CID's) of 302, 351, 390, 400, 429 2V and 429 4V. See Power Team Chart, page 16, for horsepower ratings of each engine.

Among many fine features is Ford's precision lightweight casting construction which reduces nose-heaviness and steering effort, and still gives you an engine more rugged than ever. V-8's from 302 to the 400 CID (new this year), also are designed to run on regular 91 octane fuel, or higher, which can save you a bundle in operating cost.

Each Ford V-8 also runs long and strong because of better ideas like ventilated distributor points, and a depth-type, dual-density oil filter. Oil is filtered throughout the entire depth rather than just on the filter surface. All 429 CID V-8's have canted valves for better breathing and higher engine efficiency. Obviously, when it comes to better ideas in engine reliability and durability, you get the best first from Ford—the industry's most experienced V-8 builder.






