





Fun meets practicality. They elope. On one hand, its spirited engine, precise handling and responsive brakes make it fun to drive. On the other, its dent-resistant polymer panels, namesake third door and oil-life monitor that tells you when it's time for an oil change make it eminently practical. Which side is ultimately more important? That's entirely up to you.



As it turns out, practicality can be quite beautiful. It starts with our famous dent-resistant polymer panels. Able to ward off baseballs, bicycles and errant shopping carts, these panels not only help keep Saturns looking new, they actually increase resale value as well. On top of that, we apply three coats of paint that is specially formulated to flex with the panels, making it less likely to chip. And the way we apply the paint is pretty intelligent, too, via an environmentally friendly waterborne process.











**SC1** It's built on the novel idea that a base model doesn't have to be basic. The SC1's standard features include an engine-immobilizing anti-theft system, rear spoiler, power steering, oil-life monitor, intermittent front wipers, 60/40-split folding rear seatbacks, AM/FM stereo with CD player and a five-speed manual transmission that offers great gas mileage (EPA-estimated mpg: 28 city/40 highway).



**SC2** If you believe the act of driving is something of a destination in itself, then the SC2 is for you. In addition to the above features, it offers a 124-horsepower, dual-overhead-cam, 16-valve engine. It also comes with a leather-wrapped steering wheel, sport-tuned suspension, variable-effort power steering, CFC-free air conditioning, cruise control, foglamps, remote keyless entry and power windows, door locks and mirrors.



Engines that let your fun side and your practical side peacefully coexist. The engines in the three-door coupes are designed to deliver high torque at low engine speed. They're mated to transmissions with gear ratios and software controls specifically chosen to make the most efficient use of this power. All of which means your speedometer will get quite a workout, but your gas needle won't (EPA-estimated city/highway mpg: SC1 with manual 28/40, with automatic 26/36; SC2 with manual 27/38, with automatic 25/36).





Optional automatic transmission. So advanced it holds 30 patents, this four-speed transmission incorporates a special technology called uphill/downhill grade logic. Simply put, it allows the transmission to choose from more than 200 shift patterns to help eliminate the constant searching between gears typical of ordinary automatics. All you notice is a smooth, steady flow of power.



**1.9-liter engines**. The SC2 engine has a dual-overhead-cam design, has four valves per cylinder and produces 124 horsepower at 5,600 rpm and 122 ft. lbs. of torque at 4,800 rpm. The SC1 has a single-overhead-cam design, has two valves per cylinder and delivers 100 horsepower at 5,000 rpm and 114 ft. lbs. of torque at 2,400 rpm. Both engines operate on 87-octane gasoline, both have durable steel timing chains and both are available with a five-speed manual or four-speed automatic transmission.



**Five-speed manual transmission**. By this point you've probably gathered that the three-door coupe is a driver's car. And what better way to enjoy driving than with a stick? Designed with gear ratios that specifically match engine output, this transmission delivers crisp, positive shifts and is perfect for making the most out of endless curves and rolling hills.



**Power is nothing without control**. That's why our chassis engineers have worked hard to perfect the suspension systems in the three-door coupes. The goal was to balance engine output with braking ability, and sporty handling with a comfortable ride. The result? Hop in and see for yourself.





Optional Anti-lock Braking System with Traction Control. This system employs special sensors that read what's happening and adjust braking pressure accordingly—much faster than a human possibly could. That keeps the brakes from locking and helps you retain control. The system, which is optional on both the SC1 and the SC2, includes our patented Traction Control for better footing in slippery conditions.



**Sport-tuned suspension system**. Standard equipment on the SC2, this system includes both front and rear stabilizer bars and stiffer springs that help provide a firm, solid ride while minimizing the transmission of road imperfections to the interior. The result is excellent control and a comfortable ride. The suspension system is a natural fit with Saturn's rigid spaceframe chassis.



**Power steering**. Constant-flow rack-and-pinion power steering on the SC1 is designed for a steady assist in steering at all speeds. Variable-assist rack-and-pinion power steering on the SC2 adjusts the amount of assist based on vehicle speed—more in parking lots, less at freeway speeds.





Easy-to-read instrumentation. At Saturn, we spend quite a bit of time designing our instrumentation. That's why everything is so easy to read and provides really useful information, all at a moment's glance. A particularly good example is the oil-life monitor that actually keeps track of your driving habits and reminds you when you need to change your oil.



Comfortable controls. Slip behind the wheel, keep your eyes straight ahead and drop your right hand. The shift lever is right there, exactly where it should be. The same holds true for the radio buttons and climate control switches. And their placement isn't the only thing that's intuitive. They operate the same way, as well.



Front seats with adjustable headrests. No two people are exactly the same size, so front seats and headrests on the SC2 are adjustable, as is the console armrest. The SC2 driver's seat has adjustable lumbar back support and seat height, as well as front, back and recline adjustments. The two-toned, leather trim (shown here) is a brand-new SC2 option this model year.




AM/FM stereo with four coaxial speakers and CD player. At the risk of sounding boastful, it's a pretty impressive standard sound system. And if you want the widest possible choice of tunes for the road, ask about the retailer-installed six-disc CD changer. (It's housed conveniently in the armrest that's standard on the SC2, a retailer-installed accessory on the SC1.)




60/40-split folding rear seatbacks. You've got stuff. Probably a lot of stuff. And there will be times when you need to take all that stuff somewhere. No problem. Simply unlatch a lever, fold down one or both of the seatbacks, and there you go.

These include driver and front passenger air bags; three-point load-limiting front safety belts, spaceframe construction with front and rear crumple zones, side-impact door beams, daytime running lamps, anti-submarining





**Optional Head Curtain Air Bags**\* Here's an important safety feature to help protect the driver or front seat passenger in the event of certain side-impact collisions. Similar protection is available on some luxury cars, but our three-door coupe is among very few cars in its class to offer this option. Check it out.




Steel spaceframe construction. Every three-door coupe is built on a strong, welded steel skeleton. Front and rear crumple zones are designed to help absorb energy instead of transmitting it all to the passengers. The doors are built with steel beams and cross bracing for side-impact protection. As if the intended safety benefits weren't enough, this construction also helps reduce the number of squeaks and rattles that can develop over time.

\*Always use safety belts and proper child restraints, even with air bags. Head Curtain Air Bags are designed to help reduce the risk of head and neck injuries to front seat occupants on the near side of certain side-impact collisions. All Saturn models are equipped with driver and front passenger frontal-impact air bags. The primary benefit of any frontal air bag is to help protect occupants in certain collisions by supplementing



the protection provided by safety belts. However, even with reduced force air bags, there remain fatal risks to infants in rear-facing infant restraints and to other children who are not properly secured when the air bag inflates. Children are safer when properly secured in a rear seat. Never secure an infant in a rear-facing restraint in the front seat of any vehicle with an active air bag.
