1978 Mercury Marquis. Proud in stance and unmistakable as a full-size family car that combines luxury and comfort.

Marquis for 1978 continues its heritage as a fine riding automobile. Mercury Marquis is carefully ride-engineered with a harmonious integration of body structure, suspension and powertrain. Sophisticated front and rear suspension systems are complemented by steel-belted radial tires. Deep-coil springs at all four wheels, and metal parts isolated with tough, shock-absorbing rubber help minimize noise, vibration and harshness. The resulting ride is the sum total of all of these engineering attributes. This is what we mean by ride-engineered.

Ford Motor Company 75th Anniversary. Ford Motor Company was in its 35th year when the first Mercury automobile was introduced on November 4, 1938. The 1939 Mercury was the first Ford-produced car that was styled entirely within the company and the first built up from a clay model by Ford stylists. This was the very beginning of the Lincoln-Mercury fine car division. The Lincoln-Mercury Division is proud of its contribution to Ford Motor Company's illustrious history. Just as we are proud of the fine products in this book that are a part of the heritage of Ford Motor Company. Marquis for 1978 continues that heritage.

FULL-SIZE LUXURY. FULL-SIZE COMFORT.

Six-passenger comfort. Marquis' ample interior dimensions invite comparison with any full-size car you are acquainted with. It gives you room for six passengers with ample hip and shoulder room even for three adults. The best test of this car's efficient use of space is, of course, by riding in it—both in the front seat and back. Sit back and relax. Notice how Marquis' cushioning supports your upper and lower back. The convenient dimension chart on page 5 shows exactly how spacious Marquis is.

Incompromised Quality. Attention to quality runs deep in Marquis, which features separate box/frame construction. A rigid body working with a torque box frame helps minimize road shock, noise and vibration. Use of pre-coated steel provides corrosion protection in several major body areas. Marquis uses a vinyl sealer on the underside of the rear wheelhouses and in other selected areas.

Ride-Engineered. Mercury Marquis' distinctive brand of comfort and clean styling is available in a full range of models. And Marquis is ride-engineered. Standard power steering, power brakes and Select-Shift automatic transmission take much of the effort out of driving Marquis. Its wide stance, front and rear, contributes to a solid ride on the open road and through winding curves. An inde-

pendent coil spring front suspension minimizes the irregularity of rough road surfaces. The front and rear coil springs are computer selected to match body weight and equipment.

Body Insulation. Marquis' interior sound level is the product of an extensive insulation program. Insulation, including acoustical pads and sound insulators is strategically located in such areas as roof, floor, fenders, roof pillars, cowl, dash, hood, luggage compartment—even behind the rear seat.

Wagons, too. Imagine, if you can, a practical vehicle that gives you the kind of, luxury and style that Mercury is famous for...plus the added convenience of 94.6 cubic feet of cargo space!® That's the Mercury Marquis station wagon. In addition to standard power steering, power brakes and Select-Shift automatic transmission, it features a power rear window in its three-way tailgate and a color-keyed carpeted load floor. If you want to go all out, simply ask for the Colony Park Option. You get all the standard Marquis features plus many niceties such as a Flight Bench seat, electric clock and the handsome rosewood simulated woodgrain applique on bodyside and tailgate. A Tradition of Testing. Through the years, the ride of a Marquis has been dramatically demonstrated in a wide variety of tests on national television. For example, an expensive diamond was actually cut in the back seat of a moving 1972 Marquis. In the



famous Blindfold test, 50 professional drivers rated a 1972 Marquis' ride superior to that of a \$34,000 European limousine. And in 1977, a Mercury Marquis was rated superior overall by 37 out of 50



big car owners selected from the Los Angeles area over a 1977 Cadillac DeVille, based on tests of 30 automotive qualities. These tests and comparisons, of course, do not apply to our new products. However, they are indications of the kind of ride Mercury Marquis has demonstrated in past years.

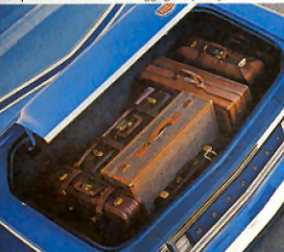

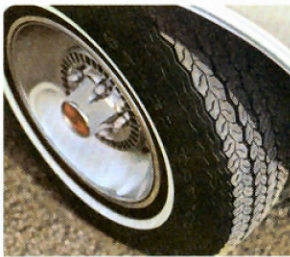

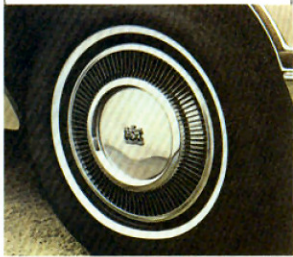

MERCURY MARQUIS. A STUDY IN ENGINEERING DETAIL.

The representation of a Marquis body, seen below, provides an indepth picture of Marquis' engineering features.

The powertrain. The standard engine in the Mercury Marquis is the 5.8 litre (351 CID) 2V V-8 engine and the optional 6.6 litre (400 CID) 2V V-8 engine is required in California. All Marquis engines have the DuraSpark solid-state ignition system.

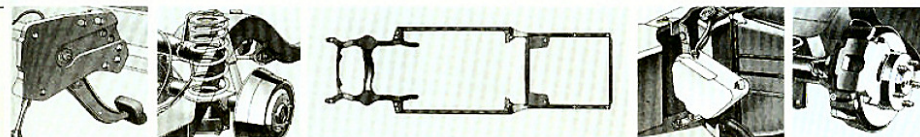
This system contributes to long recommended spark plug change intervals. The Select-Shift automatic transmission offers responsive performance and driver convenience.

Body construction. Marquis features separate body/frame construction. A rigid body, working with a 4-torque box frame, helps minimize road shock, noise and vibration. Heavy sheet metal crossmembers give the floor rigidity.

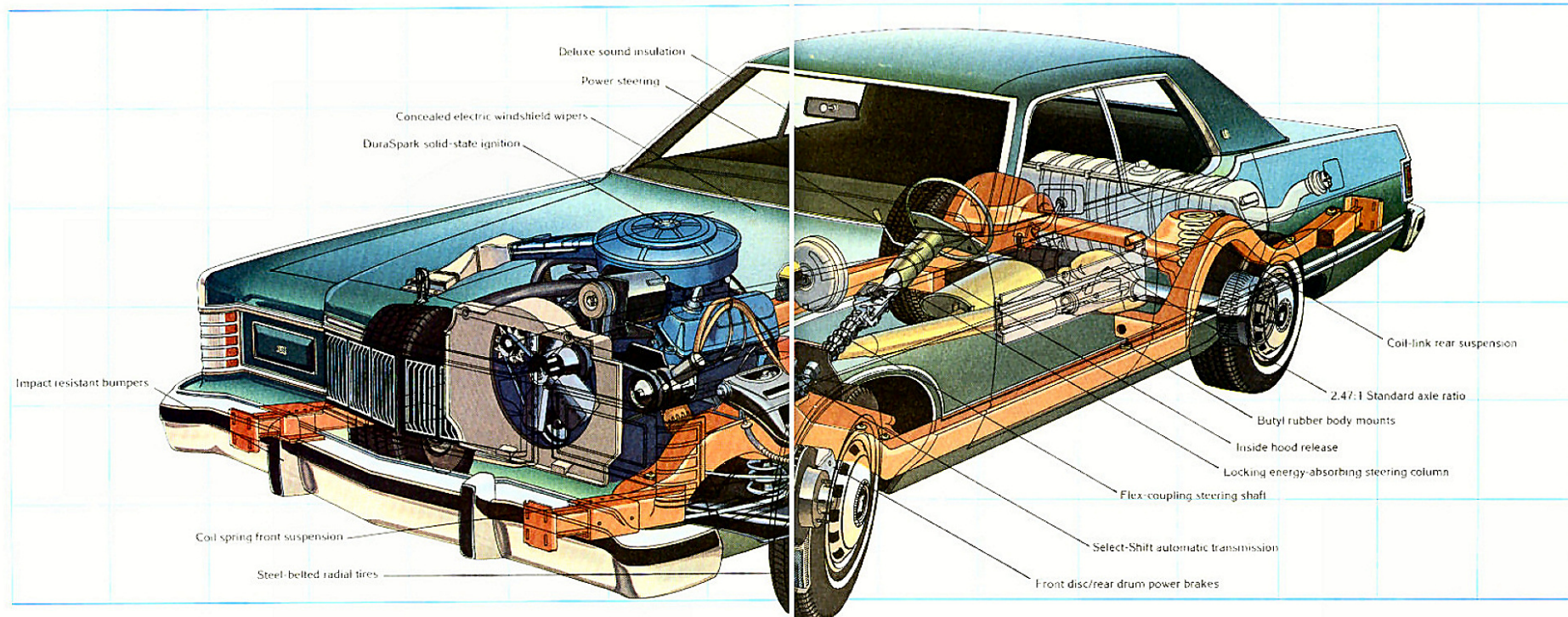


From left to right: Automatic Parking Brake release, Coil-Link Rear Suspension, Body/Frame Construction, Coolant Recovery System, Power Brakes

The suspension system. The Marquis suspension system features fully independent front coil springs and coil spring 3-link design rear. A front link-type stabilizer bar helps fight excessive sway and "lean" when cornering.

The Marquis suspension system contributes to a smooth comfortable ride. A sensitive steering system and steel-belted radials, also add to Marquis' handling characteristics.

And Marquis has features that work automatically. The closed coolant recovery system captures heated coolant overflow and automatically returns it to the radiator when it cools. Marquis' parking brake releases automatically, too. A desirable option is Marquis' four-wheel disc brakes.

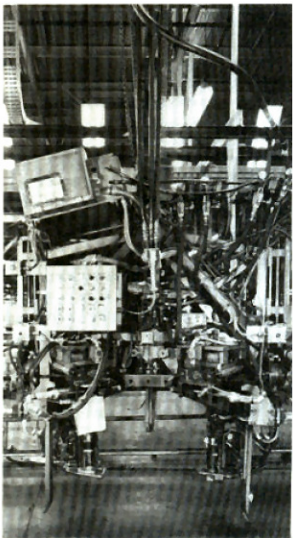


QUALITY IN DEPTH: A MERCURY TRADITION.

Driver and passenger seating in Marquis Brougham, whether in 2-door or 4-door model, is a study in relaxation, comfort and convenience amid plush surroundings. The Flight Bench seat, shown above, is tailored in soft, beautiful saddle Willshire cloth. Other available colors include dove grey, dark red, medium blue, dark jade and camel. The floor is covered in thick, 18 ounce Tiffany spun nylon pile carpeting. Whatever your color choice, the interior of Marquis Brougham is a picture of harmony. Deluxe seat belts and deluxe steering wheel are color-keyed. Light burl woodtone appliques extend across the instrument panel and also beautify floor trim panels. Doors are further enhanced with attractive and handy pull straps. And conveniences include

an under instrument panel light. Four-door Broughams have rear door courtesy light switches and a cigar lighter installed in each rear door arm rest.

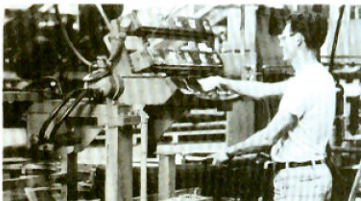

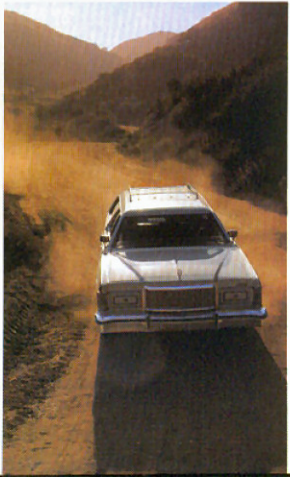
