Living with a disability can be both physically and financially challenging. If you use a wheelchair, or have a family member who uses one, you are likely to be looking for mobility alternatives that are effective...and affordable. ☺ As

the world's fourth largest automaker, Volkswagen offers a full range of

vehicles that are well suited for many of the modifications required to accommodate a variety of assistance devices. Our new passenger van, the EuroVan, is already considered by many to be the very best alternative for most mobility access applications. As a mid-sized van, EuroVan combines many of the interior benefits of larger, full-sized vans with the driving ease of minivans. We call it "Big on the Inside, Small on the Outside." ☺ This "Big on the Inside" philosophy results in a van that usually does not need to be

modified for wheelchair accessibility. That means less money spent at the time of purchase, the structure of the vehicle is not altered and the trade-in value is not compromised. ☺ "Small on the Outside" provides you

with a mid-sized van that is actually shorter in length than many minivans. The result is ease of driving, parking and garaging.

And if that were not enough, Volkswagen's Mobility Access Program provides \$1,000 in purchase assistance directly to anyone who buys a EuroVan to transport a full-time wheelchair user.

time wheelchair user. You may qualify whether you install a power lift, wheelchair ramps or choose to use no equipment at all. All we ask is proof that your van will be used to transport a wheelchair dependent person — usually a letter from your physician. • Another part of our Mobility Access Program is \$500 in purchase assistance on any Volkswagen model for any buyer who requires adaptive driving equipment. This differs from the \$1,000 purchase assistance for EuroVan in that proof of full-time wheelchair use is not required. To qualify, we only ask for a copy of your driver's license which indicates an adaptive driving equipment requirement. • For complete details, please see the Mobility Access Program claim form.



As a total package, EuroVan may well offer more benefits, and require less investment, than any other van you could consider:

OPENS HIGH AND WIDE

Every EuroVan model is equipped with a smooth-action sliding side door and a generous 41-inch wide door opening to accommodate nearly every available swing-out or drop-gate lift. The opening is 59.6 inches high, which is ample for most wheelchair users to pass through without requiring any door modifications. If you prefer to install a lift in the back of the van, EuroVan's rear hatch opens up to an even larger 47-inch wide by 51-inch high opening.

LOWEST FLOOR

The standard floor height at the side and rear door is 20 inches — lowest of any van on the market. This low floor means less travel for wheelchair lifts, thus minimum wear over time. Another benefit is the option to use wheelchair ramps in place of the more expensive power lifts. And other passengers will enjoy easier entry and exit thanks to an even lower 15-inch side door step.

PLENTY OF HEADROOM

Even when equipped with rear air conditioning (located in the headliner), EuroVan provides up to 53.7 inches of floor-to-ceiling height. Choose a model without air conditioning and you can have as much as 55.5 inches. This means that, in most cases, there is no need to spend additional money on roof or floor modifications to create adequate headroom. Not only does this save you money initially, but a van that has not been cut and modified is generally more marketable if and when you decide to resell. In addition, you also have the use of your new EuroVan sooner.



HIGH SEATS

Those who transfer from a wheelchair to a seat will appreciate that EuroVan's seats are higher off the floor than in any minivan. With the proper equipment, EuroVan's driver's seat can be adapted to swivel for those who transfer to drive.



ROOM FOR ALL

In many situations, a wheelchair user is only one of several passengers to be transported. In these instances, EuroVan's interior capacity really shines. With the center seat(s) removed, EuroVan provides seating for up to five occupants and still allows enough room for most wheelchairs to enter and be safely secured.

GREAT VISIBILITY

From the driver's seat, any one of the six passenger seats or a properly secured wheelchair, everyone will enjoy EuroVan's fifty-three square feet of tinted safety-glass. Outstanding visibility creates a safer and more enjoyable ride.

AN EVEN TEMPERATURE

To warm up cold days, every EuroVan comes standard with front and rear heaters, each with its own fan-speed and temperature control. For hot days, the EuroVan GL and MV models feature standard front and rear air conditioning. (Rear A/C deleted with optional "Westfender" package.) Vents for the rear air conditioner are mounted in the ceiling to spread cooled air evenly over all passengers.

ALL THE COMFORTS

If you are driving the vehicle, you will also appreciate the ease of standard power-assisted steering and the comfort of the firm seats. Front safety belts are height adjustable, and dials and controls are easy-to-use. GL and MV models also include adjustable armrests for both arms on the driver and front passenger seats.

PRIVACY, TOO

Our MV model features a rear seat that unfolds to a large 72" by 55" bed. Also included as standard equipment are snap-in privacy curtains. Both are handy features for those who spend time traveling and need a place to rest, change clothes or tend to personal needs.

**SAFETY
FIRST**

EuroVan's body is a virtual steel cage of pillars and crossmembers. Consequently, EuroVan has passed NHTSA's* four required crash tests.

But Volkswagen safety engineers went beyond the minimum requirements to make sure EuroVan meets Volkswagen's more rigorous standards. We designed it to pass eight supplemental crash tests, including a fixed barrier front impact test involving 36% more crash energy than NHTSA requires. The result is a van designed to help withstand impacts from every direction — front, rear, side and even rollover.



MOBILITY ACCESS CLAIM FORM

With your Volkswagen retailer's assistance, please complete sections 1 through 4. Note that the purchaser's name must be included with the name on the vehicle purchase agreement.

Send a photocopy of the completed claim form to the address below (keep the original for your records), along with the following:

1) A photocopy of a signed Purchase Agreement (Bill of Sale) for a new, not previously titled Volkswagen model. (Previous Volkswagen company cars and Service Loaner Program vehicles do not qualify.)

2A) For the \$1,000 incentive on EuroVan attach either an original letter from a physician that clearly states that purchaser (or a dependent) is a full-time wheelchair user, or an original paid invoice for a wheelchair lift installation on your new EuroVan.

2B) For the \$500 incentive on any Volkswagen model, attach either a photocopy of your driver's license (front and back) which shows an adaptive driving equipment requirement, or an original paid invoice for an adaptive driving equipment installation on your new Volkswagen.

Note: The \$500 incentive cannot be combined with the \$1,000 incentive. Program applies only to new models purchased by December 31, 1993.
