

The Golf's limited lifetime warranty on frame and chassis through collision damage is just one of many features that make it a great value. Other benefits include: sunroof, power windows, AM/FM stereo cassette with CD changer, central locking system, air conditioning with climate control, a CD player, cruise control, and much more.

entire area to the right of the steering wheel has been angled just enough for easy driver reach. Visibility is excellent with large glass areas and well-positioned rear and side mirrors that reduce blind spots and provide a wide field of vision. But while simplicity is a virtue, in Golf's case that does not mean going without. Golf's seats are orthopedically sculpted with varying foam densities for proper physical support at different points. Front seats are multi-adjustable and the driver's seat cushion maintains the correct parallel angle as the chair height is adjusted. An advanced air flow system refreshes cabin air every 20 seconds when travelling at 55 mph to help keep drivers alert. The optional Deluxe AM/FM stereo cassette system plays through eight high-quality speakers with separate woofers and tweeters. welded front chassis members, "fold" in a predetermined manner on impact to absorb crash energy before it's able to reach the passenger safety cage. The new steering wheel and its collapsible column also act as energy absorbers in front-end collisions. Inside, Golf features driver- and passenger-side
