





To drive Corolla is to experience life in the technological fast lane. Press the gas pedal, and an electronically controlled throttle body triggers your acceleration. An innovation called VVT-i, short for Variable Valve Timing with intelligence, helps the engine optimize power, emissions and efficiency. Electric Power Steering (EPS) helps guide you smoothly through the twists and turns. And as you drive Corolla, it even monitors its tire pressure automatically, warning you if it falls critically low.^{1, 2}





REFINED SUSPENSION







ELECTRIC POWER STEERING (EPS)

Electric Power Steering (EPS) helps give Corolla steering response that's effortlessly accurate. EPS also eliminates hydraulic-assist components that can reduce fuel economy. And by reducing the use of fluids, it helps lessen Corolla's overall environmental imprint.

Corolla's 132-hp 1.8-liter 4-cylinder engine, standard on Corolla grade, LE, XLE and S, achieves a remarkable balance of performance and efficiency. The DOHC 16-valve engine uses dual VVT-i. The engine block and cylinder head are made from lightweight aluminum alloy. Saving weight saves fuel. With an available automatic transmission in Corolla LE and XLE, these models can get an EPA-estimated 27 city/35 highway mpg rating!







SUPER-COOLING SYSTEM

The aluminum-alloy engine of the 2010 Corolla uses lightweight, high-compression pistons kept cool by a "water jacket spacer" that surrounds the cylinder walls. It's a design that also helps make the engine block lighter and more compact.

B DUAL VARIABLE VALVE TIMING WITH INTELLIGENCE (VVT-i)²


The sophisticated engineering behind Corolla's dual VVT-i engine pays big dividends at the pump. It intelligently determines the best valve timing for optimum power and efficiency.

ENGINE POWER

Power is on display in the 2010 Corolla. Equipped with a refined 1.8-liter 16-valve 4-cylinder engine, the 2010 Corolla is rated at 132 hp and 128 lb.-ft. of torque. A little Corolla power goes a long way.


Standard safety features on Corolla include front, side and side curtain airbags! The front seats incorporate active front headrests? Also standard on all models are three advanced safety technologies. An Anti-lock Brake System (ABS) enhances driver steering control by reducing wheel lockup under hard braking. Electronic Brake-force Distribution (EBD) with Brake Assist³ balances brake pressure distribution based on vehicle load and braking conditions. It automatically adjusts the brake force applied to each wheel and can transfer braking pressure front-to-rear or side-to-side to help optimize the available traction.



↑ TIRE PRESSURE MONITOR SYSTEM (TPMS)²


The two tires pictured above may look like they're properly inflated, but the tire on the right is actually under-inflated. The 2010 Corolla comes standard with Toyota's Tire Pressure Monitor System (TPMS). If the pressure in one of Corolla's tires reaches a critically low level, a warning light alerts the driver.³

R ACTIVE FRONT HEADRESTS⁴

Corolla comes standard with active headrests in the front seats that help keep the occupants' heads ideally positioned in the event of certain rear-end collisions.

VEHICLE STABILITY CONTROL (VSC)1

Enhanced VSC helps prevent the vehicle from slipping sideways while cornering. To help improve control in these situations, enhanced VSC automatically regulates engine output and brake-force distribution to the wheels. In addition, the system simultaneously provides the Electric Power Steering (EPS) assist torque to help the driver steer in the direction that provides greatest control. An off switch, designed to eliminate VSC, is useful in certain critical conditions.



ANTI-LOCK BRAKE SYSTEM (ABS)

ABS pulses brakes rapidly during hard braking to help keep the wheels from locking up, and thus helps preserve steering control.

Basic: 36 months/36,000 miles (all components other than normal wear and maintenance items).

Powertrain: 60 months/60,000 miles (engine, transmission/transaxle, front-wheel drive, rear-wheel drive, seatbelts and airbags).

Rust-Through: 60 months/unlimited miles (corrosion perforation of sheet metal).

Emissions: Coverages vary under Federal and California regulations. Refer to applicable Warranty and Maintenance Guide for details.

Accessories: For Genuine Toyota accessories purchased at the time of the new vehicle purchase, the Toyota Accessory Warranty coverage is in effect for 36 months/36,000 miles from the vehicle's in-service date, which is the same coverage as the Toyota New Vehicle Limited Warranty.

For Genuine Toyota accessories purchased after the new vehicle purchase the coverage is 12 months, regardless of mileage, from the date the accessory was installed on the vehicle, or the remainder of any applicable new vehicle warranty, whichever provides greater coverage, with the exception of car covers. Car covers are warranted for 12 months from the date of purchase and do not assume any coverage under the Toyota New Vehicle Limited Warranty.
