


# WHAT'S INSIDE



In keeping with the Saturn tradition, L-Series models represent outstanding values, offering engineering and features similar to those normally found on cars costing thousands of dollars more. Our new optional Head Curtain Air Bags, for example, are currently offered on Volvo, Audi and Mercedes.



Like anyone who experiences a degree of success, we've acquired a taste for some of the finer things. That might help explain why we designed our new L-Series models to be faster, roomier and more luxurious. Naturally, we have a high opinion of these new cars of ours, but it's an opinion already echoed by critics: the L100 recently received the 2000 *MotorWeek* Drivers' Choice Award for "Best Family Sedan."



L100. A sedan designed to embody all of Saturn's strong points—value, reliability, safety—but in a package large enough for five. You get a five-speed manual transmission, air conditioning complete with a dust and pollen filtration system, and an eight-speaker AM/FM audio system all as standard equipment.



LW200. A wagon that handles like a sedan. That's an apt way to describe this nimble model. It not only provides a generous amount of space for passengers and cargo, it's fun to drive. A cargo-area cover, convenience net, rear storage compartments and a rear windshield wiper are included as standard equipment.



L200. The most popular car in the L-Series line, this sedan gives you a lot for your money, including power windows and door locks, heated exterior mirrors, a remote keyless entry system, a CD player and a fuel-efficient five-speed manual transmission.




LW300. A V-6 engine, automatic transmission and sporttuned suspension combine to give this wagon a smooth, luxurious ride. Take hold of its leather-wrapped steering wheel and experience it firsthand. And yes, there's enough space to accommodate the most active lifestyle.



L300. Quick and responsive, Saturn's performance sedan is powered by a muscular V-6 engine. Plus, it offers a whole host of features, including an electronically controlled automatic transmission, sport-tuned suspension and four-wheel disc brakes.

It's easy to hold your head high when driving down the street in one of our L-Series sedans. Designed to create a striking impression, they sport Saturn's distinctive "swoosh," which helps give them a curvaceous, yet streamlined, look. Their aerodynamically advanced construction is nicely complemented by such optional styling elements as a handsome rear spoiler (available on the L200 and L300). When you add foglamps and 15-inch alloy wheels to the mix (standard on the L300 and LW300; optional on the L200 and LW200), you'll find yourself driving one exceptionally stylish automobile.

Don't be fooled by their beauty, though. They're also functional—boasting some of the most spacious trunks in their class.\*

The more you know about the integrity of the materials and processes that go into the manufacture of L-Series exteriors, the more impressed you'll be. Take our polymer front fenders and doors. Not only can they be shaped for sleeker designs, they won't rust and are up to four times more resilient than ordinary steel panels. Then there's our three-layer waterborne paint process. It produces a surface that flexes to help keep the paint from chipping. This, in turn, helps keep your Saturn looking newer, longer.


Space to stretch out in, whether you're a driver or passenger. Space enough to carry a week's worth of groceries, a weekend's worth of camping equipment or a large dog or three. Roominess was, of course, a key consideration when we designed our L-Series wagons. Which is why you'll have 98 cubic feet of total passenger space and 79 cubic feet of hauling room (when the rear seat's folded down) at your disposal. To make things more convenient still, standard equipment like a cargo-area cover, convenience net and rear storage compartments keep the groceries from toppling over and putting a crimp in your day. A rear windshield wiper also comes standard.

But our L-Series wagons offer grown-up pleasures as well:
stylish exteriors, plus performance and handling that
make driving them downright fun. Even if you
are taking the kids to their piano lessons.

When you need the acceleration—whether it's for merging onto the interstate or passing on a two-lane country road—you want it to be there. It's that simple. Both L-Series engines deliver the goods. In addition to producing 135 horsepower, our 2.2-liter, dual-overhead-cam, 4-cylinder engine has torque-heavy tuning, giving you more power off the line. Our 3.0-liter, V-6 engine cranks out a hefty 182 horsepower. And both engines are precisely matched—in terms of gear ratios and software tuning—to their transmissions, resulting in a welcome combination of excellent performance and good gas mileage.\* And are the engines ever durable. We subject them to millions of miles of grueling testing in the most extreme climates just to be sure.





Thanks to four-valve cylinder heads made from innovative lost-foam casting technology, our four-cylinder engines breathe a lot more efficiently, helping out the environment by generating fewer emissions and giving you better torque and acceleration in the process.

If you're the type who appreciates peace and quiet, you'll appreciate the fact that our 2.2-liter engine (standard on the L100, L200 and LW200) uses two counter-rotating balance shafts to reduce lateral shaking forces, leading to a smooth, quiet ride for you and your passengers.






Pleasurable driving with a practical twist.

That's what our five-speed manual transmission is all about. Standard on the L100 and L200, it gives you great off-the-line acceleration while helping to make the L-Series the fuel economy leader in the midsize segment.

Standard with a four-speed automatic transmission on the L300 and LW300, our V-6 performance engine—3.0 liters, 24 valves, dual-overhead-cams—has plenty of muscle. It also has a unique electronic throttle control. Instead of using a mechanical linkage between accelerator pedal and engine throttle, the system's entirely electronic. This allows for a smooth response to your foot on the accelerator, translating into more precise control of the engine.




Another way we ensure a quiet, more refined ride involves our vibration-isolating subframe. Relying on six mounting points instead of the four used in most cars, it helps minimize engine and transmission vibrations from reaching the passenger compartment.

With all the noise and confusion occurring on the roads these days, having a refuge is a must. That's precisely what L-Series interiors offer. Their ergonomic design features switches located just where you'd expect them to be, instrument gauges that are large and easy to read, conveniently placed cupholders and a standard air conditioning system that helps filter out dust and pollen before they enter the car. When you're ready to filter out the blaring horns and jackhammers, shut the triple-seal doors and savor your favorite music over the eight-speaker audio system that's standard on all models.





60/40-split folding rear seatbacks give you the flexibility to arrange your interior so it best suits your purposes. Reserve the whole back seat for cargo—or leave one seat up for a passenger.







Warning lights—including a "Change Oil Soon" one—let you conveniently monitor oil, brake fluid and washer fluid levels. And a fuel-door indicator points out which side of the car you need to go to when you'd like to fill your tank.




Lots of standard features—including a CD player, power windows, door locks that can be



programmed to unlock when your key's removed and a power switch for adjusting the heated exterior mirrors (on all models except the L100)—make driving that much easier and more enjoyable.




There's nothing quite like the feel of a leatherwrapped steering wheel (standard on the L300 and LW300; also available on the L200 and LW200 with the Leather Appointments package) to give you the exhilarating sense of having total mastery over the road. If you're ready to take comfort to the next level, there's our optional Leather Appointments package (available on all models except the L100). Get cozy in a heated leather front seat on a chilly morning. Or configure the six-way power driver's seat into a position that's optimal for you. The leather doesn't stop with the seating surfaces, either. We've also placed it on the door panels, parking-brake handle and automatic shifter, for a truly luxurious feel. Complementing the leather are civilized touches like a courtesy light in the driver's door to keep you from stepping in that pesky puddle after dark—and front and rear reading lights (standard on the L300 and LW300).



The Saturn Advanced Audio System, available as an option on all models except the L100, carries you to even higher peaks of audio bliss with a separate amplifier, sub-woofer and premium speakers. As an added mark of distinction, all audio systems are handsomely framed by rich woodgrain accents (except on the L100).



In addition to providing you with the power to hold your own on today's hyperactive roads, a performance automobile is expected to deliver a smooth ride and excellent responsiveness as you put it through its paces. L-Series models do exactly that. With MacPherson struts up front and independent multi-link suspensions in the rear, gas-pressurized shock absorbers and front and rear stabilizer bars, L-Series sedans and wagons help keep you in close contact with whatever road you're on.





Our Traction Control (included with the optional Anti-lock Braking System) helps you out on slick roads. When a front wheel begins to slip, it adjusts the amount of power being delivered to the wheel, which helps maximize your traction.



It's nice to have that "touring" feeling when driving. That's precisely what our low-effort rack-and-pinion power steering gives you. It has a "C-spring" pre-loaded valve that helps provide the right amount of assistance—whether you're parking or driving down the highway.

Our sport-tuned suspension system (on the L300 and LW300) offers truly impressive control. In addition to standard front and rear stabilizer bars, it has stiffer springs and specially designed Firestone\* tires for precise performance in tight situations.

It's lightweight and compact.

It combines spring and shock absorber into a single unit. It's the MacPherson strut, a key element of the four-wheel independent suspension system found on all Saturn cars. Together with the independent multi-link assemblies in the rear of the car and the stabilizer bars in the front and rear, MacPherson struts work to improve your stability and handling on the road.

To help keep your wheels from locking up during sudden stops, there's our optional Anti-lock Braking System. It adjusts braking pressure much more quickly (up to five times a second) and accurately than you could.




The list of features we've designed to help safeguard you and yours has grown steadily longer over the years. Joining such features as anti-submarining rear seat ramps and child-safety seat top tether anchors, which can already be found on L-Series models, are new features like optional Head Curtain Air Bags and rear center shoulder safety belts (only in sedans). As important as protecting you while you're in your car is, helping to keep unwanted people out of it is also our concern. Which is why we've included an engine-immobilizing anti-theft system, a laser-etched VIN plate, battery run-down protection for interior lights, a remote hood release and a steering column lock. Not to mention remote keyless entry, an anti-lockout feature and an audible theft deterrent (available on all models except the L100).



Sure, this key fob is little, but it's got a lot of power.
As controller of the Saturn Security System (standard on all models except the L100), it enables you to lock and unlock your car's doors, trigger the trunk/liftgate release and set off the panic alarm—all from up to 30 feet away.

Head Curtain Air Bags are designed to help reduce the risk of head and neck injuries to front seat occupants on the near side of certain side-impact collisions. All Saturn models are equipped with driver and front passenger air bags. The primary benefit of any frontal air bag is to help protect occupants in certain collisions by supplementing the protection provided by safety belts. Starting with vehicles produced for the 1998 model year, Saturn modified its air bag design to reduce the force of deployment, helping reduce the risk of deployment injury. However, even with Reduced Force Air Bags, there remain fatal risks to infants in rear-facing infant restraints and to other children who are not properly secured when the air bag inflates. Never secure an infant in a rear-facing restraint in the front seat of any vehicle with an active air bag. Other children are also safer if they ride properly secured in a rear seat. 


