





The Volkswagen Jetta connects you to the world around you. And the 172-hp VR6 engine in the GLX gets you out and into it at 60 mph in just 7.5 seconds (manual transmission).

A custom 10 speaker Bose® music system provides the appropriate soundtrack.

Everything about the Jetta serves the driver, from its true German road handling to a simple turn of the key that locks all the doors, activates the anti-theft alarm system and even closes the power windows and sunroof:

And because getting out and into the world by yourself isn't nearly as much fun as bringing some friends along for the ride, the Jetta seats four comfortably. It even has a fold down rear seat for extra cargo space.

Above left. Jetta GLX in Sequoia Green Metallic! Its amazing 172-horsepower VR6 engine goes 0-60 in 7.5 seconds (manual transmission). Trackcorrecting rear axle means you don't have to fight the steering wheel around tight corners. The GLX includes aggressive 15" alloy wheels and fog lamps for better visibility.

Above right. Jetta GL in Suede Silver Metallic! America's best selling European sedan. The low-drag body of the Jetta GL improves performance and fuel economy by reducing wind resistance. Smooth-profile mirrors and door handles help give Jetta GL a drag coefficient lower than that of a BMW 525i Sedan.

The Volkswagen Passat is designed to break you back into life. Not lock you away from it. In the Passat GLX, the 172 hp VR6 engine can take you from 0-60 in 8.1 seconds (manual transmission). Traction control transfers that power to where it's needed most, so you always have a feel for the road, no matter what the weather conditions are.

Inside, you'll find more passenger space than any Volvo or Mercedes Benz E-Class and an intelligently designed interior that puts the needs and comfort of the driver first.

Drive the Passat. We think you'll find it a very different type of road sedan. But then again, Volkswagen has

always been different.
