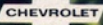

## Impala Custom Coupe

Chevrolet's newest luxury liner for 1968. Clean-lined styling is topped by distinctive roof with vertically inclined rear window and formal rear side windows. New are smoothly sculptured front fenders, front and rear side marker lights, upswept hood styling sheltering a dramatically improved windshield wiper system (besides the Hide-A-Way styling, the left wiper is specially articulated to sweep more windshield area). Bringing up the rear: new crisp contoured rear fenders, longer deck and deep-section bumper with recessed triple taillights. Inside, plush as you could expect and more. Full cushion seats in new textured pattern cloth with tufted pleats and vinyl borders. Or you might want to order an all-vinyl interior in black, blue, parchment/black, teal or gold. Get even more individuality by electing Super Sport equipment (more details on pages 10 and 11) and Astro Ventilation.

## Impala Sport Sedan

Here's a happy combination of limousine ride and room with sportster flair. First, the ride: smooth and level, thanks to four husky coil springs eating up bumps and four double-acting shock absorbers ironing things out. Special cushioned body mountings help soak up thumps and jiggles. Chevrolet's always been a leader in roominess and the 1968s carry on the tradition. You'll find lots of stretch-out space behind four wide-opening doors. Luxury is evident everywhere, in the smart textured pattern cloth and vinyl upholstery, thick deep-twist carpeting. Do your own interior decorating and order an all-vinyl interior. Sportster flair comes from the forward thrusting front fenders and sleek 4-door hardtop styling (you also can get '68 Impala features in a regular 4-door sedan version). Give yourself even more in sporty luxury: order Impala Sport Sedan with 325-hp Turbo-Jet 396 V8 and Turbo Hydra-Matic.

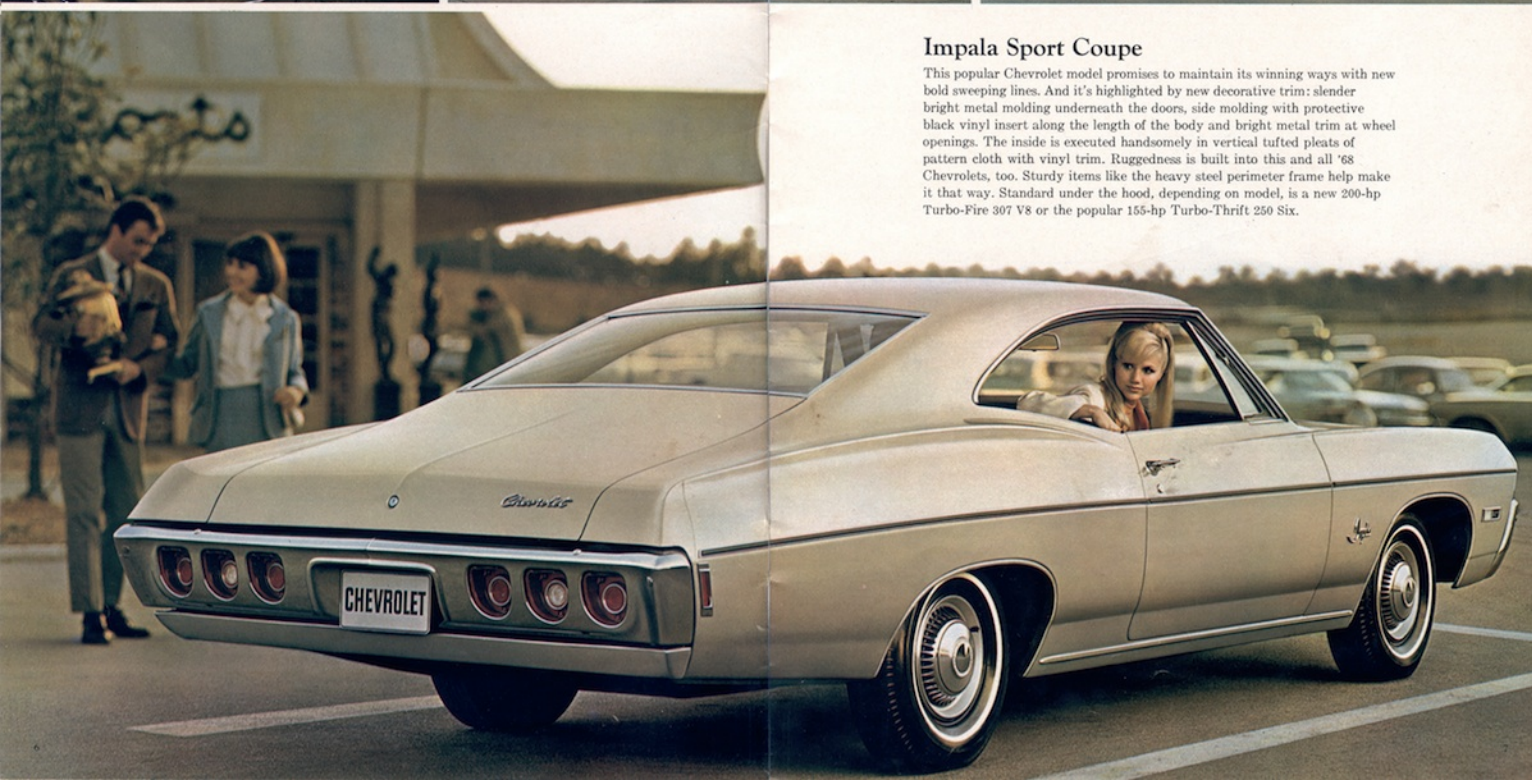






## Impala Sport Coupe

This popular Chevrolet model promises to maintain its winning ways with new bold sweeping lines. And it's highlighted by new decorative trim: slender bright metal molding underneath the doors, side molding with protective black vinyl insert along the length of the body and bright metal trim at wheel openings. The inside is executed handsomely in vertical tufted pleats of pattern cloth with vinyl trim. Ruggedness is built into this and all '68 Chevrolets, too. Sturdy items like the heavy steel perimeter frame help make it that way. Standard under the hood, depending on model, is a new 200-hp Turbo-Fire 307 V8 or the popular 155-hp Turbo-Thrift 250 Six.







## Impala Convertible

Top down or up, here is a car that puts real zest in driving. Swing open that big door (hung on new sturdier hinges). Sit on the inviting deep-cushion seat and look around at the plush all-vinyl upholstery, deep-twist carpeting that even covers lower door panels. Grasp the new oval steering wheel with its glare-reducing trim. Check out the instrument panel's new design—larger, easy-to-read instruments, recessed control knobs. An Impala Convertible can put color in your cheeks and your life. It comes in 15 Magic-Mirror colors—12 of them brand new. Three top color choices—black, blue and white—are available. In every choice, the rear window is glass. For responsive performance, order Chevrolet's new 250-hp Turbo-Fire 327 V8 coupled to the standard fully synchronized 3-Speed gearbox. Specify sportier going with the fully synchronized 4-Speed unit with floor-mounted shift.

## Impala SS Coupe

Specify the SS version of an Impala Coupe and you've got a car that's Something Special. Outside, take your pick of roof lines—classic Custom Coupe or sweepback Sport Coupe. Inside, it's driver's choice. A color selection of all-vinyl interiors are available for bucket-seat fans. Handsome center console with storage compartment divides the buckets. Special upholstery is of tufted vertical vinyl pleats with contrasting trim. Stand out even more from the crowd by blending in the SS 427 package that you can order. It includes simulated hood intake, SS 427 emblems, red stripe (or white stripe) wide-oval tires, 15" x 6" wheels, special suspension components, large-diameter front stabilizer bar and, finally, what it's really all about, the 385-hp Turbo-Jet 427 V8 engine.

## Impala SS Convertible

For the ultimate in topdown travel, specify the Impala SS Convertible. Put yourself completely in command by ordering the fully synchronized 4-Speed gearbox. Or elect the Turbo Hydra-Matic and get a two-way unit: it shifts for itself through three forward ranges, or lets you shift for yourself. Go with the new standard 200-hp V8 or specify one of four other V8s with up to 385 horsepower (that 385-hp V8 gives you the basis to order the SS 427 package, too). Bring it to a halt with smooth fade-resistant stopping power by ordering refined front wheel disc brakes. Inside, Strato-bucket seats, center console and all the other SS package goodies. As with all '68 Chevrolets, you're getting that solid sound- and weather-insulated Body by Fisher, Full Coil suspension and cushion-mounted power team.

## Caprice Coupe

Distinguished luxury, to be sure. New roof line with steeply sloped rear window and smaller rear side windows. New full side glass window to give you a better view—there are no ventpanes to interrupt Caprice Coupe's classic lines. And, a new Astro Ventilation system that pressure-flows outside air into and out of the passenger compartment without opening a window. Four posh interior choices in large tufted and buttoned panels of fine cloth. Colors: black, blue, gray-green or gold. You can order Strato-back front seat with folding center armrest and individual backrests or Strato-bucket front seats with center console. Doors reveal center panels with the rich look of hand-rubbed walnut and Caprice insignia.





## Caprice Sedan

The grandeur of the Caprice Sedan should be fully appreciated through first-hand experience. Run your eye over the sleek town car styling: impressive grille split by trim front bumper, smooth contoured fenders containing standard fender lights, upswept hood forming a protective cover for the new Hide-A-Way windshield wipers, distinctive side moldings and exclusive Caprice signatures. Know, too, you can have extras to add to the styling by ordering new concealed headlights that appear or disappear at a switch touch; also sporty rear fender skirts. Open any door and interior lights come on instantly. Settle into extra-deep cushion seats. There's a convenient center armrest in front. Or you can order a Strato-back front seat which also has a center armrest. For even greater comfort, specify the new Astro Ventilation system.

## Bel Air Sedans

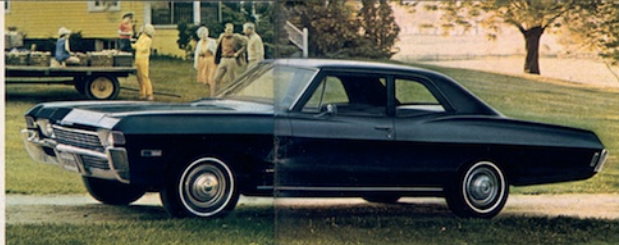
Bel Air beguiles value seekers with great looks and worth. Available in 2- and 4-door versions, it has style and then some. The broad hood sweeps up to hide windshield wipers; trim sturdy front bumper protects around front fenders; flowing body lines are decorated with an attractive side molding that affords parking lot protection. Bright metal rear window, roof drip and windshield moldings trim Bel Air handsomely. There's more: standard front and rear side marker lights, dual taillight units recessed neatly into the deep-section rear bumper. Quality is the inside byword. Foam cushioned seats are finished beautifully in pattern cloth of vertical pleats with vinyl trim. Order all-vinyl if you prefer. In any case, vinyl covers doors and sidewalls. Floors are finished in deep-twist carpeting. You also get Chevrolet's famed road-sure ride, courtesy of wide-stance chassis design and Full Coil suspension. For especially pleasant going, order a Bel Air with Powerglide, Positraction (for surest road gripping ability) and pushbutton AM radio.

## Biscayne Sedans

Say Biscayne and you've just discussed economy by the carload. Flush-and-dry rocker panels that clean themselves to resist rust, Safety-Master brakes that adjust themselves and a big Delcotron generator that gives the battery a charge even while idling. There's extra value, too, in the durable Body by Fisher. Its Unisteel design is meant to keep '68 Biscaynes around for a long while, with roof, sides, floor and pillars welded into a single tough unit. Double-wall or double-panel construction reinforces cowl, doors, hood and deck lid. Even with all this talk of economy and value, there's no scrimping on your safety. Biscayne looks after you with all the standard Chevrolet safety features, including energy-absorbing instrument panel, GM-developed energy-absorbing steering column, dual master cylinder brake system with warning light. Get Biscayne—in 2- or 4-door model—with the fuel-miserly 155-hp Turbo-Thrift Six or 200-hp Turbo-Fire 307 V8, both standard depending on model selected.





## 1968 Chevrolets Are Filled with More Value Features Than Ever

Chevrolet value features are those important details that make your 1968 Chevrolet a better car to own and operate, one that's traditionally worth more at trade-in time, too. Each feature is specifically designed to increase your comfort, safety, convenience and enjoyment. They all add up to "that sure feeling" of Chevrolet.

For instance, on the safety side, there are items like the new front and rear side marker lights that announce your car's presence to motorists on either side.

The new upswept hood and cowl styling provides sheltered storage for the Hide-A-Way windshield wiper system. This gives the cowl its clean aerodynamic lines as the wipers are hidden when not in use. Then, too, the blades are sheltered from sleet, snow, dust and sun. And about that new wiper system. The engineers took the time-honored two-speed system and redesigned it to sweep more windshield area. To do this, they devised a special hinged arm for the left wiper. They call it "articulated." We call it "better."

Step out back and one of the first things you'll notice is the soft-curve styling of the '68 Chevrolet's rear fenders, deck lid and bumper. Note the taillights—triple units on Caprice and Impala, dual units on Bel Air and Biscayne—have been recessed in the deep-section bumper, giving a smoother look to the stern. While you're back there, open up that deck lid. Check the effortless opening and closing you get with counterbalancing. Then examine the low trunk sill that means easier loading and unloading. Finally, there's the gaping trunk itself with 17.0 cubic feet of usable space.

Look inside. Chevrolet interiors for '68 are very, very plush—more padding has been added for your increased safety and comfort.

There's attention to such details as bigger padded armrests shielding new lever door handles.

Now let your eye sweep over the instrument panel. As you might suspect, it's new. The instrument cluster has been positioned up high, with large rectangular housings for fuel gauge, speedometer and clock (standard on Caprice models) so you can read them instantly. Indicator lights for oil level, generator, temperature and parking brake are placed right below the speedometer for easy, quick viewing. All knobs and switches are recessed for greater safety. Speaking of switches, the one for the ignition has a new warning buzzer that sounds if the key is left in either the "off" or "accessory" position when driver's door is opened. Finally, at the driver's seat, there's a new oval steering wheel with glare-reducing metal trim.

Astro Ventilation is a new Chevrolet feature that's standard on the Caprice Coupe. You'll notice that in the Coupe, elegant new styling takes in large full-door side windows—the small vent windows are missing. It makes the lines more flowing. What's more, Astro Ventilation provides outside air when you want it without opening a window. Outside air enters through ducts on the instrument panel. In the Caprice Coupe, this air circulates, then exits through pressure relief devices. Astro Ventilation, without the pressure relief devices, can be specified on Caprice Sedans and Impala models.

Of course, every 1968 Chevrolet contains a long list of other outstanding value features. You get factory waxing and wheel and tire balancing. There are important quality details like door-actuated interior light switches and lighted glove compartment (except Biscayne), illuminated heater-defroster controls, cigarette lighter, ashtrays front and rear, locking glove compartment, folding front seat back latches and foot-operated parking brake. Others include foam cushioned front seats (rear, too, in most models), scuff resistant cowl side panels,

padded sun visors, color-keyed deep-twist carpeting, rear seat armrests and center dome lights.

A big plus-value for all Chevrolet owners is the network of 6,400 Chevrolet dealers across the nation. This assures you the finest sales and service assistance in the industry—close at hand wherever you are throughout the country.

### EASY-CARE FEATURES

For the most part, Chevrolets take very good care of themselves. They have a host of important features that require little or no maintenance.

**SELF-ADJUSTING SAFETY-MASTER BRAKES.** Brakes are kept up tight where they should be, just by backing up and braking. Bonded linings have 198.4 sq. in. of area. Vents and wide drum flanges dissipate heat quickly to minimize the possibility of fading.

**LONG-LIFE EXHAUST SYSTEM.** Any engine noise you hear in a '68 Chevrolet could well be from some other car because Chevrolet's exhaust system is constructed with exceptional craftsmanship and corrosion-resistant components. Heavy-gauge steel or stainless steel is used in dual systems. Result: you get quiet performance and long life through the aid of Chevrolet's 1968 exhaust system designs.

**EIGHT FENDERS.** You don't see all those fenders but they're important to your Chevrolet's looks because they fight rust. Four of them are inside the front and rear wheel openings and their successful job is keeping water, mud, salt and snow away from body panels.

**FLUSH-AND-DRY ROCKER PANELS.** Water and air from the cowl intake are ducted through the rocker panels beneath the doors. This helps prevent pockets of moisture and sludge from forming to cause corrosion.

**BATTERY-SAVING DELCOTRON GENERATOR.** This air-cooled diode-rectified generator is a reliable current producer that gives longer battery life because it has a high output even at low engine speeds. No commutator to wear out as in conventional generators.

**"DELCO EYE" BATTERY.** Attributes are improved cell connectors for high electrical output even under heavy loads and the "Delco Eye" that glows a warning when the battery solution is low.

### STANDARD SAFETY FEATURES

- Energy-absorbing steering column • Seat belts with pushbutton buckles for all passenger positions • Shoulder belts for driver and right front passenger with pushbutton buckles and convenient stowage provision on all models except convertibles • Passenger-guard door locks with deflecting lock buttons—all doors.

- Four-way hazard warning flasher • Dual master cylinder brake system with warning light and corrosion-resistant brake lines • Latches on folding seat backs • Dual-speed windshield wipers and washers • Outside rearview mirror • Back-up lights • New side marker lights and parking lights that illuminate with headlights • Padded instrument panel, sun visors, windshield pillars • Reduced-glare instrument panel top, inside windshield moldings, horn button, steering wheel hub, and windshield wiper arms and blades.

- Inside day-night mirror with deflecting base • Lane-change feature in direction signal control • Safety armrests • Thick-laminate windshield • Soft, low-profile window control knobs and coat hooks • Energy-absorbing seat backs • Yielding door and window control handles • Energy-absorbing instrument panel with smooth contoured knobs and levers • Tire safety rim • Safety door latches and hinges • Uniform shift quadrant • Snag-resistant steering wheel hardware • Fuel tank and filler pipe security.

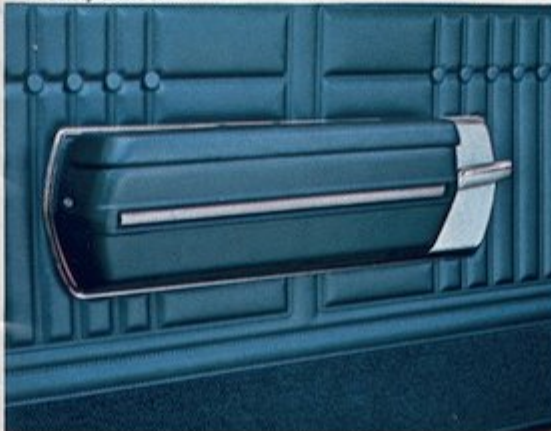

## What a '68 Chevrolet Means to You on the Technical Side

### ENGINES

Chevrolet's engine lineup for 1968 has been expanded to offer you a greater variety of power choices. Move out smartly with Chevrolet's standard Six or V8 (depending on the model you pick) or order one of four other V8s up to 385 horsepower. Every Chevrolet engine gives you these significant features: high-strength precision castings engineered to precise tolerances, efficient overhead valves with hydraulic lifters, wedge-shaped combustion chambers, short inlet and exhaust ports, controlled pressure lubrication system with full-flow filter, pressurized cooling system and high-capacity water pump. Fuel induction systems are tailored to suit the engine. All '68 engines are equipped with exhaust emission control equipment. All engines are fed by a large 24-gallon fuel tank for longer distances between gas stops.

#### STANDARD ENGINES (Depending on model selected)

**155-HP TURBO-THRIFT 250 SIX.** This advanced-design engine has single-barrel carburetor, automatic choke, short-stroke design and economy-contoured camshaft—all combine to make this a most frugal and efficient engine. Improved water pump sealing, fully counterweighted crankshaft and seven main bearings are but a few of the features that insure smooth, long-lasting performance and dependable Chevrolet operation.

**200-HP TURBO-FIRE 307 V8.** New for 1968, this rugged, more powerful engine replaces the previous 195-hp 283-cu.-in. engine as the standard V8 for all Chevrolets. It retains all the reliability and economy of its predecessor through two-barrel carburetor with automatic choke, positive-type engine ventilation, general performance camshaft. The 9.0:1 compression ratio means you can use a regular-grade fuel for savings.

#### EXTRA-COST ENGINES

**250-HP TURBO-FIRE 327 V8.** Also new for '68, this version of the popular 327 V8 engine stresses economy of operation. It has an 8.75:1 compression ratio to burn regular-grade fuel, four-barrel carburetor with automatic choke, and general performance camshaft.

**275-HP TURBO-FIRE 327 V8.** A favorite of Chevrolet fans, this engine is packed with durability and performance. It has four-barrel carburetor with automatic choke, general performance camshaft, large diameter single exhaust system and 10.0:1 compression ratio.

**325-HP TURBO-JET 396 V8.** Turbo-Jet design puts exceptional responsiveness under the hood. Four-barrel carburetor, automatic choke and large diameter single exhaust system are only a few of its attributes. Unique to the Turbo-Jet engines are the extra-strong crankshaft supports affording longer engine life, and advanced-engineered valve system and combustion chambers for maximum efficiency at all engine speeds. Compression ratio: 10.25:1.

**385-HP TURBO-JET 427 V8.** Chevrolet's top power for '68. Complementing its 427-cu.-in. displacement: performance-rated four-barrel carburetor, automatic choke, high-performance camshaft, 10.25:1 compression ratio, dual exhaust system with resonators.

### TRANSMISSIONS

Chevrolet has a transmission for every driver—whether he is a shift-it-yourself or one that likes the car to do it for him. There's even a transmission that will please both types.

**3-SPEED FULLY SYNCHRONIZED.** Standard on all '68 Chevrolets (depending on engine). Fully synchronized means you can manually downshift into first at low speeds without coming to a full stop. Wide helical gears, large synchronizers and high-capacity front and rear bearings make this transmission rugged and quiet.

**OVERDRIVE.** Available with standard Six or V8. This fully synchronized 3-speed unit has a 2-speed planetary gear feature which reduces engine speed, causing a decrease in wear and an increase in gas mileage. Shifts into Overdrive automatically at about 30 mph. A control on the instrument panel enables you to lock out Overdrive when desired.

**SPECIAL 3-SPEED FULLY SYNCHRONIZED.** This special-duty version of the standard 3-speed transmission is designed for higher performance engines and must be specified with the Turbo-Jet V8s when a manual 3-speed unit is wanted.

**4-SPEED FULLY SYNCHRONIZED.** For sportiness and versatility, order four-on-the-floor with any Chevrolet V8. You get smooth, responsive shifts through all-helical gears. Each forward gear is fully synchronized. The new shift control lever has a simple spring device to prevent shifting into reverse accidentally, replacing the manually released spring lockout.

**AUTOMATIC POWERGLIDE.** Long a Chevrolet favorite, this transmission has a 3-element torque converter and hydraulically controlled 2-speed planetary gearset. It adds up to smooth acceleration and quiet, dependable performance at a modest price. An accelerator-actuated automatic mechanism enables downshifts into low range. The five-position selector reads Park-R-N-D-L. When the center console-mounted shift lever is ordered, a new inverted-U-shaped lever selects the gears. A detent bar on the lever's underside prevents accidental movement of the selector into R, L or Park.

**AUTOMATIC TURBO HYDRA-MATIC.** The most you could want in an automatic transmission. Shifts for itself quickly and silk smooth. Or make it happen by moving the selector lever through the three forward gear ranges. It all occurs because of a 3-element torque converter with a compound 3-speed planetary gearset arrangement. This means sure automatic shifts. It also downshifts—automatically—for passing power or engine braking. Merely press down on the accelerator when you're in mid-speedometer speed range. With the center console, selector lever is of the new inverted-U-shape design. A new 2.56:1 economy rear axle ratio is available with this transmission.

**CLUTCH.** All of Chevrolet's '68 clutch disc sizes and spring pressure rates are matched to the torque of the various engines to insure smooth shifts and long wear. The single dry disc design also features a release bearing sealed in lubricant and a light alloy aluminum housing. Clutches with standard V8 and 4-Speed fully synchronized transmission and all extra-cost V8s are centrifugally assisted.

**EXHAUST EMISSION CONTROL.** Every 1968 Chevrolet engine is equipped with an exhaust emission control. This control reburns exhaust gases in the combustion chambers. Two types—each suited to the particular requirements of the various power teams—are used. An air injection reactor system is used on engines with manual transmissions and a controlled combustion system is used on engines with automatic transmissions.

### BODY BY FISHER

Body by Fisher says a lot that's special about Chevrolet. It means strength and durability because of Unisteel design—roof, sides, floor and pillars are welded into a single solid unit. Cowl, doors, hood and deck lid are of double-wall or double-panel construction. An advanced design feature is the way the body is mounted on the chassis. They are held together by eight biscuit-shaped rubber mounts with snap-in cushions to dampen noise, soak up road vibration. Other important-to-you details include superb sound insulation and weathersealing, high-level ventilation system and spring-loaded fork-type door latches for positive door closing.

**MAGIC-MIRROR FINISH.** The magic here is the lasting luster that requires only occasional washes to stay bright and shiny. Chevrolet's acrylic lacquer finish staunchly resists fading, chalking and chipping. Factory waxing is one of those Chevrolet details that mean more worth for you.

### CHASSIS

Chevrolet engineers constantly seek ways to make the excellent ride even better. For '68 they have made significant refinements in chassis components.

**PERIMETER FRAME.** The all-welded steel frame has been made stronger for '68. Of torque-box design, its heavy-gauge full-length side rails are connected by four crossmembers and new, sturdier transmission support. Hardtop and convertible models have even heavier side rails for their particular design requirements.

**FULL COIL SUSPENSION.** Husky coil springs, direct double-acting shock absorbers at all four wheels keep things on an even keel. An anti-dive feature is incorporated in the front suspension. Spherical joints are carried in teflon bushings. Link-type rear suspension has short upper control arms, strong upper control arm frame crossmember and scientifically located upper and lower control arm pivots.

A special suspension group is included when the SS 427 package is ordered (available only for Impala Sport Coupe, Impala Convertible and Impala Custom Coupe). It includes heavy-duty springs and shock absorbers, heavy-duty suspension bushings and large diameter front stabilizer bar, 15" x 6" wheels and wide-oval tires.

**BALL-RACE STEERING.** Steering gear is equipped with anti-friction ball bearings which reduce turning effort as much as 10% over conventional designs.

**TIRES.** 1968 Chevrolets have large 14-inch wheels (SS 427 and disc brake models have 15-inch wheels). Wheels and tires are precisely balanced at the factory. See your Chevrolet dealer for details on tire sizes, appearance features and model availability.

## Performance Options<sup>†</sup> to Make Your Going Greater

Make your 1968 Chevrolet start, stop and go exactly the way you want it by outfitting it with your own choices from an array of engine and chassis equipment.

**FRONT WHEEL DISC BRAKES.** These smooth stoppers have hydraulic caliper-type units with cast fins that direct air around the discs for fast heat dissipation. When these brakes are ordered, power assist and 15" wheels are included in the option.
