A NOTE ON CHILD SAFETY

Children generally are safer if they are secured in a rear seat using the appropriate child safety seats and restraints, which is why General Motors recommends that child safety seats be properly secured in a vehicle's rear seat. Never place a rear-facing infant restraint in the front seat of any vehicle equipped with an active air bag. See the Owner's Manual and child safety seat instructions for more safety information. Always wear safety belts, even with air bags.

ENVOY HAS MANY STANDARD SAFETY FEATURES INCLUDING:

Occupant Protection Equipment Lap/shoulder belts, front and rear outboard positions. Driver and front passenger air bags. Child security door locks, rear doors. Child comfort guides, rear outboard shoulder belt. Safety belt cinch capability for child seats. Power window lock-out, rear door windows. Side door guard beams.

TRAILERING WITH YOUR ENVOY

Envoy is built strong and durable to handle the demands of towing. Certain equipment that prepares Envoy for trailering is standard: power steering and brakes, a large fuel tank, a 100-amp alternator, a front stabilizer bar, special transmission oil and engine oil coolers. For other available traileringrelated equipment, talk to your dealer. If you plan to tow frequently, your Envoy is equipped with the towing package (RPO Z82). This package includes a weight-distributing hitch platform and a heavy-duty eight-wire electrical harness. Also required are a hitch ball and mounting head. Equalizing and anti-sway assemblies may be required for some trailering applications; these are available through aftermarket sources. If you have any questions about trailering with an Envoy before you buy, feel free to ask your dealer for a copy of the GMC Trailering Guide.

OFF-ROADING WITH YOUR ENVOY

When you go off-road, you should ensure your driving is appropriate to the vehicle and environment. Avoid sharp turns and abrupt maneuvers. Failure to operate vehicles correctly off-road could result in loss of vehicle control or vehicle rollover. When you are off-road, make sure that all cargo is properly loaded and secured. Whenever possible, use established trails, roads and other areas that have been set aside for public off-road recreational driving. And obey posted regulations. Don't drive on private property without the permission of the owner; in some states, you must have it in writing. Avoid any driving practice that could harm the environment or hurt wildlife, like wheel-spinning, breaking down trees, driving through streams or driving over soft ground. And never park your vehicle over dry grass or other materials that could catch fire from the heat of the vehicle's exhaust system.

TIRE CHAINS

Tire chains should not be used because they could damage your Envoy.
