
Thunderbird designers have achieved the epitome of luxury and good taste in a new Special Brougham Option for the Two-Door Hardtop and Two-Door Landau. Among many niceties of plush distinction are the impeccably tailored high-back bucket seats you see here. They are individually adjustable. Headrests are built in Deep-toam-padded, contour design gives you superb lateral and back support.

Opulent hopsack and vinyl is available in ginger, black, red, blue and ivy. A handy center console, deluxe three-spoke Rim-Blow Steering Wheel, cut-pile carpeting, rear center armrest, door pull handles, and door courtesy lights are other interior refinements.

Special Brougham Option exterior accourrements include: auxiliary grille lamps p a color-keyed front stone shield and deflector p white sidewall radial ply tires p color-keyed wheel covers p bodyside molding with protective, color-keyed vinyl inserts, and wheel lip moldings.



A unique new Locking Steering Column deters theft: locks steeringtransmission-ignition when key is removed. There's a left-hand remote-control outside mirror. AM radio, too. Teak-toned appliques grace panel and doors. Flight Bench Seats have contour-molded foam cushions and backs, richly covered. Center armrest down, bucket-type comfort. Center armrest up, generous room and comfort for three. King-size door armrests are plush. Even the air you breathe is different. Power Ventilation freshens it continuously with all windows up. Thunderbird Specifications

Colors and Trim — Brilliant, rich Super Diamond Lustre Enamel in up to 31 exterior colors (all models). Color-keyed trim selections. Flight Bench Front Seat standard; High-back bucket Front Seats and Console (Two-Door) or split bench (Four-Door) optional. Standard trim all-vinyl. Optional Brougham Interior Trim in nylon cloth and vinyl or leather and vinyl. Optional Special Brougham Trim of hopsack and vinyl. Trims available in up to 7 color choices.

Engines — 429-cu. in. V-8 with 360 hp; 4.36" bore x 3.59" stroke; 10.5 to 1 comp. ratio; 4-barrel carburetor; automatic choke; premium fuel; dual exhaust system. SelectShift Cruise-O-Matic—Lets you drive fully automatic or shift manually through the gears. Three forward gears, one reverse, with quadrant sequence

Rear Axle—Semi-floating type with deep-offset hypoid gears, Straddle-mounted drive pinion.

Frame — Strong frame-and-body design consisting of front end assembly, rear end assembly, and four torque box assemblies connected by formed center sideralis. The frame is rugged ladder-type construction with five reinforced crossmembers. Node-point body mounting at 14 computer-designated positions results in superior noise and vibration suppression characteristics.

Front Suspension — Wide 62" tread. Drag-strut, balljoint type. Rubber-bushed stabilizer.

Rear Suspension — Wide 62" tread. Three-link, coil spring system with long and short mounting-link arrangement. Lateral track bar centers axle. All links and track bar rubber-bushed.

Steering — Integral-design power steering. Tilt Steering Wheel optional. Overall ratio 21.9 to 1. Turning diameter 42.7 ft. Two-Door; 43.4 ft. Four-Door.

Twice-a-Year Maintenance

New Thunderbirds are designed to go 6,000 miles (or 6 months) between oil changes and minor lubrications; 36,000 miles (or 3 years, whichever comes first) between major chassis lubes. Other '70 Thunderbird service-savers include: 24-month engine coolant-antifreeze, self-adjusting brakes, long-life Sta-Ful battery, shielded alternator, rust- and corrosion-resistant aluminized mufflers and galvanized underbody parts. The '70 Thunderbird needs so little service it's just good sense to see that it gets the best — at your Ford Dealer's. His factory-trained mechanics and special tools add up to the greatest service combination available for your Thunderbird.

NOTE: Your new 1970 Thunderbird comes equipped with factory engineered and approved parts such as the dependable Autolite Sta-Ful battery, Autolite Power-Tip spark plugg, Autolite shock aborbors, and an Autolite 6000-mile oil littler. For continued top replacement is necessary, and an Autolite parts whenever replacement is necessary.
