





Caprice, Impala and Bel Air standard features. Building a better way to see the U.S.A. has never been more evident than it is in 1973. And this partial list of standard features is one of the best ways we can prove it.

- 1. Side-guard beams. Sturdy, protective steel rails in every door like the guard rails along a highway.
- 2. Improved power ventilation system. Keeps a nice controlled flow of outside air coming inside even when your car is stopped and the windows are rolled up. And this year we've improved it even more. During cold weather starts the system automatically delays low-speed blower operation until the engine warms up.
- 3. Improved front bumper. This new system retracts on minor impact and hydraulically cushions the shock.

5. Double-panel steel roof. It's there for two reasons: added protection and to help eliminate noises. The solid steel outer roof is welded to a perforated steel inner roof, which is covered with acoustical vinyl.

6. Variable-ratio power steering.

(Standard on all models.) Gives good road feel at highway speeds, turns fast and easy in tight parking situations. This year, the steering wheel has a new soft rim and a cushioned center section.

7. Full Coil suspension. Each spring is computer-selected individually to suit the weight of the Chevrolet you buy (except wagons), which varies according to the equipment you order.

Coil springs, of course, are only part of Chevrolet's improved ride. For example, Chevrolets have a long 121.5" wheelbase and wide stance. They also have an advanced body mounting system that separates body and frame with cushioned mountings. And precise turning and cushioning of suspension and other components like shock absorbers, transmission and engine

mounts. Everything working together to give Chevrolet superb handling and comfort.

8. Power disc/drum brake system. (Standard on all models.) On the front wheels, large fade-resistant ventilated discs. On the rear wheels, reliable finned drums. The system has a dual master cylinder, warning light and corrosion-resistant brake lines.

9. Turbo Hydra-matic transmission. Standard on any big Chevrolet with a V8 engine. It's a three-range automatic that's considered to be among the finest transmissions in the world.

10. Occupant protection features. Seat belts with pushbutton buckles for all passenger positions • Single buckle seat and shoulder belts for driver and right front passenger (with reminder light

and buzzer) • Two front seat head restraints • Energy-absorbing steering column • Passenger guard door locks with forward mounted lock buttons




























Caprice, Impala and Bel Air available options.

- 1. Power door lock system. One control on each front door locks or unlocks all doors. A good secure reminder with kids.
- 2. Power windows (except Bel Air). Each window can be controlled individually by passengers or with a master switch by the driver.
- 3. Deluxe bumpers and bumper guards. Resilient rubber insets, front and rear, that add further to your Chevrolet's appearance and security.
- 4. Soft-Ray glass (except convertible rear window). Cool, soothing tint reduces glare from all your windows.
- 5. Cruise-Master speed control. Ideal for maintaining pre-selected speeds. Once you reach the speed you want, you press a button and your car maintains it automatically. To disengage, you simply touch the brake.
- 6. Radios and tape players. A complete choice. AM radio. AM/FM radio. AM/FM/Stereo radio. And 8-track stereo tape players with either AM or AM/FM/Stereo radio. Tape cartridges plug into the radio dial area.
- 7. Air conditioning. Two of the best units made. With Comfortron, you simply dial the temperature range you want and it stays there automatically all year-round. Our Four-Season system is almost as simple because all controls are within easy reach of the driver.
- 8. Rear-window defogger. Valuable in almost all American climates. It helps keep the rear window free of snow, ice, frost or damp weather fogging.
- 9. Comfortilt steering wheel. Adjusts with one lever to any of six different positions. Nice to have even if you're the only driver because it makes it easier to get in and out of your car.

Team it up with our 6-way power seat that moves up, down, forward, backward, or tilts forward or backward (not available on Bel Air).



- 10. Superlift shocks. If you plan on carrying a heavy load you may need them. They are air-adjustable to accommodate passenger and cargo loads and help maintain ride level.
- 11. Wheel covers. Two kinds. The full wheel covers or wire wheel covers (shown) for the sport-minded person.
- 12. Vinyl roof covers. Available in seven different colors on any big Chevrolet except (naturally) the convertible. Your choice of black or white with any exterior color, or blue, chamois, green, neutral or red, depending on exterior body color. There's also a two-tone paint available for all models except the convertible: Antique White as the upper color with a Light Blue Metallic, Midnight Blue Metallic, Chamois, Light Green Metallic, Green-Gold Metallic or Midnight Green bottom color.

Trailering Equipment. There are many trailering accessories you can get right where you buy your Chevrolet. Like our load-distributing hitch platform, a wiring harness, clamp-on truck-type mirrors, a heavy-duty radiator and a higher output Delcotron generator.
