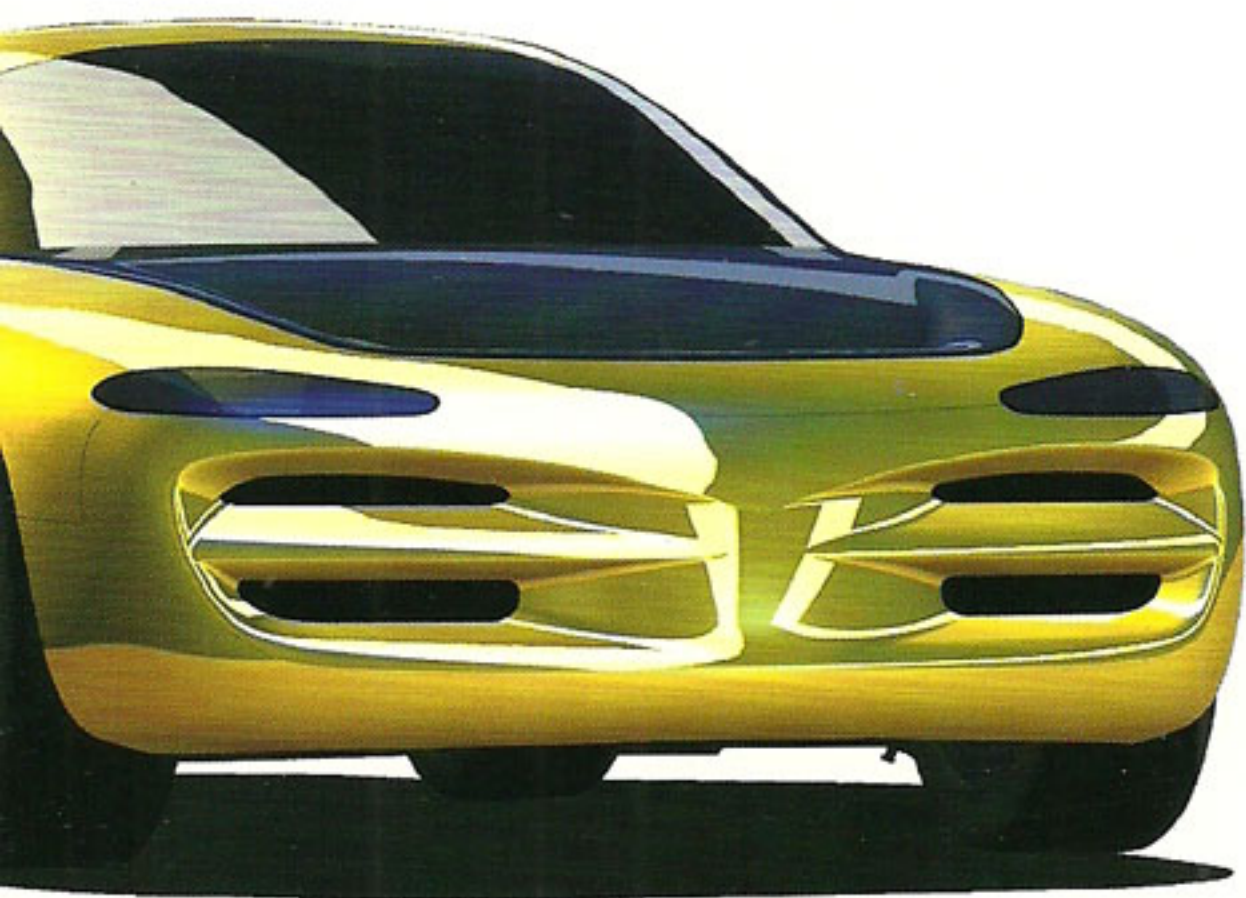

## SOPHISTICATED BRAWN

Perhaps you recall the days when Dodge Chargers and Plymouth Barracudas prowled main streets looking for an excuse to unleash their brawn. They used pure muscle to take on all challengers. Venom improves on those days by taking advantage of all that today's technology has to offer.

The cast-iron big block engines of the late '60s and early '70s have been replaced by a sophisticated 3.5-liter V6 engine. This aluminum engine uses 24 valves to produce an estimated 245 horsepower, 221 pound-feet of torque and delivers that driving force to the rear wheels for true sports car handling.

And because times **have** changed, Venom is designed to provide performance in an aerodynamically efficient and lightweight package.

The long hood and short deck of yesteryear have been replaced with a more intelligent design created by the use of cab-forward engineering which moves the wheels toward the corners, increasing both the wheelbase and the track. The result is a car with a comfortable ride and fantastic handling.

Cab forward also creates a vehicle that slips through the air, thanks to its steeply raked windshield, flush-mounted glass and sculpted sides.

And it maximizes interior room, so you can take friends and family along in your pursuit to recapture glory days gone by.
