Electronic Differential Lock (EDL)

A form of traction control that works with the vehicle's ABS to transfer power from a slipping wheel to a non-slipping wheel during acceleration. This enables the wheel with better traction to make use of the engine's power. Less slip, more grip.

Auto Hold

Whether you're going up or downhill, once you come to a complete stop, you take your foot off the brake. Your Passat controls the hydraulic pressure to help prevent the vehicle from rolling forward or backward.

Electronic Parking Brake

No need to pull levers and push pedals to set your e-brake. Just simply press the e-brake button, and it will set itself. To get going press the button again while your foot is on the brake and it will release.
