Underneath, it's still the same Monza. Gutsy, and




economical, Monza remains the car Chevrolet intended it to be. A true performer, A car that demands to be driven.

The Monza Coupe (shown above) is highlighted by a squared-off grille and round headlights.







ZOOM. 4-cylinder standard.

A fuel-efficient new 151 Cu. In. L4 engine with 4-Speed manual transmission is standard on this year's Monza, Monza offers a cast-iron, valve-in-head design with hydraulic

valve lifters that help eliminate the need for valve adjustments. Its compact, functional design makes maintenance easy, too.

ZOOMIER. V6's available.

The V6 engine represents a blend of six-cylinder and V8 design characteristics. Although the engine block and cylinder heads are cast iron, the V6 configuration makes these engines lighter than Chevy's in-line Six. And because they take up less space in it into a mean machine.
