

FIREBIRD COUPE




Pontiac's performance leader makes its most impressive visual statement outfitted in the optional Sport Appearance Package. This package includes special front and rear fascias, lower-body aero skirts, a sleek rear valance panel and a rear deck spoiler. For information on other available options, please see your dealer. The exterior look of the Sport Appearance Package comes in monotone Black, Medium Grey Metallic, Bright Red, Brilliant Red, Medium Green Metallic, or Arctic White colours. An exterior clearcoat deepens the lustre of each finish.



For 1991, the legendary Firebird Coupe includes redesigned front and rear fascias, rear deck spoiler, Hi-Tech Turbo cast aluminum wheels and Touring T/A radial tires.

Firebird Coupe's 3.1L V6, with revised cylinder heads, a stroked crankshaft and multi-port fuel injection, harnesses 140 hp.



With Hi-Tech Turbo cast aluminum rims and steel-belted blackwall radials shouldering out from the wheel wells, this Firebird looks as good standing still as it feels in action.

Under the hood, you'll find a sporty
3.1L V6 with multi-port fuel injection
and 140 hp. It breathes easily through
a low-restriction aluminum intake
manifold, maximizes power and optimizes timing advance with electronic
spark control. The optional engine
is the 5.0L V8 with electronic fuel
injection (EFI). It packs 170 hp,
255 lbs.-ft. of torque and a throaty
exhaust that talks Pontiac performance.
Match either of these powerplants
with the standard 5-speed manual
transmission or the optional 4-speed

automatic.

The full list of standard equipment on the Coupe is too lengthy to list here, but among them are power brakes, concealed headlamps, tinted glass and wet-arm windshield wipers.



PASS-Key* is the key to peace of mind for Firebird owners. The dark insert in the key shank is a specific resistor. Without its "code", special systems will prevent the car from starting.



We hope you'll never need the Supplemental Inflatable Restraint System (air bag) in every Firebird steering wheel. Along with a safety belt, it helps protect the driver in the event of a frontal collision.

FORMULA & TRANS AM



Meet Pontiac's authorities on performance for 1991. The Trans Am and Formula have the driving characteristics to back up their impressive appearance.


Combining form and function, the front fascia's undersurface is formed with special intake ducts that channel cool air to the front brakes. A redesigned rear deck spoiler and rear valance give you enhanced aerodynamics.

Those of you who appreciate a little well-applied muscle will be glad to know that V8s are still in the programme for these legendary Coupes. Formula comes with a 5.0L EFI V8 and optional 5.0L or 5.7L V8s with tuned-port fuel injection (TPI). Trans Am starts off with the 5.0L V8 with TPI then tempts you with the big 5.7L engine. For

transmissions, a 4-speed automatic is available with any powerplant, while a 5-speed manual is standard with everything except the 5.7L V8. Both Trans Am and Formula offer special suspensions. For Trans Am, Level II suspension is standard, delivering Firm Ride and Handling. Level III Performance suspension means even bigger front and rear stabilizer bars, special springs, bushings, Z-rated Goodyear Eagle "Gatorback" tires and 16" charcoal Diamond-Spoke cast aluminum wheels. Formula has Level III suspension standard, plus 16" Deep-Dish Hi-Tech Turbo wheels.



Stay tuned for 235 hp.
The specially formed runners of this High Output 5.7L V8 are designed to harmonize with the engine's firing order and valve timing to create performance-enhancing tuned intake pulses.



A low restriction, twin catalytic converter exhaust system gives Formula and GTA with the 5.0L with TPI V8 and 5-speed a 12.5% power boost over a conventional exhaust system. It's also standard with any 5.7L V8.

TRANS AM GTA



We saved the best for last: Trans Am GTA. With its High Output 5.7L V8, this is the Firebird that delivers 235 hp in tuned-port fuel-injected performance.


Its excitement builders include tuned intake runners, a high-performance roller lifter cam, a special octane sensor for optimum timing advance, a low-restriction twin catalytic converter exhaust system with 57.2mm (2½") headpipes and a 3.23:1 limited slip rear axle.

The handling package consists of 36mm front and 24mm rear stabilizer bars, gas-filled deflected disc shocks and struts, quick-ratio power steering, power 4-wheel disc brakes and Goodyear Eagle "Gatorback" tires on 16X8" Gold Diamond-Spoke cast aluminum wheels.

Inside GTA you'll find full analog
instrumentation with performancerated speedometer, cruise control, a
bank of rocker switches and power
articulating front bucket seats. There
is also a Delco AM stereol FM stereo
sound system with cassette and graphic
equalizer plus a leather-wrapped
steering wheel and shift knob. Move it
and you're in control of a 4-speed
automatic transmission or optional
5-speed manual, should you choose the
5.0L V8 engine.



The new rear wing for the GTA is shaped like an inverted airfoil for enhanced effectiveness. The chrome tailpipes are fair warning of the potential rumbling in its 235 hp exhaust.



The gear ratios in Firebird Coupe's 5-speed manual transmission are designed with Pontiac performance in mind. From first gear up, it's 4.03:1, 2.37:1, 1.50:1, 1.00:1 and 0.76:1.
