



IN TODAY'S YUKON AND YUKON XL, advanced technology pays off in real-world advantages. Take the frame, for example. Instead of being manufactured with conventional welded stampings, selected Yukon and Yukon XL frame components are shaped by water under extreme pressure, in a process called hydroforming. The result: strength without unnecessary fuel-robbing weight, along with a significant increase in dimensional accuracy and quality. Another example, consider the StabiliTrak vehicle stability enhancement system. It uses high-tech electronics to guard against potentially dangerous lateral skids. StabiliTrak is standard on Denali models and available on SLE and SLT (except 2500) models.

JOIN THE QUADRASTEER REVOLUTION.

After driving a Yukon XL 2500 equipped with the available QuadraSteer four-wheel steering system, *Automobile Magazine* was moved to write, "QuadraSteer is nothing short of a miracle."* Here's why. At highway speeds, the rear wheels of a QuadraSteer-equipped Yukon XL steer in the same direction as the front ones, resulting in significantly increased stability, even in crosswinds. At low speeds, though, the rear wheels steer opposite to the front wheels. That translates into unmatched low-speed manoeuvrability for this class of vehicle, with a turning circle comparable to that of a mid-size car. It also makes backing up with a trailer in tow easier than you could have believed possible. Add it all together and you have a genuine breakthrough in SUV handling.

A POWERFUL PROTECTOR.

A CONCERN FOR SAFETY AND SECURITY is one of the top reasons why many drivers are attracted to full-size SUVs. It only makes sense, then, that Yukon and Yukon XL are loaded with features designed for your protection. The excellent visibility that you enjoy from Yukon's tall seating position helps you to avoid potentially dangerous situations, as do Yukon's surprisingly agile handling and powerful, ABS-equipped disc brakes. If the worst does occur, your Yukon will help protect you and your passengers from injury with features like crush zones, safety-cage construction, dual-stage frontal air bags* and available front seat-mounted side-impact air bags.

*A NOTE ON CHILD SAFETY: Always use safety belts and proper child restraints, even in vehicles equipped with air bags. Children are safer when properly secured in a rear seat. Never place a rear-facing infant restraint in the front seat of any vehicle equipped with an active air bag. Refer to the vehicle Owner's Manual and child safety seat instructions for more information. Air bag inflation can cause severe injury or death to anyone too close to the air bag when it deploys. Be sure every occupant is properly restrained.

- b. The standard dual-stage frontal air bags deploy with reduced intensity in less severe impacts, while the front-passenger sensing system turns off the air bag if the seat is empty, contains a child seat or a small occupant.
- c. Yukon's stopping abilities are enhanced by 4-wheel disc brakes equipped with a dynamic rear proportioning system and standard ABS.





