FORD

Front Suspension: Wide 52" tread; drag-strut, Ball-Joint type suspension members with mounting feature that allows slight rearward movement of front wheels, reducing effect of bumps and road faults, Ball joints packed with special 36,000-mile lubricant retained by full-life seals. Rubber-bushed stabilizer helps control roll on turns. Tapered roller wheel bearings with 30,000-mile check interval (repack as required). Specially calibrated shock absorbers with all-weather fluid for softer ride, better year-round control.

Rear Suspension: Wide 62" tread. Three-link, coil spring system with long and short mounting-link arrangement to control dive and squat tendencies in braking, accelerating, Lateral track bar centers sule, resists body sway in turns. All links and track bar rubber-bushed for smooth, quiet operation. Shock absorbers sea-leg-mounted to resist body side movement, have all-weather fluid for more uniform ride control.

Frame: Perimeter design consisting of front end assembly, rear end assembly, and four torque box assemblies connected by formed center siderails. The frame is ladder-type construction with five reinforced crossmembers. Node-point body mounting results in superior noise and vibration suppression characteristics.

Rear Axle: Semi-floating, heavy-duty type with deep-offset hypoid gears. Straddle-mounted drive pinion with three roller bearings. Large diameter axle shafts. High capacity wheel bearings.

Steering: Recirculating-ball type steering gear with antifriction bearings throughout, plus high numerical ratio for easier steering. Flexible coupling in shaft helps insulate steering column and whoel from road shock. Nylon bearings in tie rod and pitman arm pivots reduce steering effort; packed with special 36,000-mille lubricant retained by full-lifle seals. Overall steering ratio 30,9 to 1; with power steering 23 to 1. Turning diameter, approx. 41 tt. Integral Power Steering locates hydraulic mechanism within gear box.

Brakes: Dual master cylinder, separate lines to front and rear. Self-adjusting, self-energizing 11-inch composite drums, grooved for better cooling. Lining area 225 sq. in. Foot-operated parking brake. Power brake has low pedal position. Tires: 4-ply rating black tubeless with Tyrex rayon cord. Safety-type rims. Basic size: 8.45 x 15. Other special tires available. See your Ford Dealer for details.

TORING

Front Suspension: Ball-Joint type with coil springs mounted on upper arms. Angle-Poised for anti-dive control, 36,000-mile (or 3-year) lube intervals. Curved strut-stabilized lower arms. Link-type, rubber-bushed ride stabilizer. Shock absorbers have all-weather fluid for better year-round ride control.

Rear Suspension: Asymmetrical design. Rear axle located forward of spring center to resist squat on braking, takeoff, Extra-long, leaf-type springs with wide spring base for more stable, levelized ride. All-weather shock absorber fluid for more uniform ride control.

Rear Axie: Semi-floating type with deep-offset hypoid gears. Straddle-mounted drive pinion with three roller bearings. Induction-hardened, forged shafts with permanently lubricated wheel bearings.
