


The classic lines of the Landau vinyl roof design are complemented by body accent striping. The striping also sets off Monte Carlo's unmistakable, sculptured lines.

When Americans think of elegance in an automobile, they usually think of sculptured lines and plush interiors. The 1974 Monte Carlo S certainly offers this kind of elegance.



Monte Carlo elegance is thorough, inside as well as out. The molded full foam seats, new bright-framed


color-keyed instrument cluster and luxurious cut-pile nylon carpeting testify to this.






