
Dodge Fever is nice to have. But it's easier to cure—with a Polara all your own. Go ahead. Step up to Polara. It's easier than you think.

What better way to put a big-car man in a sporting frame of mind?

Just because you're a big-car man doesn't mean you have to do without a convertible. Or give up bucket seats or 4-on-the-floor. Or a wide choice of horsepower. Or all the other things you want when

you're out gunning for the car that looks and drives as young as you feel.

If you find yourself catching Dodge Fever, keep in mind that Polara has more levels of excitement than many smaller cars. With a lot of extra room to work it all in.

For example, you have two big convertibles to choose from-Polara and Polara 500. You can take your pick of four Dodge V8 engines—the standard 318-cubicinch, a two-barrel 383-cubic-inch* (both running

beautifully on regular gasoline)—or two more high performers that go up to the Dodge 440-Magnum.*

The transmission lineup for Polara goes like this: standard 3-speed manual, full-sync 4-on-the-floor,* and Dodge TorqueFlite 3-speed automatic. Naturally, there are many more options to choose from. (You'll find a partial list of them on the next page.) The beauty of them all is simply this: With Polara, you can add any or all of these things without feeling the least bit crowded. *Optional, at extra cost.

For the man with taste: over 100 ways to exercise it.

Tastes vary, because they are individual and extremely personal. Polara gives you an exceptionally wide choice of optional equipment items. To help you select the ones you'd like to have installed on your '68 Polara, we have arranged them in groupings:

Comfort and Convenience

Polara air conditioning is available several ways. A new Automatic Temperature Control option (which is an extra option, in addition to the regular air-conditioning option) lets you dial the interior temperature desired, and this temperature will be maintained regardless of the outside weather. This means you can order any Polara model with regular air conditioning, or with air conditioning plus Automatic Temperature Control. In addition, for Polara station wagons, you have the option of selecting dual air conditioning, or dual air conditioning with Automatic Temperature Control.

Rear window defogger (except convertibles and wagons)

Four radio options are offered on '68 Polara models: AM radio, AM deluxe radio, AM-FM radio, * AM radio with 8-track stereo-tape player and three instrument-panel-mounted speakers for "orchestra shell" fidelity.



1968 Dodge Polara Specifications

Dimensions

(These are 1968 Polara 4-door-sedan dimensions. Other body styles may vary in some degree.)

Wheelbase 122" Track, front/rear 62.0"/60.7" Overall length 219.0" Overall width 80.0" Overall height 57.1"

Suspension

All Polara and Polara 500 models have torsion bars and ball joints in front, asymmetrical leaf springs in the rear, Oriflow shock absorbers at each wheel. The entire suspension is rubberisolated. A sway bar is standard equipment. A Polara Heavy-Duty Suspension Package (optional, all models) is described on the Optional Equipment page.

Hydraulic, servo-contact, self-energizing, self-adjusting. Bonded linings, Dual Braking System, Parking brake is foot-pedaloperated, with hand-released lever-mechanically actuating shoes on each rear wheel. Master cylinder/parking brake warning light is standard on all models. Polara station wagon brakes are 11 x 3 (front), 11 x 21/2 (rear). All other Polara and Polara 500 models have 11 x 23/4 (front), 11 x 2 (rear). Heavy-duty, manually adjusted brakes (11 x 3, front and rear) are optional, all Polara models. Power brakes are also optional, as are front wheel disc brakes (front disc brakes require optional 15" wheels and tires).

All Polara models (except wagons) . . . 8.25 x 14 (5.5JK wheels). Polara station wagons 8.55 x 14 (6.0JK wheels). 15" wheels and tires are optional on all Polara models and are included when car is equipped with front disc brakes. G70 x 15 Red Streak or white sidewall tires are optional on all Polara models except station wagons.

Electrical System

Battery: 12-volt, 6-cell, 48-amp-hr, standard on Polara and Polara 500 models equipped with 318 V8. 59-amp-hr, standard with 383-cu.-in. engines. 70-amp-hr, standard with 440-cu.-in. engines and optional with other engines.

Alternator: 37-amp, standard, (46-amp standard with air conditioning and optional on Polara models not so equipped.)

Transmissions

Four basic transmissions are offered on 1968 Dodge Polara models. (1) The Polara 3-speed manual, with column-mounted shift lever. It is standard only on models powered by the 318 V8 or 383 (2-bbl.) V8, and not available on Polara models equipped with other V8s. (2) The 3-speed TorqueFlite automatic* has a column-mounted selector (console-mounted in Polara 500 models equipped with optional center console). It is water-cooled, has an aluminum housing, and an internally actuated parking sprag. TorqueFlite automatic is available on all Polara models.

(3) The fully synchronized 4-on-the-floor manual-shift transmission* is available only on Polara 500 models, also equipped with optional 383 (4-bbl.) V8 and optional center console. (4) A special heavy-duty 4-on-the-floor* is available only on Polara 500 models, also equipped with optional 440-Magnum V8 and optional center console.

Rear Axle Ratios

A number of rear axle ratios are offered with each Polara engine and transmission team. Standard ratios have been carefully chosen to provide a balance of performance and economy. However, for more specialized applications, your Dodge Dealer can order your Polara or Polara 500 delivered with a more

You will also want to consider the many advantages offered by the Dodge Sure Grip differential (optional, at extra cost). In sand, snow, and mud, power is transferred to the rear wheel with the better traction. *Optional, at extra cost.

440 V8 is offered on wagons only; 440-Magnum V8 is offered on all other models, except wagons.

Trailer-Towing Package

A Trailer-Towing Package for Dodge Polara models is required for towing trailers with a loaded gross weight of 2,500 lbs, and not exceeding 5,500 lbs. A frame-type load-equalizing hitch is required for trailers having a loaded tongue-weight of 250 lbs. (Hitch not supplied by Dodge.)

Basic equipment includes: maximum cooling system with highcapacity radiator. Larger 7-blade fan. Fan shroud and hood seal. Heavy-duty performance axle, 3.23 ratio. Heavy-duty suspension, front and rear, with sway bar and station wagon shock absorbers. Special, 11" diameter, heavy-duty brakes (manually adjustable). Heavy-duty turn signal flasher. Heavy-duty stoplight switch. Wide-rim, 6-JK wheels.

Trailer-Towing Package is not available on Polara models with 318-cu.-in. V8.

The following, extra-cost equipment is also required: 383 (2-bbl.) V8. TorqueFlite automatic transmission. 8.55 x 14 tires (except station wagons); 8.55 x 14 8PR tires on wagons.

Recommended, additional optional equipment for trailer towing: Sure Grip differential. High-output, 46-amp alternator. Heavy-duty, 70-amp-hr battery with rubber separators and battery heat shield. Power brakes. Air conditioning. High-performance engines like the optional 383 (4-bbl.) V8, 440 (4-bbl.) V8 or 440-Magnum. Automatic Speed Control.

WARRANTY

Chrysler Corporation warrants to the first and second registered owners the engine block, head and internal parts, intake manifold, water pump, transmission case and internal parts (except manual clutch), torque converter, drive shaft, universal joints, rear axle and differential, suspension system (except shock absorbers). steering gear and linkage system, wheels and wheel bearings of its 1968 automobiles for 5 years or 50,000 miles, whichever occurs first, and all other parts (excluding tires) for 24 months or 24,000 miles, whichever occurs first, against defects in materials and workmanship and will repair or replace such defective parts without charge for parts or labor at any Dodge, Chrysler, Plymouth or Imperial Authorized Dealer's place of business. Maintenance, such as replacement of spark plugs, condensers, ignition points, filters, brake and clutch lining, etc., and normal deterioration of hoses, belts, upholstery, soft trim and appearance items are not included. Maintenance services required under the warranty are: Change engine oil every 3 months or 4,000 miles, whichever occurs first, and replace oil filter every second oil change; check operation of crankcase ventilator valve and clean oil filler cap every 6 months and replace ventilator valve every year; clean carburetor air filter every 6 months and replace every 2 years; lubricate front suspension ball joints and tie rod ends at 3 years or 36,000 miles, whichever occurs first; and every 12 months, (A) have an authorized Dodge, Chrysler, Plymouth or Imperial Dealer certify on an approved Warranty Validation form (i) receipt of evidence of performance of the required services and (ii) the car's then current mileage, and (B) the owner must submit such completed form to Chrysler Motors Corporation. To qualify for continuing warranty coverage, the second registered owner must have an authorized Dodge, Chrysler, Plymouth or Imperial Dealer submit a Transfer of Warranty form to Chrysler Motors Corporation within 30 days from the date of his purchase and receive from Chrysler Motors Corporation validation that the vehicle is eligible for such coverage.
