SCIROCCO AND GTI RACING.

The Scirocco, our true high technology sports car, has earned three National Championships, one Trans Am title and was the winning car on the Pro-Solo professional autocross circuit last year.

Scirocco has been nearly unbeatable for three consecutive years, thanks to its advanced 1.8 liter overhead cam fuel-injected gasoline engine, 5-speed close-ratio transmission, sports suspension and rack-and-pinion steering.

On the autocross circuit, Scirocco has won the Pro-Solo by beating such established performance

cars as the Chevrolet Corvette and Mazda RX-7.

The Scirocco's racing partner, the GTI, has been awarded more than its fair share of competitive honors as well.

The GTI was the 1983 Jensen Pro-Solo Stock 2 champion, the overall winner in the Canadian National Highlands Rallye, and based on the Handicap Challenge, the standard Rabbit was the overall champion at several Pro-Solo events.

1984 QUANTUM The 1984 Quantums are grand touring cars in the classic European tradition. Both the Sedan and Wagon share the same advanced German engineering to meet the demands of such world-class performance. Both are powered by the same 2.2 liter, 5-cylinder fuel-injected gasoline engine with 5-speed manual transmission. Automatic transmission and Turbo Diesel are available. Both the Sedan and Wagon also sport power-assisted rack-and-pinion steering and 4-wheel independent suspension. Acceleration is spirited. Handling is particularly agile. And standard cruise control makes long trips an absolute pleasure.

Adding to that pleasure is a long list of standard comfort and convenience features. Including air conditioning, power windows, electronic AM/FM stereo cassette with 4 speakers, a center console with rear seat heat ducts and a central locking system.
