


Full-Size Measure of Wagon Convenience—The business end of the '63 Chevrolet Wagon shows a full-size measure of cargo-carrying convenience. Ready for cargo, there's as much as 97.5 cu. ft. of load space. With tailgate down, total load length to the back of the front seat is almost 10 feet. For easy loading, tailgate opening measures 56.5 inches wide at floor and 30.5 inches high. Loading deck is less than 2 feet from the ground. Spare tire tucks out of the way inside a special storage well.

Up to 10.5 cu. ft. of Hidden Stowage Space—Chevrolet Station Wagons for '63 have a special compartment for out-of-sight stowage of personal articles. Located beneath the rear cargo floor, the compartment can be reached from outside the wagon when tailgate is lowered. Easy access is provided through a handy hinged cover. (Locking cover optional at extra cost.) In 6-passenger wagons, the compartment measures a total of 10.5 cu. ft. and is over a foot deep.









NEW EASY-CARE FEATURES FOR EXTRA WORTH

This year Chevrolet offers a new range of easy-care features that make servicing and maintenance much simpler, contribute substantially to the life of your wagon.

NEW AIR-WASHED ROCKER PANELS—Chevrolet uses the cowl inlet ventilating system to water-flush and air-dry the inside of the rocker panels to help prevent corrosion. Water entering the cowl inlet travels through passages to the rocker panels, washes out dirt and dust, then drains through special outlets. Forward motion of the car forces air into the cowl inlet and through the passages to dry the inside of the panels.

NEW SELF-ADJUSTING SAFETY-MASTER BRAKES—Applying the brake pedal with car moving in reverse automatically adjusts the brakes. As a result, Chevrolet's new Safety-Master brakes are kept in proper adjustment for safe, sure stopping action.

NEW EXTENDED-LIFE EXHAUST SYSTEM—Liberal use of aluminum coatings in mufflers enables Chevrolet's '63 exhaust systems to resist the deteriorating effects of heat and corrosion for much longer periods of time. This means fewer replacements, less maintenance expense.



Tailgate opening is 47.5 inches wide at floor, 28.5 inches high. Loading deck is only 21.5 inches from the ground. Spare tire stows out of the way.






