We even have three wagons tough as trucks. Suburban, Sportvan and Blazer all are built on truck chassis.

Everything you've always wanted in a car, in a wagon. Caprice Estate, Impala, Bel Air all have V8 power, Turbo Hydra-matic automatic transmission, power steering, power disc/drum brakes and power tailgate window as standard equipment.

There's up to 106.4 cubic feet of

cargo space in both the 2- and 3-seat models. And it's easy to get to, thanks to our Glide-Away tailgate. (More about that later.)

Ride and handling? You wouldn't believe you're in a wagon. New more durable rubber mounts for front stabilizer bar and front shock absorbers; independent front coil springs and long rear leaf springs; computer-selected springs—all contribute to a wagon ride that is dramatically smooth, handling that is responsive.

The Caprice Estate Wagon. Distinctive from every angle.

It has its own very special grille featuring prominent vertical bars with bright accents, and special Caprice front panel crest. Translucent woodgrain vinyl exterior panels that let the body color show through. Full wheel covers. Individually framed headlights. Bright moldings.



- 4. Forward facing third seat. Lets kids stretch their legs and allows for improved visibility. Standard on all of our big Chevrolet 3-seat wagons.

- 6. Front switch for tailgate power window. No need to get out to open or close the tailgate window. That's why we put a power switch inside and up front in addition to the one at the tailgate.
- 7. Side-guard door beams. Steel guard rails are welded inside every door for your added protection.
- 8. Fenders inside fenders. Tough inner fenders at all four wheels help defend against rust and corrosion.
- 9. Double-panel roof structure. Two layers of steel overhead for strength and quiet. Acoustically engineered perforations in the inner roof panel help deaden sound much like ceiling tile.
- 10. Load space. Large enough to lay flat a 4' by 8' plywood sheet with the rear seats down. Total cargo volume: 106.4 cubic feet.
- 11. Split second seat. Allows room for passengers and long cargo plus easy access to the third seat.

- 12. Sealed side-terminal Delco Energizer battery. Helps stop power-robbing battery terminal corrosion. The Delco Eye in the filler cap glows to indicate when water is needed.
- 13. Rear end aerodynamics. The aerodynamic shape of the roof helps keep the rear window clean without using an air deflector.

The story of the Glide-Away tailgate.

There's one big problem with tailgates. Whether they swing down or sideways, they often get in the way.

Our engineers whipped this problem by designing a tailgate that disappears. Nothing sticks out to get in your way. You can even load or unload in a closed garage. Or with a trailer attached.

Here's how it works.

To lower the tailgate, turn your key to the right. The power window slides up and into the roof. A farther turn to the right and the gate releases down and slides under the floor with a gentle push.

To raise the tailgate, just pull it up. It's easy because it's counterbalanced. (And you can't pinch your fingers between the gate and glass because the window won't close unless the tailgate is up all the way.) Now turn the key to the left and the window slides down.

You can even dispense with the slight push and pull by ordering the available power tailgate. It raises and lowers automatically at the turn of the key.

The Glide-Away also is a simple mechanism. It works on the same principle as a sash window, with very few moving parts. So few that it weighs about 50 pounds less than our previous two-way tailgate design.

 - Heavy-duty generator. Our higher output Delcotron generator increases electrical output for heavy loading.
- 3. Load distributing hitch platform. Specifically designed for Chevrolet and Chevelle. Easy to install and easy to remove because it's bolted on.
 - Heavy-duty battery. For added electrical power reserve.
 - Superlift rear shock absorbers. Help keep your wagon level for light-duty trailering with ball frame hitch.
