Montcalm • Rideau 500

One of the most important things about Mercury Meteor wagons is that they combine all of the important features of the Meteor cars plus an added few of their own. They're impressive, they're smooth riding, quiet and comfortable and they're spacious, with plenty of travelling room for six people plus loads of luggage space.

There are two Meteor wagons to choose from, the finely appointed Montcalm and the Rideau 500. Both have large, easy to load cargo areas. Its a cavernous 94.6 cubic feet. The standard floor area is large enough to take a 4' x 8' panel lying flat. But there's still more to come because under the floor is another 9.1 cubic feet of cargo space that can be locked so you can keep valuables safe.

Both these wagons feature Ford's famous 3-way doorgate with a power window. Standard.

This year Meteor is styled more impressively than ever, with a design that's unmistakably Mercury. A classic hood ornament overlooks a freshly designed grille.

Both wagons deliver a smooth and quiet ride thanks to Meteor's long 121 inch wheelbase, plenty of sound absorbing materials strategically placed throughout, plus a radial tuned suspension. Steel belted radial ply tires are standard and help improve gas economy as well as add many more thousands of miles of tread life over conventional tires.

Interior appointments are impressive with the unmistakable Mercury look of

quality. Deeply padded and comfortable seats. Full length arm rests, with a wide cushioned sill along the front padded door and there's thick 12 ounce cut-pile 100% nylon carpet underfoot.

Interior appointments on both Montegos are accented by thick, 12 ounce cut-pile, 100% nylon carpets—long wearing and comfortable.

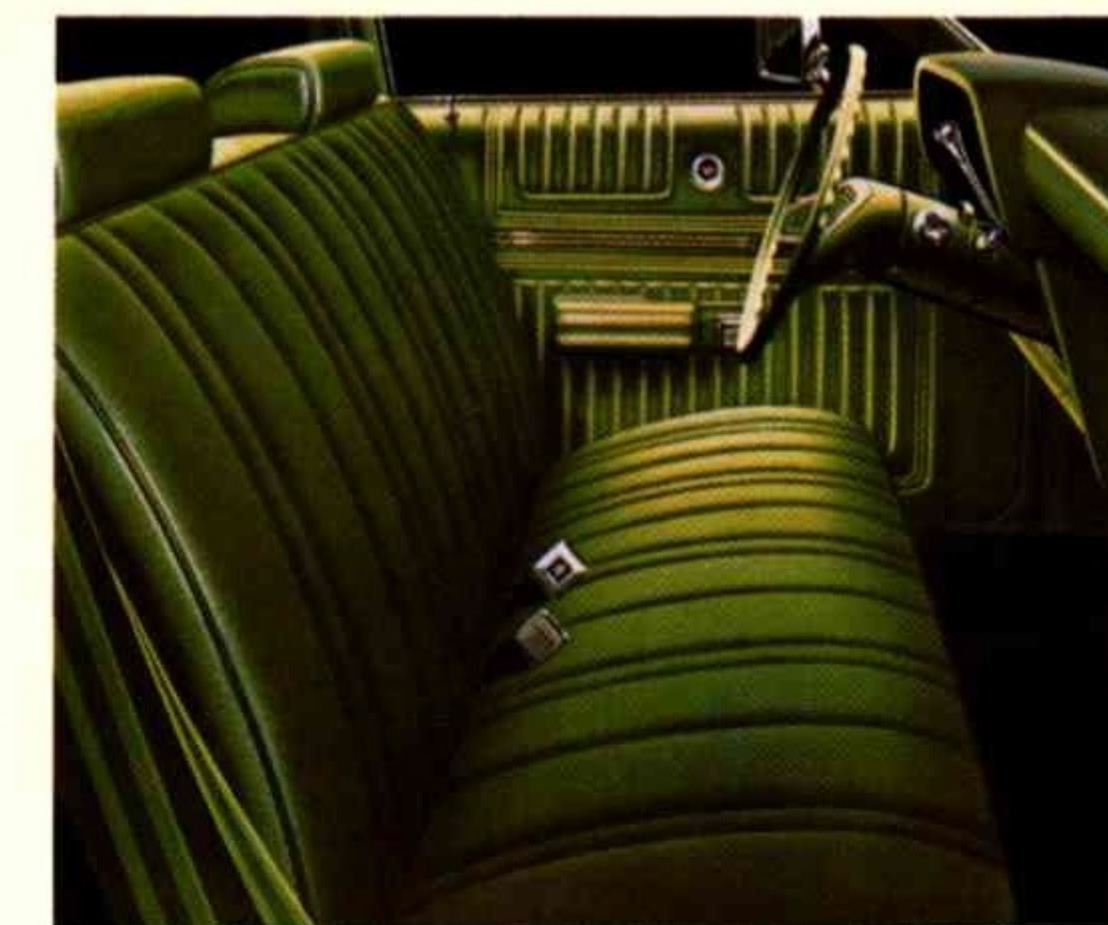

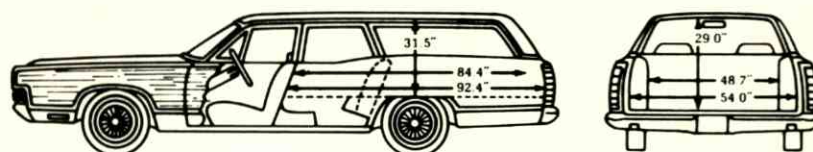

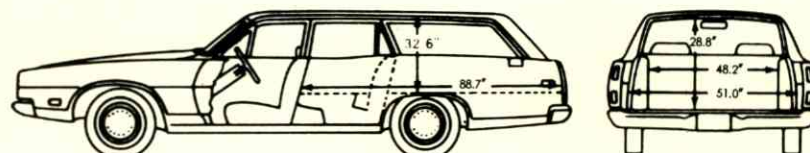


Optional rear-facing third seat on Montego models, gives additional seating for two passengers. The three-way doorgate opens as a door to afford easy entry and exit.

The standard three-way doorgate is convenient to use—it operates as a door whether the rear window is rolled up or down, and drops flush with the wagon floor for loading cargo.



Colony Park, Marquis and Meteor Station Wagons give you the extra space to carry full-size loads of passengers or cargo, and still give comfort and luxury. A lockable stowage area permits you to hide things below deck, too.
