

Choose either the 50/50 reclining passenger seat (shown below and left) or swivel bucket seats that swing around to a full 90°. Both give you an opportunity to personalize your Monte Carlo further. The 50/50 reclining seat offers

superb passenger travel comfort with a seat back that adjusts to a gently reclining position. And for the driver's seat, a six-way power adjustment is available.




Seats are of molded full foam construction, covered in a smart checked knit cloth in black, sandstone, blue, red or green. A handsome color-coordinated effect is created with knit cloth repeated in the upper door paneling and rich cut-pile nylon carpeting which extends up the lower door panels.


As with all Monte Carlo interiors, door pull straps are included for added convenience.

Ever since its 1970 model introduction, Monte Carlo has been enthusiastically accepted by those who appreciate a fine, personal-size automobile. A masterful blend of artful design and handling finesse, Monte Carlo is a thoroughly enjoyable car to look at and to drive. In fact, the more you drive Monte Carlo, the more you appreciate its integrity. For 1975, Monte Carlo becomes more

distinctive than ever. We've given it a handsome new grille and newly styled wraparound taillights to further enhance its sculptured lines. New bright molding is added to rear panels for a pleasing

Interior.

Monte Carlo's standard interior takes a clearly comfortable approach to driving, with molded full foam bench seat, deep cut-pile nylon carpeting and color-keyed instrument panel, steering wheel and steering column.

Upholstery comes in an appealing mix of tailored knit cloth or available vinyl. Striking white vinyl seats are available with carpeting and other areas in blue, green, red or black.

Both instrument panel and steering wheel are distinguished by simulated wood burl accents. And there are such conveniences as an electric clock, door



pull straps, glove compartment light, flow-through power ventilation that circulates air even when the car is idling, plus a new speedometer dial marked with miles per hour and metric equivalents.

Monte Carlo Landau features.



To satisfy the discriminating, the Monte Carlo Landau Coupe (shown on pages 2 and 3) offers distinctive additions. Most obvious, of course, is the formal Landau vinyl roof. Then there are dual bodycolor sport mirrors with the driver's side remotecontrolled, Turbine II

wheels, fender accent striping, dual horns, visor vanity mirror plus Landau crests on the roof's rear quarter and the door trim panel.

Occupant protection.


Monte Carlo is a driver's car. Head it down any road, even briefly, and this fact comes home to you. Emphatically. You drive it. It doesn't drive you.

Monte Carlo offers a confident road feel and superb handling that complement rather than challenge a driver. The result is a thoroughly satisfying motoring experience that ordinary drivers will appreciate and staunch car enthusiasts will revel in.

Though there are many reasons for the car's technical excellence, one of the most obvious is the front suspension. It involves a high caster angle on the front wheels. Without getting into technical explanations, this means the kind of arrangement found on certain European road cars. What it does is help give Monte Carlo stability and driving control.

Here's another par excellence item:
GM-Specification GR70-15 steelbelted radial ply tires are mounted
on wide seven-inch wheels. This,
coupled with radial-tuned Full Coil
suspension, helps provide a taut feel
for the road. The Full Coil suspension
incorporates husky, computer-selected
springs matched to the car and its
equipment weight.

As for cornering or sharp curves, front and rear ride stabilizers help

hold the car flat and make handling more responsive.

Monte Carlo's standard power steering is the variable-ratio type. This means that tight parking turns require little effort, yet on the road you have a firm feeling of control.

Then to ease travel over rough roads, a hydraulic damper on the steering linkage helps lower road shocks and steering wheel vibration.

Knowing what goes into Monte Carlo, no wonder it's such a great road car.

NEW CHEVROLET EFFICIENCY SYSTEM.

A nicely engineered group of components, Chevrolet's new Efficiency System is designed to add to the pleasure and economy of driving a 1975 Monte Carlo. High Energy Ignition. Chevrolet's High Energy Ignition sends up to 85% hotter spark to the plugs for quicker, more positive engine start-ups in wet weather or in cold or hot climates. This powerful spark helps produce more complete combustion of the fuel mixture. With HEI, fewer tune-ups are required because there are no breaker points or ignition condenser to wear out.

Catalytic converter. The new catalytic converter meets strict emission standards for 1975. By taking over most of the emission control work, the converter lets our engines go back to doing what they're designed for: delivering smooth, responsive, efficient performance.

Radial ply tires. Monte Carlo is equipped with steel-belted radial ply tires built to exacting GM specifications to give a desirable combination of smooth ride, handling, road hazard resistance and long tread life. Because these tires have less rolling resistance, they can help improve fuel economy. They also give improved traction on wet roads, snow and ice, and lessen the need for expensive snow tires.

Early Fuel Evaporation. Still another innovation is Early Fuel Evaporation. It helps give faster warm-ups and promotes smooth operation until the engine reaches its normal temperature. This can help stretch fuel economy on short trips in cold weather.

Carburetor air induction. In addition, new carburetor air induction funnels cooler, more dense outside air directly into the air cleaner and carburetor for

improved engine performance after warm-up.

As a result of the engineering improvements contained in the new Chevrolet Efficiency System, the 1975 Monte Carlo is designed to let you go more miles between recommended service intervals compared to 1974, a welcome saving of both time and money.


Even though Monte Carlo comes well equipped, you can give it still more personality—your own—by specifying from a large selection of available items, many of which are listed below. Your Chevrolet dealer, of course, has more specific details.

Convenience.

New 50/50 reclining passenger seat (shown on page 5) . Power assist for standard full-width seat or driver's side of 50/50 reclining passenger seat gives six-way power control that adjusts up, down, forward, backward, or tilts forward or backward . Floor console with transmission shift control (available only with swivel bucket seats and automatic transmission) • New right-hand remote-control mirror (available only with left-hand remote-control mirror) Power trunk opener lets you open trunk from inside of car . Auxiliary Lighting Group includes luggage compartment, ashtray, courtesy, underhood and mirror map lights, plus new "headlights-on" reminder buzzer.



Shown left, power door lock system has a control on each door to lock or unlock both doors. Right, power windows can be adjusted by driver using master switch; separate button located on right front passenger side.






