A 2.2L SOHC turbocharged and intercooled engine powers Probe GT, which also has an automatic adjusting handling suspension, variable power-assist speed-sensitive steering, and 4-wheel disc brakes (with anti-lock system optional). the extended-length 2WD model.) The suspension is a 4-corner coil spring system. Steering is power-assisted. And the power brakes are equipped with rear anti-lock system.

Aerostar comes in XL trim. XL Plus and XLT, too, both available with new optional Sport Appearance Package.* Or drive the top-line Eddie Bauer.
