

### Chrysler Engineering and Electronics

Power steering. Gives you a fine sense of control, yet works easily. Only 3.5 turns of the steering wheel are needed to move the front wheels from full-left to fullright.

Unibody construction. This is one of the strong points that Chrysler engineering has built its reputation on! Using more than 4000 welds, the body panels and structural members are fused into one unit. It's a totally strong, solid structure.

Impact-absorbing bumper system. Large hydraulic cylinders help soak up the shock of minor impacts.

Rubber iso-clamps. These are simply large rubber cushions that isolate the suspension system from the axle. They help to dampen road noise and vibration.

TorqueFlite automatic transmission. Completely maintenance-free under normal driving conditions: no band adjustments, no fluid or filter replacement is recommended.

Lock-up torque converter. The new lock-up torque converter provides direct mechanical linkage between the engine and the rear axle when the automatic transmission shifts into third gear, resulting in better gas mileage, cooler transmission temperature, and lower engine speed. Standard with 400 V-8s (Federal) and 360 CID V-8s (California). Not available at high altitudes or with trailer-assist option.

Torsion bar front suspension. The underlying reason for Chrysler's fine stability and road sense. Road shocks are absorbed by the twisting action of the torsion bar before they can be transmitted to the car body. In combination with a rubber isolated stub frame and large rubber Iso-clamps and front sway bar, it produces Chrysler's famous Torsion-Quiet Ride.

Power brakes. (Front disc, rear drums.) Standard on all Chryslers. Disc brakes have excellent fade-resistance. Front and rear brakes are self-adjusting. Every Chrysler has separate hydraulic systems for front- and rear-wheel brakes. In case of damage to one of the systems, the other system functions independently to bring the car to a stop.

7-step rust and corrosion protection. Every car body is thoroughly cleaned and coated with special chemicals in a 7-step dip-and-spray process to combat corrosion. Then two coats of tough epoxy primer are applied, baked and sanded. Finally, three coats of acrylic enamel are baked to a glossy, lasting luster.

Oil change interval. Your 1978 Chryslers require only an oil change once every 7500 miles, or six months of driving, under normal driving conditions, providing another example of how Chrysler engineering has reduced maintenance on its cars.



The computer-controlled Electronic Lean Burn System is standard on all Chrysler 400 and 440 V-8s . . . the engines that think! The Electronic Lean Burn System employs a small spark-control computer, making it possible to use lean mixtures during part-throttle operation. Electronic Lean Burn's simplified distributor uses a magnetic pickup coil to initiate a timing circuit in the Spark Control Computer. The computer adjusts spark advance with split-second accuracy in response to your engine's need. Your car reacts with smoothness and responsiveness!



Long-Life battery. Optional. The best battery you can buy. The 500-amp battery is backed by a 5 year or 50,000 mile (whichever comes first) nonprorated limited warranty . . . the owner has only the responsibility to keep the fluid level up! Its long, reliable service

is assured by heavy-duty construction, with a thermally insulated shield to protect against excessive engine heat.

Electronic Ignition System. (Included in Electronic Lean Burn.) The distributor used with electronic ignition has no points and no condenser. Result: no more

ignition tune-ups in normal use. Helps deliver sure starting voltage in any weather. And can increase spark plug life up to 30,000 miles under normal driving conditions with unleaded fuel.

Electronic voltage regulator. Under normal driving conditions, maintenance-free! Its electronic circuitry is sealed in tough epoxy - shock-resistant, moistureresistant and extremely durable.

High-capacity alternator. Helps prolong battery life by sending a charge to the battery even when the engine is idling. Included with the optional electrically heated rear window defroster and or air conditioning systems.

High-speed starter. For quick, reliable starts, this 1.8 hp. starter motor is standard on 400 and 440 V-8s. Rubber isolated clutch contributes to the starter's durability.
