i-ACTIVSENSE® | Avoiding an accident in the first place is always the safest route. With the available i-ACTIVSENSE® suite of safety features, sophisticated safety innovations help alert you to hazards so you can better avoid collisions—or lessen their impact. ADVANCED BLIND SPOT MONITORING¹

Radar sensors detect and alert when objects are in your left and right blind spots. It also warns when fast-traveling vehicles are about to enter a blind spot from further behind.

LANE DEPARTURE WARNING SYSTEM²

If you unintentionally drift out of your lane while driving at speeds higher than 37 mph, the system will alert you.

PAINT WORTHY OF ITS CANVAS | One of the first things you'll notice with the Mazda6 is its color. The glossiness. The luster. But this kind of depth doesn't come easy. When the design team proposed Soul Red Crystal Metallic as the lead color, the engineers were captivated by its deep reflections. And Mazda wants you to be captivated as well. Which is why a novel three-coat painting process is used, applying a bright layer of aluminum flakes below the unique red paint, and a clear top layer to emphasize the translucency. The process is quite painstaking, creating additional steps in an already laborious process. But for us, it is also quite invigorating.






