Comanche and Cherokee have the smooth ride and precise handling of exclusive Quadra-Link® front suspension. Every Jeep vehicle has exceptional ground clearance. Steel skid plates provide protection for the fuel tank and transfer case (standard on Wrangler; optional on Comanche and Cherokee).



Whenever conditions dictate, you can shift into Wrangler's Command-Trac four-wheel drive without stopping. This enables you to muscle your way through mud, make tracks in snow, and keep the fun going no matter what the road conditions. For even more severe




conditions, you can shift into 4WD Low range.
This low-speed gear puts Wrangler's power to work in situations that would stop an ordinary vehicle cold. To minimize pitch, Wrangler's multi-leaf springs are mounted to solid axles. A front stabilizer bar helps keep Wrangler level during cornering. 15-inch wheels

and tires are standard, as are power brakes.


Wrangler's optional Off-Road Package (available on Base and Islander) gives you what you need to conquer the toughest conditions. It includes heavy-duty gascharged shock absorbers, draw bar, and tow hooks.



Wrangler's high-output 4.0 litre 6-cylinder engine leads its class with 180 horsepower @ 4750 rpm and 220 footpounds of torque @ 4000 rpm. Combine it with a 5-speed manual overdrive transmission or optional 3-speed automatic (with 4.0 litre only).

## The Battle For Control Is Finally Over.

Mud, rain, snow, bumps. These are the hostile elements that can threaten your freedom of movement. Thankfully, Jeep Cherokee has a strategy for overcoming such ground attacks.

It starts with a strong power base: the high-output 4.0 litre Power-Tech Six engine. Standard on most Cherokee models, it delivers 190 horsepower, over 20 percent more than the engine of Ford Explorer. That's more power for passing, climbing, hauling, and towing. It's matched to the standard 5-speed manual transmission or the optional 4-speed automatic overdrive transmission (standard on Briarwood and Limited). Meanwhile, Cherokee Base offers as standard the 2.5 litre

4-cylinder MPI engine.

For slogging through treacherous terrain, nothing beats shift-onthe-fly four-wheel drive. Cherokee offers two systems: standard Command-Trac part-time and optional Selec-Trac full-time.







With two-wheel ABS, the front wheels can still lock up, which can cause the driver to lose directional control of the vehicle during heavy braking. With driver maintains steering control during braking.

The optional four-wheel anti-lock brake system is designed to prevent lockup on especially wet or slippery surfaces. Unlike the system used by Ford, Jeep ABS operates in either two- or four-wheel drive and on all four wheels.

There's 35.7 cubic feet of cargo room with the rear seat in place and 71.8 cubic feet when it's folded.

Choose from five models-Base, Sport, Laredo, Briarwood, and Limited. Laredo, Sport, and Base are avail-

Every one has the strength of UniFrame construction. This integrated frame-and-body unit provides outstanding durability without excessive weight.



maximum traction and security. For the most severe conditions, shift into 4WD Low for maximum low-speed traction.






