






Pressure, as high as 750 pounds per square inch, is developed by an engine-driven pump and transmitted through high pressure hoses to a control and actuating system built into the steering gear. Turning your steering wheel operates this system, applying just the right pressure automatically and directing it to turn the wheels the way you select. As you complete your turn, the pressure ceases and the steering wheel returns to straight-ahead on your new course.
