Dream No.1 You want a car that handles like a sports car at a price that you can handle.

You've always seen yourself behind the wheel of the winning car at Le Mans. Or Sebring.

A dream that usually ends the minute you get behind the wheel of most cars.

Because most cars don't have the things that sports cars have.

Things that you'll find in Volkswagen's Scirocco. Like a 1.5 liter overhead cam engine. Rack and pinion steering. And 4 wheel independent suspension.

Like front wheel drive. So instead of being pushed through curves and turns by the rear wheels, you're pulled through

by the front wheels.

And a transverse engine. Which gives better balance and road control, because the weight of the engine is between the

front wheels. Not in front of them.

Besides all this front end control, we

gave you something for more rear end control. It's an independent stabi-

lizer axle. If one wheel loses touch with the road surface it will keep the other wheel where it belongs.

And as if all this weren't enough, even Scirocco's

shape has a hand in making it handle so well. That's because we combined the wedge with the hatchback to cut wind resistance. So even when Scirocco is fly-

ing, it still holds the road.
Then to help you bring all this to a stop there's Scirocco's diagonally divided, dual circuit brake system. With power discs in front.
And drums in back.

And just to be on the safe side, Scirocco has an energy absorbing safety steering column. Shock absorbing bumpers. And turn signals that are hard to overlook. Which brings us to Scirocco's price.



We gave it one that makes it the kind of car you don't have to dream about owning.





Dream No. 2 You want a sports coupe, but you don't want to be cooped up.

You like to go places and do things. And in a small car that presents quite a problem.

Because small cars are seldom big on the inside.

However, Scirocco has a comforting solution.

More space. In the interior as well as the trunk.

First, a few words about that eye open ing interior.

You'll see plenty of room to stretch out because the engine is mounted transversely. But you won't see a transmission hump, because we gave Scirocco front wheel drive.

The reclining front seats are body contoured for more comfort. And in back, there's a molded bench seat where you can park packages or an occasional passenger. Naturally, each seat wears what a well dressed seat should wear. Tartan. And the plush interior carpeting makes life a

little softer on your feet. Then, to make

sure you don't blow hot and cold about Scirocco, we gave it an ventilation and heating system.

excellent ventilation and heating system. With air ducts in the doors so no one will suffer from poor circulation.

If you're concerned about Scirocco's trunk space, you can relax. Because even though Scirocco only measures 13 feet from bumper to bumper its trunk measures 12.3 cubic feet. And fold the back seat down and that becomes 18.8 cubic feet.

So if the reason you haven't been sold on a sports coupe is because you don't believe small can be comfortable. you're in for a big surprise.

Scirocco has made your impossible dream possible.







Dream No.3 You want a car that gets you around on less, but still makes you look like you're going places.

You're on your way to the top. Or maybe you're already there.

In either case, you want to look like you've made it.

So Scirocco has the kind of body styling that gets second looks.

And on second look you'll see that its low profile does more than make Scirocco a beautiful car.

This functional combination of the wedge and the hatchback reduces wind resistance. Which helps get better gas mileage.

And that, plus an engine that doesn't need a drink every time you pass a gas station, will get you 35.41 miles to the gallon on the highway, 24-25 in the city.

Of course, gas mileage alone doesn't make a car economical. So we built Scirocco to be a car you'll get a lot of mileage out of.

And to keep it that way, we back it with the VW Owner's Security Blanket. Which covers the repair or replacement of any part which proves defective in material or workmanship, with the exception of tires, filters, fluids and regular maintenance services, for 12 months or 20,000 miles. Whichever comes first."

You'll also be secure in the knowledge that the VW Owner's Security Blanket includes Express Care Service for repairs that take less than 30 minutes. And Free Loan-A-Car service (with prior appointment) for new care warranty repairs that take more than one day.

In addition, there's a 6 month/6,000 mile parts and labor guarantee on all genuine VW parts used in making repairs. And if you happen to need one, your VW dealer can rent you a car at special rates when yours is tied up for non-warranty repairs.

Your new Scirocco can also be hooked up to our computer for a quick and complete checkup. So that we can spot and repair potential trouble. Before the trouble lives up to its potential.

If you're travelling with a fast crowd Scirocco has a leatherette covered steering wheel, a dash with a lot of dash, and dual headlights. All standard equipment.

You also have easy access to Scirocco's accessories. Because for a bit extra, you can add an automatic transmission, a radio, rear mudflaps, bumper guards and

a sporty stripe that spells out the name of your car. All of which could make Scirocco the first car to floor its owner.

Which for some people makes Scirocco a dream come true.
