Of course, the Imperial is a complete automobile. The biggest engine we make, a 440 cubic inch 4-barrel V-8, is standard. a minute a month.



IMPERIAL INTERIORS. Every

commitment to luxury is available to you in the 1973 Imperial.

For example, the interior shown on the preceding page is the optional splitbench seat in Cologne leather that's available on our four-door model. This seat has all the fashion and flair of a piece of fine furniture. Extra plushness and comfort are provided by a built-in "floating cushion." You have a choice of six colors: blue, green, parchment, black, gold, or white.

Another point to remember: yards of rich, deep-pile carpeting are everywhere you look. If you wish, you can add even more convenience by ordering an optional remote-control deck lid release for your trunk.

A. Optional leather bucket seats for two-door models are available in blue, green, parchment, black, gold, or white. Both seats are individually contoured for personal comfort—and the passen-ger seat reclines. With this interior, power seats are required.

B. Standard interior for the Imperial two-door hardtop is an Iraq cloth and Cologne-grain leather split-bench seat in green, black, or gold. The deeply padded center armrest has a wide surface for the convenience of both driver and passenger.

C. Standard interior for the Imperial four-door hardtop is a 50/50 split-bench seat in Iraq cloth and Cologne-grain leather. The driver and the passenger seats adjust individually . . . and the passenger seat is the reclining type. It can be moved to a wide variety of positions to accommodate your passenger's comfort. Individual folding center armrests for both driver and passenger are also provided. Colors: blue, green, parchment, black, or gold.

D. The instrument panel on an Imperial carries on our functional yet beautiful interior scheme. Simulated rosewood graces the instrument panel as well as accenting the driver's console, all door panels and passenger assist handles.

WHAT MAKES AN IMPERIAL AN IMPERIAL. Luxury car owners expect their cars to be quiet and highly roadable. The 1973 Imperial comes through on both counts with Torsion-Quiet Ride (A). Helping to keep road noise out is our Sound Isolation System. Current owners know how effective this system is. In 1973, our

passenger compartments are even quieter. And you should always know what time it is in your Imperial. Our new standard chronometer (B) is accurate to within a minute a month. To help you enjoy the interior even more, assist handles (C) along with courtesy lights are located on all doors. On the four-door model, rearseat passengers can enjoy switch-operated reading lamps, built-in foam pillows and lavaliere straps (D). Our extra-protection bumper system (E) that exceeds federal government requirements and bias-belted tires are standard. Optional steel-belted tires (F) are also available.


For a better start, an Electronic Ignition System (G) is standard. With this system, ignition maintenance is virtually reduced to cleaning or replacing the spark plugs.

Though the standard equipment list on an Imperial stretches from air conditioning with automatic temperature control to undercoating, there are a few other options that deserve special mention.

There's an electrically operated sun roof (H) for both models. You can vary the opening to let a little or a lot of sun in.


A new option is our Security Alarm System available only with power door locks. Once this system is armed, if a protected area of the car (hood, trunk, doors, and ignition) is tampered with, the horn and lights are activated. Your ignition key will immediately shut off the alarm.

Last year, of all domestically produced passenger cars, only Imperial offered a four-wheel computer-controlled braking system. Our system, called Sure-Brake (J), unlike similar systems offered by competition, makes it impossible to lock the front wheels even on very slippery surfaces. Power front disc brakes (K) and self-adjusting rear drums are standard.





C. Power Vent Windows. This convenient option is available on the four-door hardtop model.

D. Sun Roof. Electrically operated to help you easily find your place in the sun. Available for both 2- and 4-door models.

E. Tilt & Telescope Steering Wheel. Adjusts for both height and reach for driver comfort and convenience. Swings up for easier entrances and exits.

F. Auto-Speed Control. Set the fingertip control and your Imperial will maintain that speed automatically until you brake, accelerate or disengage.

G. Power Seats. Effortless adjustments for driver's seat only, or both front seats with buckets or 50/50 seating.
