

Parisienne Brougham

First, it is all-Pontiac!

Parisienne has all the virtues of being a Pontiac with all the glamour of being a Brougham.

It gives you a 350 CID V8 and a 3-speed automatic transmission as standard equipment.

It gives you the quick steering response and positive feel of variable-ratio power steering and the extra reassurance of having power front disc and rear drum brakes.

And it gives you the sure handling, the stability and the smooth cornering that come with full-coil suspension, statically balanced wheels and tires and Pontiac's famous Wide-Track. Parisienne performs.

And you get these virtues and more standard! See page 19 for a more complete list of standard features.

And then, it is a Brougham! In addition, your Brougham's steering wheel has its rim cushioned with soft vinyl. It will never feel clammy or too hot. Your deep-pile carpeting extends from sill to sill and well up the doors. There's an electric clock. And other Brougham fineries such as body-colored inserts in the outside door handles plus Deluxe wheel covers.

There's the luxurious upholstery mentioned to your right.

And all this comes in the kind of room you buy a big car for. Room you can enjoy in "closed car" comfort because outside air is drawn into and right through it by

power. It's Pontiac's fullyadjustable powered ventilation system that operates continuously as long as you have the engine running.

All Pontiacs hate noise!

Annoying sounds are tuned out wherever possible. For instance, special seals around the energy-absorbing steering column and in the accelerator pedal cable shaft help insulate you from engine noise.

And the engine itself is built to go quietly as possible about its business.

The roof consists of two steel panels. Stronger roof. Quieter car. The inner panel is perforated with many small holes, very much like an acoustic ceiling. In addition, noise is further cut down by a chamber between the inner and outer roof panels.

Sound deadeners, noise barriers and the liberal use of insulation all work together to make the inside of a Pontiac a

Red accent carpets are available with black and grey cloth trim. Here's something extra.

Buyers of any of our big coupes or sedans might consider a new rear window defroster option that's designed specifically for Canadian winters. It's been thoroughly proved in the extreme cold of northern Ontario. At 20-below. it clears 30% more glass area than a standard blower, does it quickly, improves your heater's efficiency and helps make the rear passenger area even cozier. This extra-cost option feeds engine coolant heated air directly to the rear window.



Catalina

Let's talk about comfort.

Because that's one of the big things on your shopping list if you're considering a new Catalina or any full-size Pontiac.

The 1973 Pontiacs are the most comforting to date.

Full-foam seats, front and rear. The foam is molded in one piece, up to six inches thick, for resilience with firm, cushioned support. The backs are also full-foam. You should feel more comfortable, less prone to fatigue, even after many hours on the road. And you can expect full-foam seat construction to keep its shape longer than other kinds.

Driver fatigue affects safety as well as comfort, of course.

Driving made easier.

Full-coil suspension and especially the design of the front suspension system help stave off driver fatigue by reducing the effort of driving. It all helps, for instance, in giving your car impressive

stability in cross-winds and when passing large trailers or trucks. You make fewer steering corrections. You're more at ease behind the wheel.

Having a big 350 CID V8, 3-speed Turbo Hydra-matic transmission, power steering and power brakes all help you feel more comfortable because you feel more confident. (See list of standard features on page 19.)

All big Pontiacs have many features that, in one way or another, contribute to your comfort.

Linking the engine to the rear axle, there's a constant velocity universal joint for quiet, vibration-free performance. Large, soft body mounts help isolate road noises. Big coil springs on each wheel, selected by a computer according to your Catalina's weight, help give it that smooth Wide-Track ride.

Exteriors of all Pontiacs are finished in a Magic-Mirror process for an exceptionally smooth, fade-resistant and



One of the specialities of Grand Prix has been in keeping outside noise outside. A double panel roof with the inner panel perforated acts as an efficient silencer and is helped by the extended use of acoustical materials.

You can enjoy the quiet with the windows up, too. The air in the passenger compartment is constantly being changed by a powered ventilation system that starts working for you the moment you switch on your engine.

Grand Prix "SJ". Care to indulge even more? There's an SJ option you can order that includes very desirable

features. Such as GR 70 x 15 steel-belted radial ply tires, a unitized ignition system, a battery that never needs service and a rear stabilizer bar. And, oh yes, a 455 CID 4-bbl. V8! Some package!



Grand Ville's standard engine, a 455 CID 4-barrel V8, has a coolant overflow system designed to end engine coolant loss. As pressure builds up in a hard-working engine due to extremely hot days, excessive loads or very hilly terrain this system prevents expanding coolant from spilling out through the overflow tube. It assures a full coolant system at all times.

A '73 Grand Ville should never overheat, even with air conditioning going full blast. And Climate Control is an option Grand Ville customers are often attracted to.





Unless otherwise noted, all options on these pages are available on all 1973 full-size Pontiacs and Grand Prix.



Sound Systems. You can choose from a complete selection of AM, AM/FM or AM/FM Stereo pushbutton radios. Or you may want our integral AM or AM/FM radio and 8-track stereo tape player unit and 4-speaker system (3 on Grand Prix). Two rear speakers come with all stereo systems and a single speaker is available with the AM and AM/FM radios.

A windshield-embedded antenna is standard when you order a radio. Your hidden antenna doesn't intrude on your car's styling.



Tilt Steering Wheel. Adjusts to any one of six different positions for more individual driving comfort. Helps make getting in and out of your car even easier. Not available with standard steering wheel on Laurentian and Catalina.

Defroster/Defogger. Most of our customers have three choices in ways to keep the rear window clear for safer driving.

One. An electrically-heated rear window defroster uses rows of thin wire embedded in the glass to help keep the window surface clear of ice, snow and fog. Not available on Grand Ville Convertible.

Two. A rear window defogger with an electric blower under the package shelf directs air on to the inside of the rear window. Not available on Grand Ville Convertible, Grand Prix.

Three. A new rear window defroster directs engine coolant heated air on to the rear window. This system is a Canadian development and extensive tests have proved it to be highly efficient under all conditions. See story on page 4. Not available on Grand Ville Convertible, Grand Prix.

Dual Exhausts. (Not shown.)
Delivers better performance.
Standard on Grand Prix. An optional engine must be ordered on Laurentian, Catalina, Parisienne Brougham.

Deck-lid Release. Lets you unlock your trunk without getting out of the car. Simply press a button inside the glove box.

It helps to save time and inconvenience and permits driver to remain in car when the weather is inclement.




Power Seat. Just press a button and you can raise, lower, tilt or move forward or backward the entire front bench seat. Helps lessen fatigue on trips and affords greater comfort. With your bucket seat-equipped Grand Prix, power assist is available only for the driver's seat. Moves forward, backward, up, down and tilts.





Electric Door Locks.

Encourages the regular locking of all doors and helps to save time. The master control is mounted on the front door panel on the driver's side and the front passenger's side. Front seat backs of 2-door models automatically lock when doors are closed and unlock when doors are opened (extra cost). Manual unlocking device is still present. Removes any possibility of accidental opening of door by children when car is in motion.



Front and rear rubber-faced bumper guards provide an added measure of protection in parking situations. Full-width rub strips for the new improved front and rear bumpers are also available. Extra protection with style.











Climate Control. Air conditioning? We prefer to call it "climate control" because this option offers you a lot more than a cool car interior on a hot day. It works for you all year 'round.

Whichever system you choose, it will let you ride free of humidity, summer and winter, in the kind of comfort that suits you best, without inside mist on any window and with all windows closed for quieter enjoyment of your car.

Climate control keeps out dust and irritating pollen. It lets you arrive refreshed and perfectly groomed. And returns a good part of your investment at trade-in time.

Choose a fully automatic or manual control system.




Cruise Control. Attain your desired speed, just touch the button on the end of your turn signal indicator and you'll maintain that speed. To disengage, press the brake pedal.






Wheel Covers. Few options can add such instant "dress up". Your dealer can advise you on choice and availability.
