Ford Motor Company in the case of a vehicle purchased by the owner in the United States, or Ford Motor Company of Canada Limited in the case of a vehicle purchased by the owner in Canada, each hereinafter called "the Company", warrants to the original retail purchaser (hereinafter called "Original Purchaser") each part of a new and unused 1968 model Ford-built passenger car (except Bronco or Club Wagon) or Ranchero to be free under normal use and service from defects in factory material and workmanship for a period of 24 months from the date of original retail delivery or first use, or until it has been driven for 24,000 miles (1), or until sold by the Original Purchaser, whichever comes first.
