SUPER WILDCAT. Strictly tailored to meet the demands of the performance lovers, this Super Wildcat is a 425 cubic inch engine with two four-barrel carburetors and high-performance camshaft. The horsepower is 360. Available as extra-cost equipment on Riviera, Electra 225 and Wildcat models, this mighty engine belongs among the kings of the road. Even at highway speeds it's merely loafing along. What's more, it gives you a big reserve of power to counter any emergency.

WILDCAT 465. Here's another big, topperforming engine in the Buick Wildcat family. It's the 425 cubic inch Wildcat 465 equipped with single four-barrel carburetor. The big piston displacement plus a high-lift camshaft give it extraordinary dash on acceleration plus an easy, wellpaced gait at cruising speeds. Horsepower is rated at 340. This engine is regular equipment on Riviera, optional on Electra 225, Wildcat and LeSabre Estate Wagons. Wonderfully quiet in operation, too.

WILDCAT 445. This is the engine that made Buick performance famous. The 401 cubic inch Wildcat 445 is rated at 325 horsepower while the compression ratio is 10.25 to 1. Electra 225, LeSabre Estate Wagons and Wildcat models come equipped with the Wildcat 445 at no extra cost. Actually, this engine is the design prototype for all the great Wildcat engines, now refined to a state of near perfection (but we always keep trying). Hard to find its equal for smoothness.

WILDCAT 355. Here's a newcomer to the Wildcat family—and it's great. It's a tremendous bundle of performance in a new lightweight package. The cubic inch displacement is 300 and with a 4-barrel carburetor it turns up a very respectable 250 horsepower. For maximum weight savings many parts are made of aluminum. This engine is optional in LeSabre, Skylark, Special Deluxe and Special models. Compression ratio is 11 to 1. It uses premium fuel but economy is good.

WILDCAT 310. Here's a high-spirited engine that subsists nicely on a diet of regular-grade fuel. It's the 300 cubic inch Wildcat 310 equipped with two-barrel carburetor. The compression ratio is 9 to 1. This engine comes at no extra cost on LeSabre models and is optional on Skylark, Special Deluxe and Special models. It's a fine combination of thriftiness and performance that puts new economy into the Buick LeSabre and new liveliness into the trim-size Skylark and Specials.

FIREBALL V6. Behold Buick's revolutionary V6 engine—now bigger and better than ever in 1964. Both bore and stroke of this remarkable engine have been increased to raise the output to a full 155 horsepower. But the best news is economy. All of the V6's top regular-gas economy has been retained in the new edition to give you V8-like smoothness on a mere smidgin of regular gas. Skylark, Special Deluxe and Special models come equipped with the Fireball V6. \square



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
