With bucket or bench seats.

Handsome, individually adjustable bucket seats in plaid cloth and vinyl are one of two Futura offerings. The color shown is Wedgewood Blue (UB), one of three color choices. Also available in six colors of all-vinvl trim. Bucket seats are standard in Futuras with the 2.3 litre engine/4-speed manual transmission power team.



Bench front seat is offered on Futuras with any of these three power team options: (1) 2.3 litre engine/SelectShift automatic transmission (column mounted); (2) 3.3 litre (200 CID) Six/ 4-speed manual overdrive*; (3) 5.0 litre (302 CID) V-8/4-speed manual overdrive.* The trim is pleated luxury vinyl in Red (TD). Five other color choices are offered. Or you can choose from cloth and vinyl trim in five color selections. *Not available in California.

corrosion protection. Ford takes steps to see that your new Fairmont Futura is engineered and built to high quality standards. And in order to help keep your Futura looking new, we incorporate the use of precoated steels, such as galvanized steel and chromium/zinc-rich primer coated steel, vinyl sealers, aluminized wax in critical areas, and enamel as a finishing coat.

LOW SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE. As part of a continuing program to lower the cost of ownership, scheduled maintenance requirements on most new Fords have been reduced dramatically since 1975. For example, with the new 1979 Fairmont Futura, the recommended maintenance schedule is now

10,000 miles (7,500 miles with V-8 engines) or 12 months between scheduled oil changes and 30,000 miles between lubes. These are just two small parts of a comprehensive program which, in total, can lower the cost of scheduled maintenance to an estimated \$154 in 50,000 miles on the 1979 Futura, equipped with 3.3 litre (200 CID) Six and automatic transmission; 73% (or \$410) less than the '73 Ford Maverick equipped with 3.3 litre (200 CID) Six and automatic transmission. Computations are based on Ford's Labor Time Standards, a \$17.70 hourly labor rate, manufacturer's suggested retail parts prices effective September 1, 1978, and assumes 10,000 miles accumuation per year on the '79 Futura.
