

While Bonneville's surfaces fluidly meld, the surfaces themselves are an amalgamation of highly durable galvanized steels, dent-resistant polycarbonates and flexible polymers.



The SSEi's chassis features a fully independent suspension, electronic load leveling, Magnasteer variable-effort power steering and a four-wheel anti-lock braking system. The sophisticated Computer Command Ride adjustable suspension is available.

It is a rare sedan that demonstrates a clear commitment to pure performance. From the first Bonnevilles that set speed records on the salt flats of Utah to this present SSEi, Bonneville remains true to its reason for being.

Demonstrable proof presents itself in the form of engineering that delivers exceptional control, handling and power. The SSEi's noteworthy capabilities make the car stand out as one of the world's most powerful sport sedans—no surprise given the Eaton supercharger fixed atop the SSEi's award-winning engine. The features that enable this commanding performance similarly enhance Bonneville's premium level of comfort.



Remarkably refined and quiet, the Supercharged Series II 3800 V6 propels the SSEi with 240 horsepower at 5200 rpm and an enormous 280 ft-lbs of torque at only 3200 rpm.



Fingertip controls modify the SSEi's transmission shift characteristics, as well as the settings for the Traction Control and available Computer Command Ride.

Fast-paced roads separate the genuine road cars from the pretenders. Roads like these demand what the SSEi provides. Shown at right is the Bonneville SSE with available SSEi Supercharger Package in Silver-Taupe Metallic.





Instrumentation provides the window through which vital information reaches the driver. Like any good window, the view is clear. At night, Pontiac's hallmark of red backlighting ensures exceptional visibility.



The reason Pontiac offers the Sport Luxury Edition with either 205 or 240 horsepower (with the available supercharged engine) stems from the fact that different drivers demand differing amounts of reserve power.

Bonneville with the Sport Luxury Edition Package: From the moment the doors remotely unlock, it becomes amply clear that the luxury of Bonneville centers on the driver. Interior lights illuminate to give the driver time to acclimate to the purposeful driving environment. The contoured leather driver's seating area includes power adjustments. Interior temperatures adjust automatically, as does the level of assist provided by the sophisticated variable-effort rack-and-pinion power steering system (adding steering assist to make parking easier, and reducing assist to provide necessary road feel at highway speeds). Music comes to life through the six-speaker, AM/FM cassette audio system, while the job of bringing the road to life is assigned to the low-profile Goodyear Eagle LS touring tires and the quicker 3.06:1 performance axle ratio. Bonneville: Everything is under control—the automobile over the environment and the driver over the road.

With an interior as quiet as the Bonneville's, the rich sound produced by the available CD player is heard with fidelity. Sound system controls on the steering wheel are also available.






Bonneville SE in Medium Dark Teal Metallic with available 16" Crosslace wheels.




The Bonneville SE uses a three-channel, electronically controlled anti-lock braking system as one way to enhance braking and steering control in otherwise unpredictable situations (such as steering around an obstacle while braking on slick pavement).

Sport sedans earn their stature by endowing drivers with the ability to control. Bonneville SE excels by indulging drivers with the requisite road-going hardware: a 205-horsepower V6, electronically controlled four-speed automatic transmission and a taut, fully independent suspension.

Beyond these performance-oriented basics, Bonneville furnishes drivers with expected standards such as air conditioning, power windows, power door locks, and welcome extras such as the convenience of the rear-seat pass-through and cruise control. Welcome personal security comes from an integrated theft-deterrent system, all-season touring tires and a fully automatic lighting system featuring daytime running lamps. Considering all it apportions to drivers to excite the driving experience, Bonneville earns its status as one of the world's finest sport sedans.



Comfort takes on many forms, such as knowing that every Bonneville features the security afforded by the PASS-Key II theft-deterrent system. Personal security is further enhanced with the available remote keyless entry, providing the ability to lock or unlock the doors from up to 30 feet away.



Unmistakable and brilliant, Bonneville looks as distinctive at night as it does in the day.





wide. We sometimes find it necessary to produce Bonnevilles with different or differently sourced components than originally scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in Bonnevilles and will provide the quality of performance associated with the Pontiac name. Since some options may be unavailable when your vehicle is assembled, we suggest you verify that your vehicle includes the equipment you ordered, or if there are changes, that they are acceptable to you.

Warranty Protection:

Bonneville's 3-year/36,000-mile (whichever comes first) no-deductible bumper-to-bumper limited warranty covers repairs, including labor and parts, to correct any defects in material or workmanship occurring during the warranty period. The complete vehicle is covered, except for adjustments and normal maintenance.

Corrosion Protection:

Bonneville is designed and built to resist corrosion. All body and sheet metal components are warranted against rust-through corrosion for 6 years or 100,000 miles, whichever comes first.
