They are also some of the finest cars and trucks of their type produced anywhere in the world. The following are just a few of the many ingenious design features available on many of these vehicles.

I. THE SILENT SHAFT ENGINE.

Excess noise and vibration usually associated with four-cylinder engines has been virtually eliminated by Mitsubishi engineers who developed this unique Silent Shaft design. The secret lies in the use of counter-balancing shafts that rotate in opposite directions to cancel out the vibration, and hence the noise, inherent in conventional four-cylinder engines. This design feature is incorporated in the 2.0-liter engine that's standard on the D-50 pickup. A 2.6-liter Silent Shaft engine is standard on Challenger, Colt wagon and the D-50 Sport.

2. POWER DISC BRAKES.

Sure-stopping, fade-resistant caliper-type power disc brakes are standard up front on Colt hatchback, Colt wagon, Challenger, and D-50 pickup with drum brakes in the rear. In addition. Colt hatchback features a dual diagonal braking setup with two separate systems for opposing front and rear wheels. To help provide Colt with straight-line stopping power. And Challenger offers four-wheel disc brakes with the optional Road Wheel Package. For the ultimate in sports car braking systems.



3. THE TWIN-STICK TRANSMISSION.

Just when everyone else was "discovering" four- and five-speed transmissions, Mitsubishi engineers came up with the world's first eight-speed for cars. That's the amazing Twin-Stick that you'll find standard on the Colt hatchback. The lever on the right is like a normal four-speed. The range selector lever on the left converts that four-speed into an eight-speed by giving you two operating ranges ... one for economy and one for power. So, depending on the mode you select, you get either outstanding efficiency or surprisingly brisk performance. It's a Mitsubishi and Chrysler Corporation exclusive.

4. MCA (MITSUBISHI CLEAN AIR)—JET ENGINE SYSTEM.

This valve injects an additional amount of air to create an extra-lean, swirling mixture of fuel and air in the combustion chamber.
