From its aerodynamic front styling to its special rear spoiler, Monte Carlo SS has been track-tested and refined by Chevrolet engineers, and they've got it decidedly right.

The power is Chevrolet's famous 5.0 Litre High Output V8 with low-restriction dual exhaust. A 4-speed automatic transmission efficiently transfers the driving force through a 3.73:1 performance axle and wide, white-lettered Eagle GT radials on big 15" x 7" Rally wheels. Keeping a firm grip on all that performance is the F41 Sport Suspension with large-diameter stabilizer bars front and rear. The special SS trim, padded sport steering wheel and gauges,



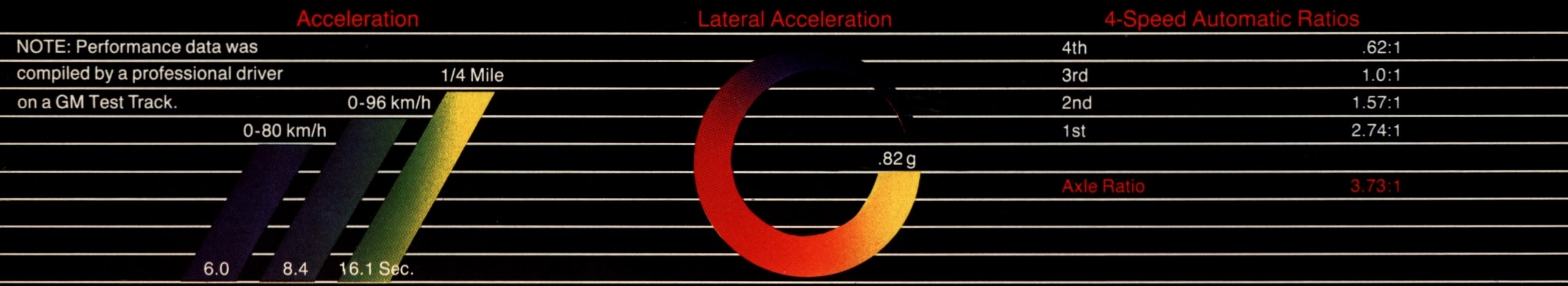
with tach, set off the interior. And the SS exterior is instantly recognizable, from the exclusive black-out trim to the Monte Carlo SS identification.

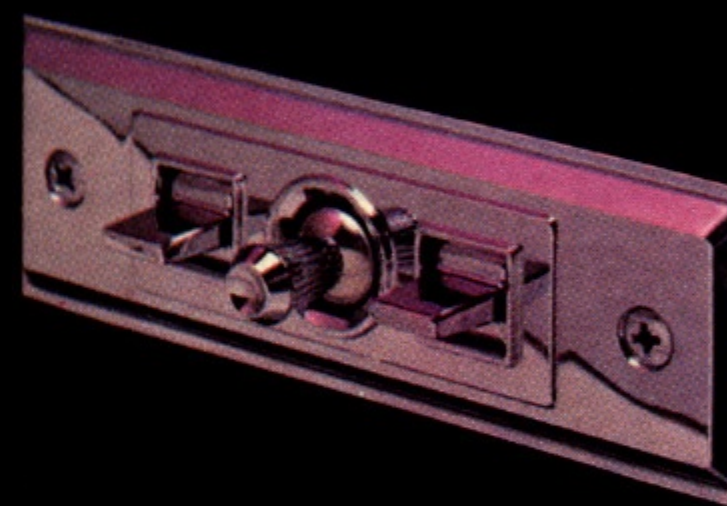

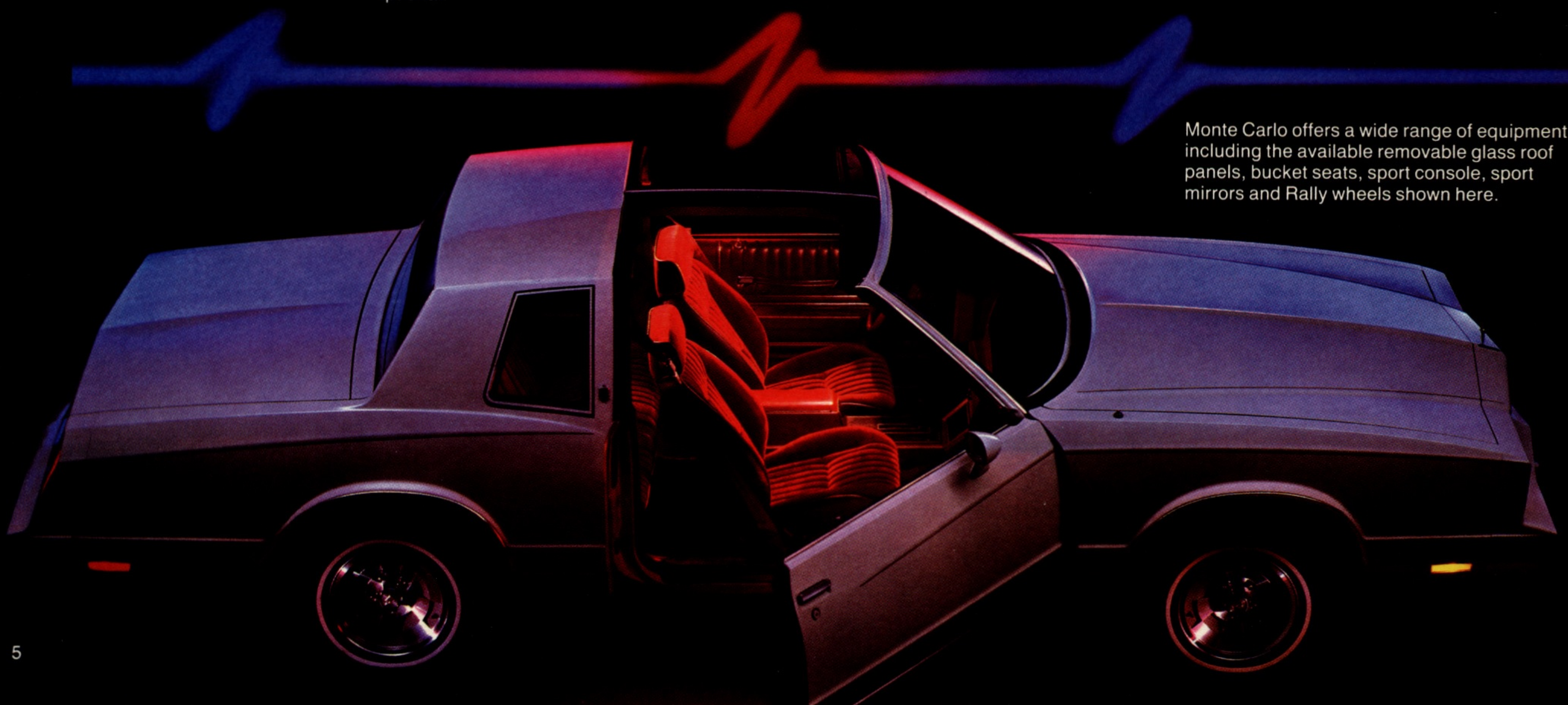

A word about assembly, components and optional equipment in these vehicles.

The vehicles described in this brochure are assembled at various Divisions of General Motors Corporation. These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by General Motors of Canada Limited and related companies and their suppliers. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for

particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emission and safety requirements or fuel economy guidelines, or for other reasons, to produce vehicles with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in our products by General Motors of Canada Limited or related companies and will provide the quality performance associated with our name.

Please note that certain optional equipment can be ordered only in conjunction with other optional equipment. Also, upgrading from specified standard equipment may be necessary when certain optional equipment is ordered. Ask your sales representative for details.

With respect to extra cost optional equipment, make certain you specify the type of equipment you desire on your vehicle when ordering it from your dealer. Some options may be unavailable when your car is built. Your dealer receives advice regarding current availability of options. You may ask the dealer for this information. GM also requires the dealer to advise you if an option you ordered is unavailable. We suggest you verify that your car includes the optional equipment you ordered or, if there are changes, that they are acceptable to you.

All illustrations and specifications contained in this catalogue are based on the latest product information available at time of publication approval. The right is reserved to make changes at any time, without notice, in prices, colours, materials, equipment, specifications and models, and to discontinue models. Some of the equipment shown or described throughout this catalogue is available at extra cost. Check with your dealer for complete information.

FOR YOUR PROTECTION

New Vehicle Limited Warranty—This warranty covers any repairs needed during the basic coverage period due to defects in material or workmanship. Any required adjustments will also be made during the basic coverage period of 12 months or 20,000 kilometres, whichever comes first. The complete vehicle, except tires, is covered during this period.

Powertrain Coverage—This powertrain warranty covers gasoline engines and other powertrain components up to a total of 24 months or 40,000 kilometres, whichever comes first. This powertrain warranty also

covers specific diesel engine components to 36 months or 80,000 kilometres, whichever comes first. All powertrain warranty repairs are subject to a \$100 deductible for each repair visit.

Corrosion (Rust-Through)

Coverage—General Motors warrants for 1985 passenger cars, light duty trucks and vans that your General Motors dealer will repair or replace at no charge any body sheet metal panel found to have developed perforation (rust-through) due to corrosion. This warranty begins on the date the vehicle is first delivered or put in use and extends for 36 months, regardless of distance travelled by the vehicle.

Battery Coverage—If your battery should fail under normal service due to a defect in material or workmanship after the basic coverage period expires, but before the vehicle has been in use 36 months, it can be replaced on a pro rata adjustment basis for a new Delco battery. The pro rata adjustment price of the new battery will be based on the number of months the original battery was in use since the start of the new vehicle warranty. Contact a dealer handling your vehicle for further details on such adjustments.

Tires are warranted by the tire manufacturer.

Owner Assistance—The satisfaction and goodwill of owners are of primary concern to GM dealers and General Motors of Canada Limited. In the event a warranty or some other matter is not handled to your satisfaction, the following steps should be taken:

1. Discuss the problem with your dealership management.
2. Contact the General Motors Zone Office closest to you as listed in the Owner Assistance Section of your Warranty and Owner Assistance Booklet.
3. Contact the Customer Service Representative, General Motors of Canada Limited, Oshawa, Ontario.

Special Policy Adjustment Program Beyond the Warranty Period—General Motors is proud of the protection afforded by its warranty coverages. In order to achieve maximum customer satisfaction, there may be times when General Motors will establish a Special Policy Adjustment program to pay all or part of the cost of certain repairs beyond the terms of the warranty. Check with your General Motors dealer or the nearest GM Zone Office to determine whether any special policy adjustment program is applicable to your vehicle.
