Then, to add the luxury of fine sound to smooth driving, Jetta is equipped with an AM/FM stereo cassette sound system.

And Jetta has all the other features you've come to expect from a large luxury car. Tinted glass all around. Fully adjustable reclining front bucket seats. With the price of gasoline today a serious consideration, an important Jetta feature is the 1.7 litre fuel injected engine which delivers excellent fuel efficiency allied with remarkable acceleration and smoothness of ride. A CIS fuel injection system is usually only found on more exclusively priced automobiles.

When you want sparkling performance, the 5-speed manual transmission Jetta can take you from 0 to 80 km/h in just 8.8 seconds. Yet Jetta meets fuel emission standards without a catalytic converter and runs on less expensive regular gas.

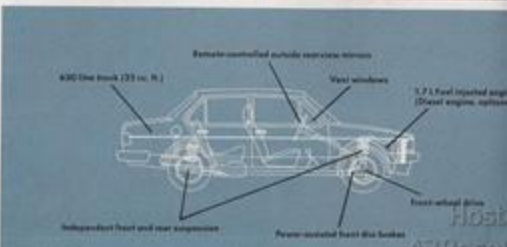
Or consider the Jetta Diesel with its reliability and up to 800 kilometres range on every tankful of fuel.

Test drive Jetta and notice the positive front-wheel drive handling. Take a few bumps and feel how Jetta's four wheel independent suspension smoothes the way. Seek out curves and feel the confidence you get from the precise rack and pinion steering.

For fast, sure stopping, Jetta is equipped with self-adjusting, fist caliper front disc brakes, dual diagonal brake circuits with

power assist and wide (175/70 SR 13) steel belted radial tires.

Jetta is a spacious car that has been designed with the efficiency you expect from Volkswagen. It all adds up to a superb package.

Inside Jetta, four people can relax in complete comfort in full foam seating. The front bucket seats recline. The headrests adjust.

The rear seat backrests are contoured for added comfort. Armrests double as door handles. And solid craftsmanship is in evidence everywhere, from the cut pile carpeting on the floor and lower door panels to the velour or leatherette upholstery.

You expect plenty of luggage space when you buy a large car. And with Jetta, you get it. In fact, the Jetta trunk is gigantic with a full 630 litres (22.2 cu. ft.) exceeding that of many larger automobiles. And Jetta's full size spare shows in its own special compartment under the trunk floor where it doesn't use up any valuable luggage space.

There are many more features to make you comfortable in the Volkswagen Jetta but here's one that's not so immediately obvious. You can relax as you consider that Jetta meets the Canadian Federal/Provincial Anti-Corrosion Code which requires that vehicles remain free from perforation for 60 months or 200,000 kilometres, whichever occurs first. The list of Jetta standard features is impressive but a few factory installed options are available. • Diesel engine • 3-speed automatic transmission • Light alloy wheels • Sunroof • Air conditioner • Passive restraint system which includes automatic front seat belts (if A, with diesel engine or 4-spoke steering wheel) • Also available is a dealer installed optional deluxe Sound System (AM/FM stereo cassette including electronic tuning with digital station and time display and pre-set tuning memory).
