




with overdrive, 4-wheel independent suspension and power disc brakes, front and rear. Anti-lock brakes are standard on Limited and Gran Sport.



Roadmaster Sedan

The lustrous, aerodynamic sides of the 1993 Roadmaster Sedan reflect a classic heritage. The full-frame, rear-wheel-drive luxury sedan draws its power from a fuel-injected 5.7-litre V8 engine that develops 180 horsepower, 300 lbs-ft of torque. Buicks are designed and built to resist

corrosion. All body sheet metal components are warranted against rust-through corrosion for 6 years/ 100,000 miles. Application of additional rust-inhibiting materials is not required under the corrosion coverage.

Coverage is currently available only in the U.S.A. and Canada for the 1993 model year. See your Buick dealer for details.

A word about warranty.

Plus warranty covers repairs for any new Buick, including labor and parts, to correct any defects in material or workmanship occurring during the warranty period. The complete vehicle (except tires, which are covered by their manufacturer) will be covered for 3 years or 36,000 miles, whichever comes first. Body sheet metal rust-through from corrosion is covered for 6 years or 100,000 miles, whichever comes first. See your Buick dealer for terms of this limited warranty. Supplemental Inflatable Restraint coverage is 3 years regardless of mileage.
