

If you choose the Dodge 600 ES there's a standard electronic instrument cluster that includes oil pressure, voltage, fuel and temperature gauges plus speedometer, odometer and tachometer. The standard Electronic Voice Alert system (on Dodge 600 ES) monitors 11 of the car's vital functions, tells you, in a softly modulated voice if any condition requires correction. The choice of seating is widely varied. Consider these:

• Dodge 600 2-Door Coupe. Standard. Clothand-vinyl high-back bucket seats with integral head restraints, reclining seat-backs. And a shift-lever console is available. An optional free-standing centre armrest is available with the console. In beige, brown, blue, charcoal or red. Or, with automatic transaxle, you can choose a cloth-and-vinyl bench seat with folding centre armrest and adjustable head restraints. In beige, blue, brown, charcoal or red.

- Dodge 600 Convertible. Has all-vinyl, lowback bucket seats with adjustable head restraints and reclining seat-backs. Includes a shift-lever console with free-standing centre armrest. In beige, red, or red-and-white.
- Dodge 600 and 600 ES 4-Door Sedan. Standard upholstery is cloth and vinyl high-back bucket seats with integral head restraints and reclining seat-backs. Colour choices are beige-and-brown, red or silver-and-charcoal. A shift lever console with free-standing armrest is available. 


## Dodge 600 Turbocharged Engine . . . the big news in peformance for 1984

Begin with the proven performance (more than 20-billion owner-driven miles) of Chrysler's 2.2-litre Trans-4 engine. Add a Garret Research 13 Turbocharger. Result: 142 horsepower. A multi-point electronic fuel injection system employs a Bosch throttle body, fuel injectors, regulator and fuel rail. An electric fuel pump delivers fuel to the regulator, and idle speed is controlled with an automatic idle speed unit. Chrysler engineers have taken special pains to make sure that all this power is properly controlled on the road. The newly designed front suspension with its improved Iso-Strut system has been modified to incorporate special high-performance components. Firm-feel power steering gear, power front discs and drum rear brakes have similarly been modified to meet high-performance demands. Afficionados needn't be told what the new turbocharged 2.2-litre engine means in terms of standing-start acceleration and passing power. It's the kind of power that has been exhilarating drivers since rubber was first put to the road.




Chrysler's achievements in recent years is unquestionably the ability of the Chrysler engineering team to put its expertise, experience and intuition to work in getting the best from the new techno-


men and women involve themselves in are myriad: complex stress-calculations in the bodydesign laboratories; aerodynamic testing in scale and full-size windtunnels; trial assembly of prototypes and exploration of new production techniques at Chrysler's Clairpointe "mini-plant"; vehicle handling evaluation on the twisting backroads and the high-speed oval at Chrysler's 4000-acre Proving Grounds; air conditioning and and ventilation testing at the height of the summer in Arizona; cold-start and fuel-system testing in January in Kapuskasing, Northern Ontario; month-in, month-out laboratory rig-testing of hinges, electric motors, switches, linkages, seat structures; acceleratedcorrosion destruction of import and domestic competitors' vehicles. All these are just some of the projects being undertaken to maintain the momentum that has brought Chrysler recognition as a builder of front-wheel-drive vehicles of world-class quality, reliability and durability, qualityengineered to be the best.

The results are not always readily apparent in the showroom. Real quality is much more than skindeep. In recent years, there has been a co-operative program by Chrysler design areas to reduce NVH - Noise, Vibration and Harshness. For 1984, the means to achieve this varies from model to model – improved door frameto-side glass sealing on one, tighter spare-tire compartment covers and seals on another, improved motor-mount alignment on yet another - small but significant improvements intended to make Chrysler cars run whisper-quiet. Likewise the continued emphasis on the reduction and elimination of corrosion and rust. Again, the improvements for 1984 vary with the model, but in general, there is even more extensive use of galvanized, galvanealed, zincrometal and zinc plated steels, fibreglass, plastics, and special paints and primers. These improvements may not be instantly obvious in the new-car showroom, their worth much further down the road.



In truth, there is probably no part, no surface, no joint in Chryslerbuilt vehicles that is not subject to some sort of engineering scrutiny to determine where improvement might be possible. In the manufacturing processes the same objective and uncompromising approach is built into the Chrysler Quality Assurance Program that embodies more than 200 separate inspections.
