There are still three versions of America's favorite compact to choose from. The 2-Door Sedan, the economy Maverick that started it all. (Shown here with optional Accent Groupbright window frames and drip moldings, wheel covers and color-keyed carpeting inside; white sidewall tires and Protection Group-front and rear bumper guards and bodyside molding with black vinyl insert.) The carefree Grabber with its low cost and sporty good looks. (Shown with optional WSW tires.) And the family-sized, family-priced 4-Door Sedan. (Also shown with Accent Group and WSW tires.) They're all economy champions. They're all American favorites. And they're all better ideas from Ford. One is probably just right for you.

Maverick is the one true compact in America. It's designed to meet all of the needs of the compact buyer. Let's talk it over.

The trim "in-between" 2-door size (shown with optional Accent Group, vinyl roof and white sidewall tires) was designed for excellent maneuverability without sacrifice to room and comfort. With a turning diameter of 36.9 feet (slightly more on the 4-door), Maverick can turn a pretty tight circle. Maverick's overall length, only 179.4 inches for the 2-door, 183.6 inches for the 4-door, lets you sneak into parking spots most American cars have to pass up.

Unitized construction, which means the body is welded into one piece, makes the Simple Machine tough, durable and quiet. For stability, the rear shock absorbers are staggered giving Maverick flatter cornering, easier handling—and giving you a remarkably smooth, controlled ride. To keep it carefree, you get built-in features like precision-made printed circultry for trouble-free instrumentation. And to keep it safe, Maverick's dual hydraulic brake system is designed to give you sure, fast stopping action. (See back cover for a complete list of Ford Motor Company Lifeguard Design Safety Features that are standard on all 1972 Mavericks.) Better ideas like these make Maverick a top compact value. And, in fact, America's favorite compact.

A better idea inside is the convenient full-width stowage tray. You also get full-width seats with "check" pattern cloth and vinyl trim. And color-keyed floor mats. (See below for a complete list of features that are standard on the 2-Door Sedan.)

Flash! The Simple Machine in snazzy sports clothing. With all those little nifties added, it deserves to be called Grabber. Simulated hood scoops, a deck lid spoiler, dual racing mirrors, road lamps, and hub caps with trim rings are some of the many features in the Grabber package. The hood paint treatment and tape stripes come in four color combinations. You also get rich all-vinyl seat trim and color-keyed carpeting. (See below for a complete list of Grabber's standard features.) Grabber, all models for that matter, can be equipped with any of the four engines in the Maverick lineup. There's the standard 170 CID Six. The optional 200 or 250 CID Sixes. And the spirited 302 CID V-8, a natural for Grabber.

Standard on all Mavericks is the column-mounted, fully synchronized 3-speed manual transmission. A 3-speed manual floor shift is also available as an option with the 200 CID Six or 302 V-8. The optional SelectShift Cruise-O-Matic transmission, required with the 250 CID Six, teams up beautifully with the 200 CID Six and 302 V-8 options. (Whew!) You can also get it with an optional floor shift which makes your decision about optional bucket seats easy. They'd be a must.

Relax! With all its sporty good looks. Grabber (shown with optional white sidewall tires) is as simple and economical as our 2- and 4-door sedans. You'll also be surprised to discover how simple it is to afford one.



MORE MAYERICK OPTIONS

A—More Power. Who says America's favorite compact can't have a little Zap! You have three optional powerplants to choose from: the 200 CID Six, the 250 CID Six and the eager 302 CID V-8 (shown). And they all run on regular gas!

B—Floor Shift. Get "command post" treatment with Maverick's floor shift. With either bench or bucket seats, it's available with the 3-speed manual transmission (shown here) and the 200 CID Six or 302 V-8. It's available with SelectShift teamed with any optional engine if you get bucket seats.

C—Protection Group. This option takes the worry out of parking in a crowded lot. Bodyside molding with black vinyl insert and front and rear bumper guards help prevent those little "nicks" and "dings."

D—Rear Window Defogger. Now you can do away with all those streaky attempts to wipe the steam off the rear window. Just a flip of the switch and it's clear again.
