THE 1974 FURY

Every 1974 Plymouth Fury has been beautifully and completely restyled from front to rear. They also have several engineering differences that could make a difference in the next car you buy. Plymouth tough is beautiful.

Outside, the Furys have a crisp, new hood, roof and reardeck profile. The body is highlighted by tastefully appointed, highly decorative bright moldings.

Inside, Fury styling takes on a fresh, contemporary look with loop-pile carpeting, a new modular instrument panel and new interior fabrics and appointments.

The 1974 Furys are also designed to be quiet. Thanks to plenty of new acoustical materials, sound deadeners and a new tuned exhaust system.

Comfort, convenience and performance features put the 1974 Fury in a class by itself. Standard features include TorqueFlite automatic transmission, power steering, power front disc brakes, Electronic Ignition System, Torsion-Quiet Ride and new, upper-level ventilation on all Fury models.

Some of the items listed above are the engineering differences you'll find in every 1974 Fury. More information on these differences can be found on pages 10 and 11.

GRAN COUPE & GRAN SEDAN

The 1974 Gran Coupe and Gran Sedan are the sleekest, most beautiful Furys we have ever built.

They have been completely restyled . . . and we've even made distinctive, dual paint stripes and deluxe wheel covers standard features on both beautiful models.

We've increased the glass area on the 1974 models-over 25% on 4-door hardtops-for improved driver and passenger ing comfort. Designed a new modular instrument panel that lets you reach every button and switch . . . even with your seat

belts fastened . . . and added a new bin-type glove box that has a handy coin holder.

Other Gran Coupe and Gran Sedan features include a threespoke padded steering wheel, an electric clock and a 400-CID 2-barrel V-8 engine that runs on regular or low-lead fuel. All standard.

You also get all of the Chrysler Corporation engineering visibility. Made upper-level ventilation standard for added driv- differences like TorqueFlite automatic transmission that requires no maintenance under normal driving conditions, and electronic ignition that has no points or condenser to replace.

For example, the cloth-and-vinyl split-back bench seat with the center fold-down armrest that is shown below was selected for Fury because it's been designed to give you many miles of riding comfort. It's available in blue, gold, black, green or parchment. There is also an all-vinyl interior available as a no-cost option in the same colors.


We've matched up our elegant interiors with a new modular

instrument panel that's as functional as it is beautiful. It has all of the operational controls left of the steering wheel and all the comfort controls on the right. All within easy reach. The design is such that it will give you a more personal feel when you drive your 1974 Plymouth Fury.

Since you'll probably be spending many hours of motoring in your Fury, here are a couple of ways to add more pleasure and comfort. You can start with any of our new family of radios that includes an optional AM/FM stereo radio with 8-track stereo tape. An electronic digital clock that has been certified by the Swiss government as a chronometer and accurate to within a minute a month. A new air conditioning system with automatic temperature control, or a Tilt and Telescope steering wheel. Another convenience option is our 50/50 Brougham bench seat with dual center armrests, individual adjustments and passenger-side recliner (4-door models).







Value can be beautiful, too. Especially when you consider that we've made a 360 cubic-inch V-8 engine standard equipment on every Fury III, Fury II and Fury I in '74.

When you add this to Fury features like unibody construc-

When you add this to Fury features like unibody construction, torsion-bar suspension, a TorqueFlite automatic transmission, an electronic voltage regulator, power steering and power disc brakes up front, you can understand why this year's Fury is a value leader. There's also Fury's Electronic Ignition System which, due to its higher starting voltage, helps start your Fury in any kind of weather and cuts your ignition tune-up costs down to spark-plug replacement at about 18,000-mile intervals. In addition, there are no points or condenser to replace.

Speaking of beauty, we have added ten new colors to this year's Fury line to bring the total to 18.

And if you'd like to top your Fury off with something really

special, there are vinyl roofs in six colors, available for all models.

We've also made some other improvements we're sure you'll like. All Furys, for instance, have a redesigned suspension and long-leaf springs in the rear to contribute to our Torsion-Quiet Ride. We've also made upper-level ventilation standard, so you and your passengers can enjoy better interior air movement.

FURY III, FURY II AND FURY I INTERIORS


The beautiful cloth-and-vinyl bench seat, shown below, is standard on all 1974 Fury III models. The seats come with a thick, comfortable foam padding. They're available in green, black, gold, blue or parchment. Also available, but not shown, is a standard all-vinyl trim for Fury I in green, black, or gold. A standard cloth-and-vinyl trim for Fury II in green, black, or gold plus an optional all-vinyl trim for Fury III in green, gold or parchment. And an optional parchment all-vinyl 50/50 bench seat with passenger-side recliner for Fury III 4-door models. Ask your dealer to show you all of the standard and optional interiors available on Fury III, Fury II and Fury I models.

SOME TOUGH-TO-BEAT FURY FEATURES

Whichever Fury you pick, you're sure of getting a full measure of comfort, safety and convenience features. For openers, all Furys have a new bumper impact-absorption system that includes hydraulic energy absorbers. There's also more glass area on all the Fury 4-door models. There's even a convenient bin-type glove box that has a built-in coin holder. To give driver and passengers more interior comfort, we increased front and rear leg room on all of this year's 4-door sedans. Whatever you decide to take along with you, there's plenty of room for it in the 20.4 cubic-foot Fury trunk. Also standard on all Furys is an inside hood release.



Then add front torsion bars. They help absorb bumps, while a sway bar helps keep the Fury level. Then add our new tuned exhaust system, roof silencers, sound deadeners, silencer pads,

and door and window seals, and you'll start to understand what Torsion-Quiet Ride is all about, and why this year's Fury gives a new degree of quiet.

More Power To You.

Our standard engine lineup is the best Fury has ever offered. The Gran Coupe and Gran Sedan come with a 400 cubic-inch V-8. The Fury III, Fury II and Fury I are powered by a 360 cubic-inch V-8. An optional engine for all Furys is a 440 cubic-inch V-8. And all engines run on regular or low-lead fuel.

For increased convenience, we've also added a new 25-gallon fuel tank and a coolant reserve system for 1974.

An Ignition System That's Plenty Dependable.

Our Electronic Ignition System has no points or condenser to replace, and spark plugs need only be replaced at about 18,000-mile intervals. You also get consistently higher starting voltage—by as much as 35%—to help you start in any kind of weather.



dip-and-spray rust preventative. Every Fury is cleaned, coated, sprayed with two coats of primer, baked, sanded, then painted with two coats of tough acrylic enamel. Then it's baked again.

We also protect you once you get rolling, with a new collapsible steering column, rugged side impact beams and our new hydraulic impact-absorption bumper system that is designed to protect your Fury's front and rear from damage at speeds up to 5 mph. There's also a new passenger restraint system (color-keyed shoulder and lap belts) with starter interlock to help keep you secure.

FURY TRAILER-TOWING PACKAGES

If you plan on towing something with your 1974 Fury, be sure to include one of our fine trailer-towing packages in your order.

That way, you are sure of getting the electrical system, the components and the weight-to-horsepower ratio that is right for your Fury. And our packages are complete for your trailer-towing needs.

For example, our optional Heavy Trailer-Towing Package (A35) has been designed for total loaded trailer weights up to 7,000 pounds. This year, it has many new features. A new, dual

battery-charging system that charges both the trailer battery and the car battery at the same time... and a new, 65-ampere heavy-duty alternator that is designed for heavy trailering. There's also the 7-wire harness (most systems only have a 5-wire) that ties all of the Fury's electrical wiring into one neat package. There is a single, 7-pin connector for back-up lights, taillights, brake lights and turn signals, electric trailer brakes, trailer battery and ground wire.

There's also a load-distributing hitch platform, that attaches

to the Fury's understructure to help distribute the trailer tongue weight evenly.


The Heavy Trailer-Towing Package has an electric brake controller that mounts on the regular brake pedal and stops the car and trailer simultaneously when activated. The electric brake controller is adjustable for brake proportioning between tow vehicle and towed unit. Other features of the Heavy Trailer-Towing Package include wide wheel rims, heavy-duty suspension, maximum cooling system, auxiliary transmission oil cooler and variable-load turn-signal flasher. If the total

loaded trailer weight is 2,000 pounds or less, our optional Light Trailer-Towing Package (A34) is not required but is recommended. It includes the 7-wire harness and connector, variable-load turn-signal flasher and load-bearing hitch with ball.


There are also a number of options available that will make towing more pleasant... including large trailer-towing mirrors (dealer-installed) that provide a clear view of everything behind or coming up alongside of you and your trailer.


