

mind. Its efficient cross-flow cylinder head design improves performance, its broad torque characteristics offer more power for quick starts and high-way passing, and special engine mounts

reduce noise and vibration. A Motronic® engine management system monitors and automatically adjusts for variables like outside

temperature, altitude, even fuel octane. The result is optimum fuel efficiency, less maintenance and improved diagnostics. Jetta, has other advancements that make it quite drivable. Optimized suspension geometry and spring and shock absorber calibration enhance ride and handling. A rigid unibody structure reduces the tendency to flex and gives it a solid, "one-piece" road feel. Four-wheel independent suspension moves the wheels individually over bumps, isolating any effect on each, again providing for better control and a smoother ride. Unwinding curves is easy with the track-connecting rear axle system illustrated below.

It helps counter over-steer and provides better tracking by allowing the rear wheels to follow closely in line with the front wheels. Tight power rack-and-pinion steering lets Jetta, move about nimbly. And though the pleasure of driving a Jetta, might make you reluctant to do so, on occasion you will need to stop. An optional Anti-lock Braking System (ABS), standard on GLX, allows sure stopping control. Yes, Jetta, may have its roots in another part of the world, but its head and heart lie in- nicely right here in ours.

Much like an egg carton protecting its fragile cargo, Jetta's rigid unibody structure is a safety cage of steel

plates, beams and crossmembers, including side impact bars. Its front and rear crumple zones, made possible by our mash seam welded front chassis members, fold and deform in a predetermined manner on impact to absorb crash energy before it can reach the passenger

safety cage. Inside the passenger compartment itself, Jetta_{GL} features

dual, driver- and passenger-side air bags as standard equipment.*

In the back, two 3-point safety belts and a center lap belt add to the protection. In front, the "rising ramp" style seats help prevent passengers from sliding under the lap belt while positioning them properly for the knee bolsters. To avoid

accidents entirely whenever possible and help a driver react effectively to the surprises of the road, Jetta_{GL} provides a

range of tools. Like an engine powerful enough to make evasive maneuvers when needed. Responsive rack-and-pinion steering for instantaneous

agility. An optional 4-wheel Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) to help prevent wheel lock-up on slippery

surfaces. And all-season, road-gripping tires and a firm suspension to aid with better, precision control. While we're keeping you safe, we're also doing our best to keep the environment safe.

Jetta's polyethylene gas tank—which is protectively located outside the rear crumple zone—can't rust, resists impact, won't leak in the event of an accident and, like all major plastic components we use, it is coded for future resource

recovery. Ozone-depleting CFC's have been removed from the air conditioning system. Paints are lead chromate- and cadmium-free. Brake and clutch linings contain

no asbestos and our service departments are encouraged to participate in oil recycling programs. We strongly believe safety works two ways. Making a car safe for you. And a safe car for the environment. Ultimately, it's the same thing.








