

IDEAL WEIGHT DISTRIBUTION—Like every Corvair model, the Monza offers all the benefits of America's "CAR OF THE YEAR" design. With its air-cooled aluminum engine in the rear and the passenger compartment more toward the center of the car, weight distribution and ride remain nearly constant regardless of the number of passengers. This constant ride helps make all Corvairs easy to handle, fun to ride in.

BEST BRAKING—Weight distribution is also the secret to the Corvair's remarkable braking. Even in emergency stops, the ideally distributed weight puts a nearly equal share of work on all four brakes—gives straight, heads-up stops. You have better control while braking, more even brake wear. And, the Corvair's Safety-Master brakes are air cooled for greater fade resistance, feature bonded linings for longer life. Braking ease is similar to a full-size car with power brakes.

SUPERIOR TRACTION—Weight of the engine over the rear wheels gives the Corvair traction that's unmatched by any other car in its class. The added grip of the road makes the Corvair a sure-footed goer in every sort of

weather and road condition . . . in every part of the country.

SUPERB HANDLING—In test after test, the Corvair has proved conclusively that it is the finest handling, most roadable car in its class. The credit for its outstanding performance capabilities must go equally to its rear engine design and its new suspension system . . . the first 4-wheel independent suspension on a modern U.S.-built car! PERFORMANCE AND ECONOMY—The revolutionary Corvair Turbo-Air 6 is the first pancake designed aluminum engine in a modern U.S.-built car. It's a lightweight 80-h.p. performance package, with a highly efficient shortstroke design, that can deliver all the get-up-and-go you'll ever need. It can be teamed with either a 3-speed floor shift transmission or Corvair Powerglide*. On the economy side of the ledger, the quick warm-up of its air-cooled engine means less fuel consumption because

less driving is done during engine warm-up. Automatic choke cuts off sooner, helps save on gas.

UNISTRUT BODY BY FISHER—Roof, floor, sides, front and rear sheet metal are all joined in a single welded construction of superior strength. A massive steel cowl extends the full width of the front, giving added protection. In the rear, a thickly insulated special bulkhead isolates passengers from engine compartment heat and sound.
