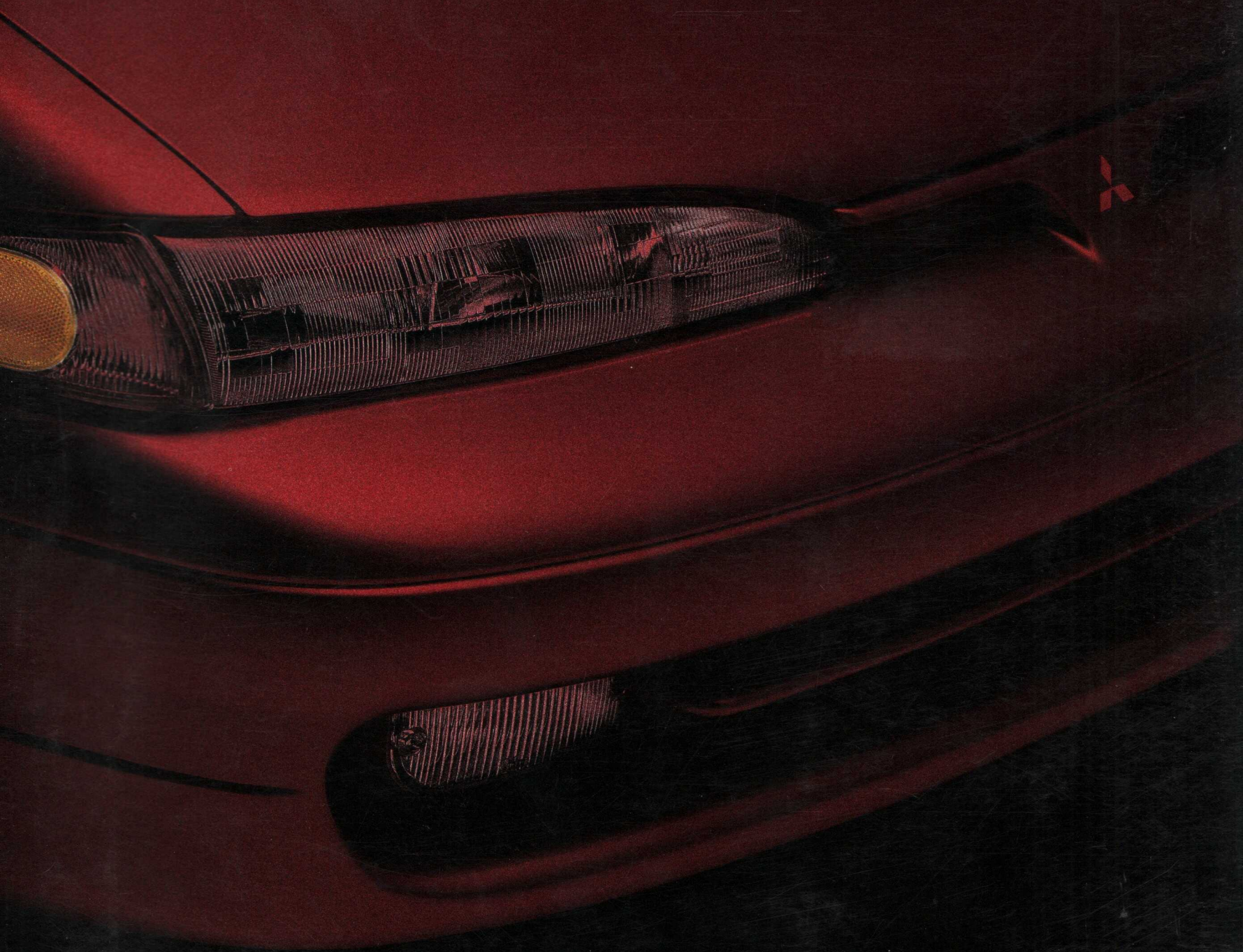

Observing an Eclipse is only half the beauty of it.

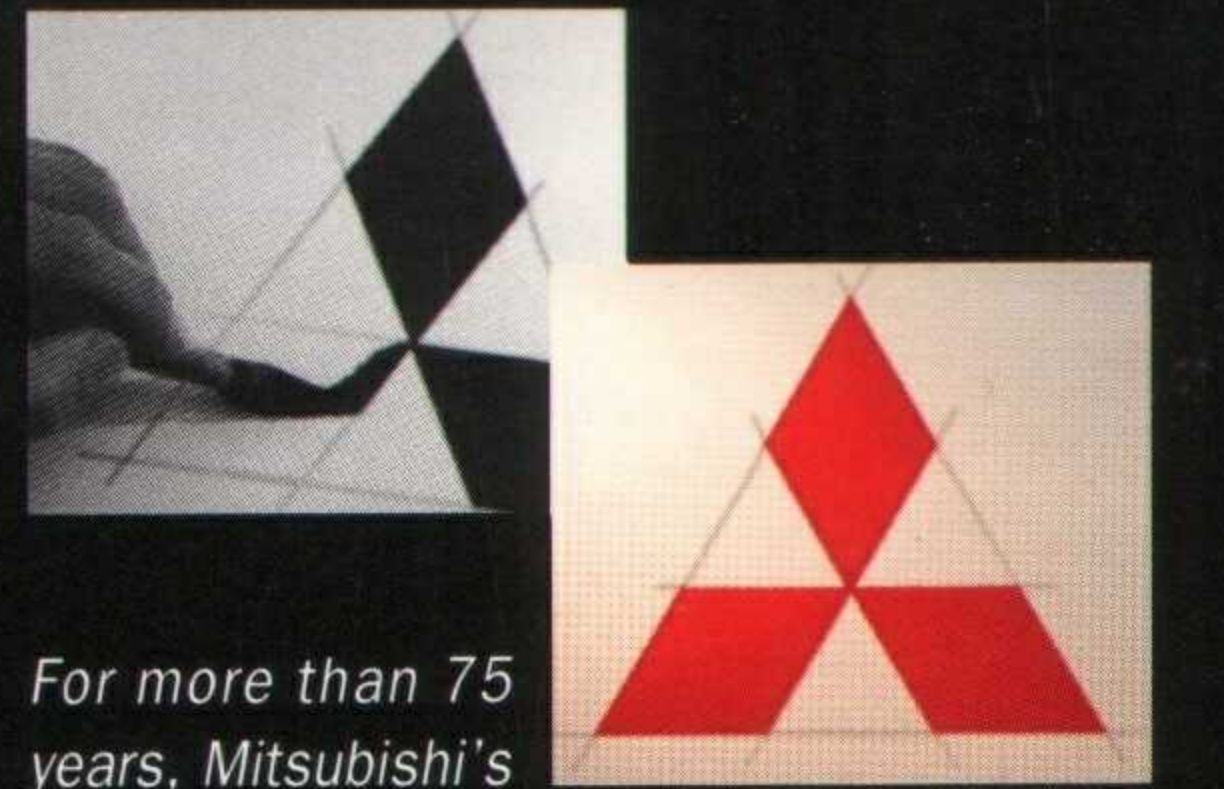

DOHC/TURBO

The Eclipse GS DOHC, shown below in Kalapana Black over Modena Silver Metallic, features a normally aspirated 135-hp 2.0-liter DOHC 16-valve engine, five-speed manual transmission with overdrive, four-wheel disc brakes, wraparound rear spoiler, 16" speed-rated performance tires, rear wiper/washer with intermittent control, air conditioning and available alloy wheels. The Eclipse GS Turbo, not shown, adds a turbocharged, intercooled, 195-hp 2.0-liter engine, gas-charged shock absorbers, alloy wheels and an available anti-lock braking system (ABS).

When it comes to true sports coupe performance, breeding shows.

Scratch the surface of some sports coupes, and underneath you'll find the faint heartbeat of basic transportation. Eclipse, on the other hand, is pure sports coupe through and through. From its lean aerodynamic lines and seamless curves, to its animated performance on any level, this is a sports coupe that will make you believe that driving can truly be fun again.

What captures your eye is the stunning styling of Eclipse. Its stance is low and aggressive, beginning with the sculpted front air dam and integrated fog lamps, sweeping along the wraparound

body side molding to the contoured, slightly elevated rear deck with spoiler.

The 2.0-liter DOHC 16-valve 4-cylinder engine produces 195 horsepower in its turbocharged incarnation, and a don't-take-it-lightly 135 horses in the normally aspirated version. Patented Dual Engine Stabilizers™ neutralize engine vibration, giving you the full benefit of the engine's smooth transition through the gears. A five-speed manual transmission with overdrive is standard on Eclipse, a four-speed automatic overdrive

transmission is optional.

Power-assist rack-and-pinion steering responds deftly to your touch, easing you into and out of tight places, helping you guide Eclipse confidently around curves and down long straight stretches of road. The independent front/three-link rear suspension minimizes imperfections in the asphalt, providing a smooth, stable ride. Large-diameter four-wheel disc brakes bring Eclipse to a smooth, sure stop. The added assurance of an anti-lock braking system is available for the Eclipse GS Turbo.

The GSX interior, shown below with optional gray leather seating surfaces, features a driver's seat that adjusts six ways, including thigh support, side bolster and headrest. A leather-wrapped steering wheel and manual transmission gear shift knob, as well as power windows, door locks, sideview mirrors, air conditioning and a CD player are all standard. The optional leather trim is also available on Eclipse GS Turbo.

A single-disc CD player is available for all Eclipse models.
