space ready to work for you. While up front, the Model G Wagon's exquisite interior is fully capable of transforming a tedious errand into a pleasure cruise.




The Bonneville Model G Wagon is a delight to drive, whether you're carrying cargo or getting carried away on your favorite country road.

Coming or going, the Model G Wagon looks impressive. And by adding the available luggage roof rack you can increase an already generous capacity for cargo.




Fold down the rear seat and there's more than 71 cu. ft. of cargo space for golf clubs or groceries. Plus concealed storage beneath the floor for valuables.

ABOUT ASSEMBLY, COMPONENTS AND OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT IN THESE PONTIAC PRODUCTS.

The Pontiacs described in this brochure are assembled at facilities of General Motors Corporation operated by Pontiac, GM Assembly Division or GM of Canada. These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by various divisions of General Motors and by various suppliers to General Motors. From time to time during

the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce Pontiac products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in Pontiac products and will provide the quality performance associated with the Pontiac name.

With respect to extra cost optional equipment, make certain you specify the type of equipment you

desire on your vehicle when ordering it from your dealer.

Some options may be unavailable when your car is built. Your dealer receives advice regarding current availability of options. You may ask the dealer for this information. GM also requests the dealer to advise you if an option you ordered is unavailable. We suggest that you verify that your car includes the optional equipment you ordered or if there are changes, that they are acceptable to you.


