

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

Cabrio's free-spirited fun is based on something very solid: our meticulous attention to function and purpose. And Cabrio isn't a car "converted" from some existing sedan. Every aspect of Cabrio's convertible design has been carefully developed from the ground up. And that shows.

The instrumentation is clear. Controls are within easy reach and reach. Visibility is excellent with large glass areas all around, including a glass rear window, with electric defogger, and well-positioned rear and dual remote side mirrors that reduce blind spots and provide a wide field of vision. Seats front and rear are orthopedically contoured with varying foam densities for proper support at critical points,

The sheet metal Cabrio uses is pre-painted so it's convertible from the ground up, no top or interior that had to be painted off.

Everything is lower, converted (but not flat) and compacted afterwards.



Should you want to keep the outside outside, Cabrio's top is made of six layers of weather-leaving protection and insulation. Just imagine driving in Cabrio's comfort and reduced road noise, too.



One of our more basic protective features, Cabrio's insulated heated glass — not plastic — won't shatter over time. It features an electric defroster to those days you can't see the top floor.



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This is almost no one should ever want, but it's something we do for the benefit of Cabrio owners to help prevent, and in case, such an event might occur, we were able to make sure Cabrio's unique fixed roll bar and other convertible features that would effectively help prevent occurrences in a collision situation.



Let's be candid. Safety in a convertible is something everyone questions. Carrying egg-shell fragile cargo is a concern. Rest assured, a great deal of thought has gone into the safety engineering of the Cabrio. In fact, even though our previous model was rated the top convertible in the small two-door class for safety*, the new Cabrio has been even further refined. After all, you shouldn't have to worry about security just because you like picking up some rays. So Cabrio's been designed to help you survive and, better yet, avoid accidents altogether. Its unibody structure of steel beams, plates and crossmembers, including side-impact door bars, forms a safety cage around the passenger compartment. And with its reinforced lateral structure, Cabrio already meets 1997 side-impact protection requirements. Front and rear crumple zones created by our mesh seam-welded front chassis members, deform progressively in a
